



FIREWORKS SAFETY

Sparkling devices are now readily available in New York State. Niagara County has legalized small sparkling devices. Orleans County has not legalized these devices. As they are now available to the public in other jurisdictions safety issues should be addressed.

The sparklers burn at approximately 2000 degrees. After they have burned down please dispose of the wire remnants properly. A small bucket with water is best. Avoid trash cans with combustible materials or paper products. The sparks given off by "showering fountains" can spark a grass fire. Please use care in placing the larger showering fountains on the ground. Ornamental grasses and mulch can hold a spark and flare up hours after the sparklers had been enjoyed.

As always firecrackers bottle rockets and roman candles are still illegal. If you choose to use these types of fireworks please be respectful of your neighbors. Follow the warning label; light fuse and get away. Do not hold the larger firecrackers in your hand.





- IF THERE IS A GENUINE SENSE OF URGENCY, say so. The words "We're moving," or "Must sell fast," suggest that readers respond immediately.
- 5 INCLUDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER. Classifieds get results fast and often generate immediate sales. If you cannot be available to answer the phone at all times, be sure to specify special calling times such as "after 9pm" or "before 11am."



A TRUST WITH RESTRICTIONS

When the person creating a trust has concerns about the spending habits of a beneficiary of that trust, a "spendthrift trust" may be created that provides an independent trustee with full authority to make decisions about how the trust's funds may be spent. The terms of the trust, which can be wide-ranging in possibilities, place the trustee in control of the trust property and of any benefit the beneficiary receives. The grantor must consider how much control to give to the trustee and describe the trustee's power in detail. The grantor must also decide how and when the trust will end, the status of the trust principal, if the beneficiary's circumstances change, and if special payouts are to be allowed.

The process of establishing a spendthrift trust fund is identical to creating any other trust fund except the trust instrument must contain a spendthrift provision. In 2015, analysts with the Government Accountability Office found that the average American between the ages of 55 and 64 had accrued roughly \$104,000 in retirement savings, a shockingly low figure that would make it very difficult for men and women nearing retirement to maintain their quality of life into their golden years. 



Finding Work After 50

Unemployment isn't easy for anyone, regardless of their age. But unemployed men and women over 50 may find it especially difficult to

Whether it's a by-product of age-related discrimination or any of a host of additional variables, jobless older workers often struggle to find work. In a 2016 analysis of government figures, the Schwartz Center for Economic Policy Analysis at the New School estimated that the jobless rate for workers 55 and older in August of 2016, six years after the Great Recession, was nearly 9 percent. At the time, the national jobless rate hovered around 5 percent.

Unemployed men and women over 50 who are struggling to find work can consider the following strategies as they look to rejoin the

- · Revisit your résumé. Unemployed men and women over 50 have no doubt updated their résumés to reflect their most recent professional experience. But they may need to trim some of the fat in regard to their work life 10 or more years ago. Today's hiring managers may only be concerned with recent experience that illustrates skill sets that are relevant to today's jobs. Men and women over 50 may consider their experience from 20 years ago invaluable, but if that experience does not meet the specific needs of the jobs they're now seeking, then they should remove it from their résumés so hiring managers can quickly access the more relevant information from their work histories.
- · Embrace 21st century job hunting. Finding a job in the second decade of the 21st century is unlike job hunting in decades prior, and wholly different from how men and women over 50 looked for jobs upon beginning their professional lives. Networking can mean the difference between unemployment and landing a job. Go to job fairs attended by hiring managers and join professional organizations that host events where professionals in your field can gather.
- · Turn your age into a positive. Men and women over 50 should accept the likelihood that their new managers and/or hiring managers will be younger than them. When interviewing for a job, men and women over 50 should make an effort to showcase their enthusiasm about working with and learning from younger colleagues, while also noting their desire to commit long-term to a company. Some hiring managers may surprise older applicants, viewing them as potentially more reliable than younger workers simply looking to gain some experience in a particular industry before moving on to the next opportunity.
- · Make use of your existing down time. Another strategy unemployed men and women over 50 can try as they look for work is to make better use of their existing downtime. Enrolling in online courses can give prospective employers the impression that applicants over 50 are both tech-savvy and willing to learn new things. Each of those things can help men and women over 50 overcome any unjustified, tech-related stigmas that hiring managers may attach to older job candidates.






