Wooden Uncle Sam

Uncle Sam wearing a blue tailcoat with stars, red striped pants, a red striped top hat and sporting a beard and goatee is not the first symbol for the United States, but probably is the best known today. Columbia was the first symbol, starting in 1738. She remained popular until the 1920s, but was not as favored as Brother Jonathan and Uncle

ated in 1916 for a recruiting poster by James Montgomery Flagg. The figure is pointing and saying "I Want You." Hundreds of homemade wooden Uncle Sam mailboxes have been made since World War I ended. This Uncle Sam figure is made of flat-shaped boards, but he is missing the tray for mail. He was sold by James Julia Auctions for \$533.

• What can you tell me about • Splashme dolls? I've seen these little seated figures online and would like to know who made them and how old they are.

A. Splashme dolls were designed in 1917 by Genevieve Pfeffer (1890-1985), who used "Gene George" as her business name. The doll's shape, with head in hands and elbows on knees, is based on Rose O'Neill's Kewpie doll "The Thinker." Splashme dolls also have similar large, side-glancing eyes. The dolls were made of bisque, composition or plaster of paris, had painted features and wore painted bathing suits and bathing shoes. They were first sold at beaches and vacation spots. Splashme dolls with a mohair wig or a scarf tied around painted hair were first made in 1918. Pfeffer also wrote books about the Splashme dolls. Splashme doll items included baby talcum containers, soap, party favors and postcards. The

dolls sell today for about \$35 to \$50.

Make sure all animals have 3. current identification to help reunite them with you in case of an accident. If your pet is microchipped, this would be a good time to make sure the notification information is still up-todate.

The wisest course of action is to assume your companion animal is going to suffer stress or discomfort and do what you can to protect them.







Genetic Screening May be Helpful for Some

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 62-year-old female who weighs 97 pounds and is 4 feet, 10 inches tall. I'm a non-smoker, non-drinker. I'm a mother of three, take no medications and have no medical issues except acid reflux

My brother died of Ewing sarcoma at 6. My 10-year-old sister died of dysgerminoma. Mom was diagnosed with colon cancer at 47 and died at 52. Dad died of pancreatic cancer at 81 after being in remission from prostate cancer for five years. On Mom's side, her sister and aunt also had colon cancer.

What screenings do I need? What screenings are needed for my two daughters, ages 41 and 43? My daughters' paternal grandmother died of breast cancer at 72. My other siblings, a 56-year-old brother and 68-year-old sister, are healthy. -- G.T.

ANSWER: With so many cancers in your family, I would strongly suggest a visit with a genetic counselor. The combination of colon, pancreatic and prostate cancer suggests a genetic syndrome, such as Lynch syndrome and BRCA I or 2, although your history isn't classic for either of these. There are many less-common familial syndromes that increase the risk for various cancers, and we are gradually increasing our knowledge of them.

Some of the cancers you mention are not associated with any known syndrome, such as Ewing sarcoma, a primary bone cancer, and dysgerminoma, a rare type of ovarian cancer. It's possible that your family has just been very unfortunate. Still, I would recommend getting more knowledge about any genetic risk you may have.

With this information, you can learn the right screening strategies for yourself, as well as obtain information that could potentially be valuable to your siblings and children.

DEAR DR. ROACH: At first the doctors thought my wife had myasthenia gravis. After a series of tests, it was determined that she did not have that disease. However, the neurologists now think she has mitochondrial myopathy. Can you tell us a little more about this disease, please? -- R.R.

ANSWER: Mitochondrial myopathies are a group of disorders of the mitochondria, which are responsible for the production of energy inside the cell. Almost all cells contain mitochondria, but muscle cells are loaded with them. Since they do so much of the energy consumption, muscles are most affected. These disorders used to be considered rare, but it is now thought that 1 in 10,000 people may have one of these disorders (which makes it uncommon, but not rare). Mitochondria come almost completely from the mother, and as a result, a family history of muscle problems in the maternal line suggests this diagnosis. Mitochondrial myopathies range dramatically in severity. They are diagnosed with a combination of blood testing, EKG (since some can affect heart muscle), EMG (a test of the electrical activity of muscle), muscle biopsy and genetic tests of the mitochondria. Unfortunately, I can't give you any details at all about prognosis or treatment, which require a specific diagnosis. Most of these have no specific treatment, though L-carnitine, coenzyme Q10 and creatine often are tried. Your wife's neurologists will give you more information.



