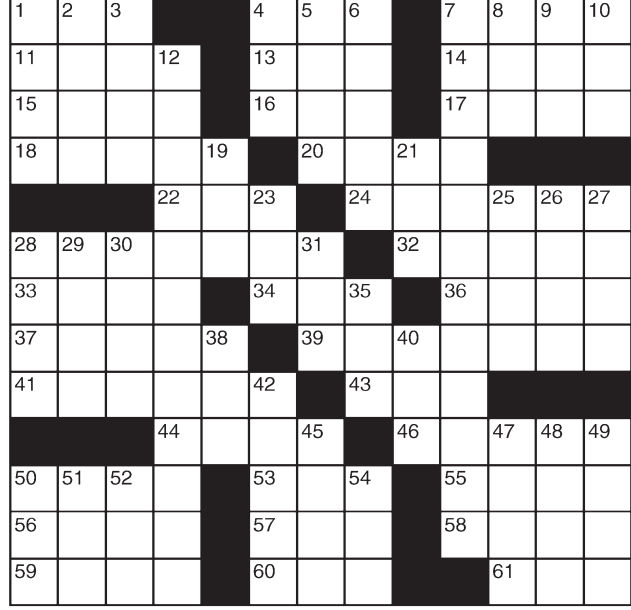



Discuss Slow Growth With Your Doctor

(NAPSA)—A child's normal growth is one of the key indicators of good health. Often, when a child doesn't grow at the same pace as his or her peers, parents just assume the child is a late bloomer, says Deborah Bowlby, M.D., a pediatric endocrinologist and expert in children's growth at the Medical University of South Carolina. But for some children, a slow growth rate is a sign of a growth disorder. Dr. Bowlby answers a few commonly asked questions about the problem.

Q: Why is it important to monitor a child's growth?

A: In general, healthy children grow. Your child's doctor should measure and plot both height and weight on a growth curve at every visit.

Q: What are some reasons a child may not be growing?

A: Children can have poor growth if they are not getting enough food or are unable to absorb nutrients from their food, as is the case with celiac disease. Children with chronic medical issues such as cystic fibrosis can also have poor growth. Some children have problems with their bones or have genetic conditions that cause them to be short. Hormone deficiencies can also cause poor growth.

Q: How are growth disorders diagnosed?

A: A pediatric endocrinologist should evaluate the child's growth pattern in the context of his or her family and stage of pubertal development. If a child is short and not growing well, baseline blood tests and a bone age X-ray (X-ray of left hand and wrist) may be ordered to

assess the child's potential for growth. In some cases, genetic tests may also be requested. If a hormone deficiency is suspected, a "stimulation" blood test may be scheduled to assess hormone levels.

Q: How are growth disorders treated?

A: Growth disorders are treated by treating the underlying condition. If a child has a nutritional issue, he or she may need to see a nutritionist or a gastroenterologist. When there is an underlying medical condition, the child may be referred to a pediatric subspecialist. If the child has a hormone deficiency, we replace the hormone that is missing.

Q: What advice would you give to parents who think their child may have a growth disorder?

A: If you think your child has a growth disorder, ask the pediatrician's office to plot his or her height and weight on a growth curve. Talk with the pediatrician about your child's overall health and whether he or she needs to be referred to a pediatric endocrinologist.

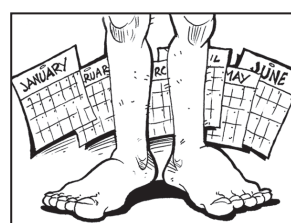

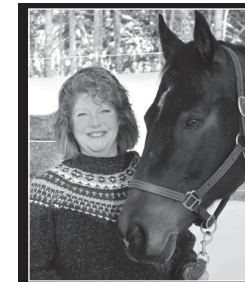

Deviled Eggs Are a Summer Perennial

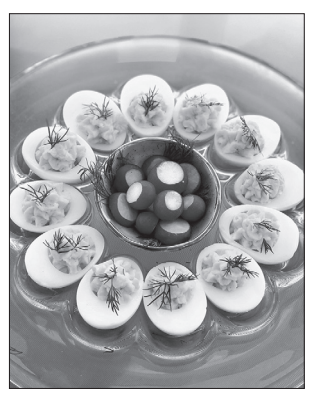
Nothing sparks memories of family picnics and barbecue get-togethers like a platter of bright yellow-and-white deviled eggs. Sometimes dressed up with a dusting of paprika, capers or fancy sprigs of garden dill and chives on top for the yum of it, they welcome all ages to the buffet table to taste and enjoy.

