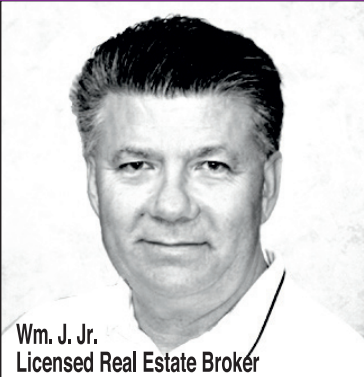

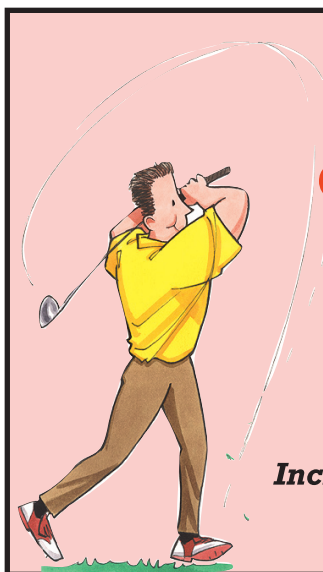

This year, the Wolf and Webelos dens worked together to plan, build, and install two Little Free Library boxes within the village of Nunda. They were able to present the idea to both the Nunda Town Board and Nunda Village Boards for approval, be involved in the collection of materials, planning the boxes, building, installing, and filling the boxes. By doing so, the boys learned all of the steps involved in a community service project, how to use the necessary tools, and had a lot of fun working together to achieve something they can be proud of every time they see it in the community.

Cub Scout Pack 4077 from Nunda has been in existence for 65 years. Cub Scouts is the family-oriented part of the Boy Scouts of America program where boys meet once a week to do fun activities with the goal of helping them learn to work with others while becoming self-reliant, dependable, and caring people. They get to participate in camping, hiking, building/racing model cars, field trips, and other projects that help their community and the people who live there.



Our hope is that the Little Free Library boxes will inspire a love of reading and creativity while building a sense of community. The Little Free Library boxes are located at the Nunda Government Center on the corner of State Street and Massachusetts Street, and in front of the Nunda Police Department at the corner of State Street and Mill Street. The boxes ask people to take a book and leave a book, so we are hoping that the project will continue to encourage community involvement where people can exchange or donate gently used books to keep the boxes full and encourage a continual variety of reading materials, while giving everyone the opportunity to enjoy a good book.

It was amazing to see how one project can encourage such a sense of community. Although both Nunda Lumber and Lowes offered to donate materials if the Scouts couldn't obtain all of them, the community gave donations so that business donations weren't needed.