"The American Success of an Odd Minority"

This time of year never fails to put a spring in my step and As for me, "least likely to a smile on my face. July 4th, to me, is one of the happiest times of the year. I am an avid student of history, and the story of how this great country came into being and quickly became the envy of the world is simply amazing to me. To see the freedom and opportunity it still offers to all makes me utterly grateful to be a citizen of this land.

I say this as an American and as an odd minority.

I was born in Florida in 1970, arrived in North Carolina two weeks later, grew up a Tarheel, and I am one quarter Lebanese, one quarter French, and one half Puerto Rican. This odd mixture generally results in my being regarded as a blue-eyed hillbilly with a perfect tan year round. But if one were to name my "people group," what would a Lebanese/French/Puerto Rican be called? I am, after all of these years of pondering, almost settled on "Lefrican." My only conundrum now is pronunciation. Should my people name rhyme with Leprechaun, or should it have a smoother flow, with the emphasis on the first syllable, and sound more like "Leffrikin"? One thing of which I am fairly certain is that my "people group" is very small indeed; I, like Louis L'amour's Joe Makatozi, am probably the last of my breed.

American. That is my people, that is my country, and I am grateful. My family on my maternal

side arrived here just after the Civil War, if I have traced it back correctly, and settled in Louisiana. My grandmother and grandfather met there.

succeed" would not have been a stretch. My mother was left with the unenviable task of raising me alone. I was a kid raised in a mobile home, I never received an inheritance from a rich relative, there was no father to guide me, the ingredients for disaster were there.

But the ingredients for success were as well.

My mother raised me in church, we were there every time the doors were open. I received Christ as my Savior while still a youth. I stayed in school, did not get into trouble with the law, started working at various odd jobs when I was thirteen years old, never stopped working, stayed away from drugs and drug users, never smoked, never drank alcohol, paid my way through college, stayed a virgin until marriage and then have stayed faithful to my wife ever since. All of that means I have never had to pay alimony or child support, have never had trouble finding employment since I have no criminal record, and have never had to beg for rides to and from work since I have never lost my license. For ten years I owned and operated my own small business.

I am not rich; I am a pastor. But I have done pretty well. In just a few years, if all continues to go well, our home will be paid off, we will be entirely debt free. I have traveled extensively and enjoyed life.

There is a point to all of this, and if you are clucking to yourself about my "bragging," then you have missed it

entirely. The point is, God has been good to me and to everyone else blessed to be an American. I grow weary, oh, so very weary, of people who cannot or will not see how grateful to God they should be just for getting to live here.


The children of Israel had been in bondage for 400 years in Egypt. God used Moses to deliver them, and they were free. Their life was not perfect, yet they were free, and they had the potential to be great.And yet, Numbers 14:4 says, "And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt." They were actually so ungrateful that they were willing to torpedo the future of their nation and go back into bondage.

America has never been and never will be perfect. No nation on the face of the earth ever was or ever will be. But unlike many nations, this one is largely what each individual makes it. In my 21 years of ministry I have seen the stark difference between those who have poor character and a poor work ethic and those who are up early, stay out of trouble, and make wise choices. 

VA Slashes Backlog of Claims Appeals

The Department of Veterans Affairs has announced a major reduction in the number of disability claim appeals that had piled up. This year it managed to clear 53,000 decisions, which is 86 percent more than the 28,000 the VA cleared during the same time last year. Its goal is to review 81,000 claims by the end of September.

How did the VA manage to finish so many claims when it couldn't manage it before? Part of the answer lies in the \$42 million that was used to hire 200 lawyers to write decisions, as well as 24 law judges. One wonders how many lawyers they originally had, before adding the 200. One also wonders, unfortunately, about the qualifications of the 200 lawyers they hired, and who reviewed their employment applications.

To avoid having your initial claim denied, get help with your first application. Start with a veterans' service organization. Look at www.benefits.va.gov/vso/varo. asp and click on your state for a list of organizations at your local Regional Benefit Office. The list includes the organizations, their location at the benefit office and their phone number.

