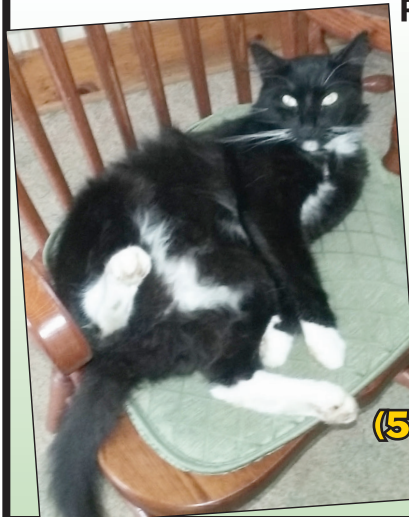

● The Village Hall will be **CLOSED** on Wednesday, July 4th and Friday the 6th for the holiday.

● Residents of the Mount Morris water supply system. For the past two weeks the water has had an earthy, woody smell and taste. This is a situation we have experienced in years past which is caused by environmental conditions. This summer has been dry and fairly warm for an extended period of time. The water level of Silver Lake was at a low point which is usually not seen until the end of July. The surface water temperature of Silver Lake has been hovering around 69 to 70°F and these are perfect conditions for the growth of organic matter in the lake that can cause taste and odor issues. These conditions have also been found in neighboring communities' water systems.

The Village of Mount Morris has been continually monitoring our system as it does 365 days a year. The Village of Mount Morris has been testing water samples throughout the system and supplying the results to the Livingston County Health Department. We are maintaining our system's water quality within NYS Health Department guidelines. Water quality is a balancing act. We try to minimize chlorinating the water in order to lessen the formation of disinfection byproducts at the far ends of our water system. System operators have to balance between disinfecting and excessive chlorine byproducts.

The planned updates to the water treatment plant that will be starting in the fall of 2018 are expected to help with the smell and taste issues that occur under these conditions.

If any resident of the Village of Mount Morris water system, which includes the Village and Town of Mount Morris, and the majority of the Town of Leicester, along with the Village of Leicester and Hamptons Corners area of the Livingston County Water system have concerns about their water quality, they can contact the Livingston County Health Department at 243-7270.