Deviled eggs are a homemade dish involving several steps. You may take a shortcut by buying pre-cooked and peeled hard-boiled eggs at some markets, but for most families, the basics begin with boiling the eggs just right.

Here's my standard method for making perfect hard-cooked eggs: Place eggs in a medium saucepan and cover with cold water 1 inch above the eggs. Bring to a full rolling boil on medium high heat (no lid). Turn off heat, cover the pan, and let eggs sit for 10 minutes. Immediately plunge the eggs in a bowl of cold water (I add a few ice cubes) to chill them rapidly so that the eggs eventually will release easily from the shell when peeling. Remove from water.

Refrigerate eggs or peel for this recipe.

- finely chopped scallions (optional garnishes)*
1. Cut eggs lengthwise in half and remove the yolks. Set whites aside on a serving platter.
 2. Mash the yolks in a mixing bowl with a fork or pastry blender. Stir in mayonnaise and seasonings, and continue to mix until smooth.
 3. Spoon or pipe mixture with a star tip (for a fancy presentation) into the egg-white halves, and dust with paprika, if desired.
 4. Let kids top with parsley, chives or scallions. Or, create a unique garnish using family favorites, such as sliced grape tomatoes, bacon bits, smoked salmon, pickle relish, capers or grated cheddar cheese.



Cook's note: Substitute mayonnaise with 3 tablespoons plain hummus, or make a half-and-half mixture of sour cream and Greek yogurt. Add a few drops of Tabasco or vinegar for an extra kick.

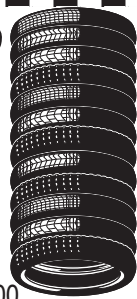

aging. In this case, the 5-10-20 fertilizer would have 5 percent nitrogen, 10 percent phosphorus and 20 percent potassium.

A balanced fertilizer such as 5-10-20 promotes strong roots for the fall and winter months.

Treating for Pests: Plants—like people—can get sick. For example, grass can suffer from environmental stress that creates conditions for pest pressure. If lawn disease strikes, medication treatments in the form of pesticides are required to nurse the plant back to health.

To control weed pests, such as dandelions and clover, sedges and grassy weeds including crabgrass, treat your lawn with a pre-emergent herbicide. As the name implies, pre-emergent herbicides inhibit weed growth before weeds emerge.

If weeds emerge over time, treat them with a postemergent herbicide. Always consult specific pesticide product labels for restrictions, rates, use sites and safety information. Learn more at www.betterturf.basf.us.

Gardens Growing As Green Alternatives To Lawns

(NAPSA)—You don't always need a lush lawn to make the neighbors green with envy. Sometimes, you don't need much lawn at all.

Gardens for homegrown food have been an important part of American homes from the early pioneers to World War II Victory gardens. Now, however, a recent survey has found that food gardens have re-emerged as a new technique to increase the sustainability of a home. Nearly one in five residential landscape architects is replacing part or all of traditional grass lawns with vegetable gardens, according to a survey by the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA).

"Plus, there's nothing more convenient or sustainable than homegrown food."

Food gardens can be easy, rewarding and sustainable. For starters, don't spend a dime on mulch when you can use leftover leaves. Additionally, grass clippings from other parts of your yard make an excellent weed suppressant.

Many classic vegetables such as tomatoes require starting from

seeds, but perennial plants offer a lower-maintenance alternative and come back every year. Some great examples include asparagus—especially the purple passion variety, with 20 percent more sugar than regular varieties—as well as blueberry bushes, blackberries and rhubarb.

Herbs can make for an especially sustainable food garden, as many prefer hot and dry areas of the yard, with chives, sage and tarragon returning every year. A great idea is to explore the many varieties of mint such as chocolate, marshmallow and fruit salad, which carry flavors that match their names.

Food gardens are one of many ways by which landscape architects can create a more sustainable, low-maintenance alternative to expensive grass lawns for homeowners.