To avoid being denied again during an appeal, your best bet is to get a lawyer, but beware. Be sure your lawyer is up to the task. Ask other veterans for references if they've gone the appeal route. Then ask the potential lawyer a lot of questions, like: How long have they done veteran appeals? Are they VA accredited? Since you'll no doubt pay a hefty fee (a portion of your benefits after you win) to a lawyer, be sure you're getting a good one. If you're getting years of back pay, that could add up to a lot of money you're handing over.



* Moving tip: Put books into suitcases, which often have wheels and good handles, in order to transport them. Books placed in boxes can get unbalanced when they don't fill the box efficiently. It makes them hard to carry and hard to stack, since you risk the corners crushing. But suitcases are easy to carry right to the shelf before unloading.

* Finding a bandage to cover a skinned knee or elbow is almost impossible. These can be a large or irregular area that doesn't fit under even the most generous of bandages, and adhesive bandages just don't stick well over a joint. Here's a tip for that: Apply antibacterial ointment generously, then cover the knee or elbow with a regular gauze pad. Then add a "sleeve" cut from a pair of tights. It moves with the joint without bunching up the way an ACE bandage does, and it stays in place.

* "After the kids decorated cupcakes one day, I found that the counter and floor were covered with little spilled sprinkles. They were the ball kind, and they were hard to pick up. * "To save money on electricity, hang jeans and other heavy clothing to dry first. When it's mostly dry, pop it in the dryer to fluff. Do the same with towels. The dryer softens it, but the sunlight dries it well, and I think it smells better too." -- U.F. in Ohio

* Some facts about cantaloupe, now in prime season: Choose fruit that is smooth and round, with a depressed, soft scar on the stem end. Look for netting on the skin that is even and yellow, not green. One cantaloupe will get you about 50 melon balls or 4 cups of fruit when diced.

INGREDIENTS

1/2 cup butter or margarine

2 cups sugar

2 cups water

1 teaspoon vanilla

2 cups self-rising flour

1/2 cup shortening

1/2 cup milk

5 cups chopped, pitted and peeled peaches or frozen unsweetened peach slices, thawed and chopped

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon1/4-1/2 teaspoon ground nutmegVanilla ice cream

DIRECTIONS

Place butter in a 3-quart rectangular baking dish and set dish in a 350 degrees oven to melt butter, allowing 5 to 8 minutes. (Be sure to watch carefully to avoid browning the butter). Remove dish from oven; set aside.

For syrup: In a medium saucepan, combine the 2 cups sugar and the water. Cook and stir over medium heat until sugar is dissolved; bring to boiling and boil, uncovered, for 5 minutes. Remove saucepan from heat; stir in vanilla. Cover and keep warm.

For dough: Place 2 cups flour in a large mixing bowl. Use a pastry blender to cut shortening into flour until pieces are pea-size. Make a well in center. Add milk all at once. Stir just until moistened. Knead dough on a lightly floured 14x12-inch piece of waxed paper 10 to 12 strokes or until nearly smooth. Lightly sprinkle dough with flour. Cover with another 14x12-inch piece of waxed paper. Roll out dough to a 12x10-inch rectangle (about 1/4 inch thick).

For filling: In another large bowl, combine peaches, cinnamon and nutmeg. Spoon 3 cups of the peaches on top of the melted butter in the baking dish, spreading evenly to form a single layer. Spoon the remaining 2 cups peaches evenly over the dough rectangle. Roll dough into a spiral, starting on a long side. Pinch seam to seal. Cut into twelve 1-inch-thick slices. Arrange rolls, cut sides down, over the peaches in the dish. Pour syrup carefully around rolls. (This will look like too much syrup, but the rolls will absorb the liquid during baking.)

Bake in the 350 degrees oven for 45 to 50 minutes or until golden. Cool on a wire rack 30 minutes. Serve warm with a scoop of vanilla ice cream.

6 Strategies to Encourage **Nutritious Snacking**



Skip the chips and improve your children's snack habits with these simple ideas for influencing healthier decisions:

- Enhance the visual appeal of foods by piercing them with decorative toothpicks
- Offer a variety of colorful foods on a plate.
- Create color contrasts with foods on a plate or in a bowl. Arrange foods in an orderly way using a bento box or divided plate that helps
- keep them separate. Involve kids in preparing their meals.


