

## ALABAMA BUTTERMILK PIE WITH PECANS

#### **Ingredients**

- Pastry for singlecrust pie (9 inches)
- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1-3/4 cups sugar
- 3 eggs
- 3 tablespoons allpurpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- Sweetened whipped cream, optional

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 425°. On a lightly floured surface, roll dough to a 1/8-in.-thick circle; transfer to a 9-in. pie plate. Trim pastry to 1/2 in. beyond rim of plate; flute edge. Line un-pricked pastry with a double thickness of foil. Fill with pie weights, dried beans or uncooked rice.
- 2. Place on a baking sheet; bake 20 minutes or until bottom is lightly browned. Remove foil and weights; bake 1-2 minutes longer or until golden brown. Cool crust on a wire rack. Reduce oven setting to 325°.
- 3. In a large bowl, beat butter and sugar until blended. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in flour and salt.
