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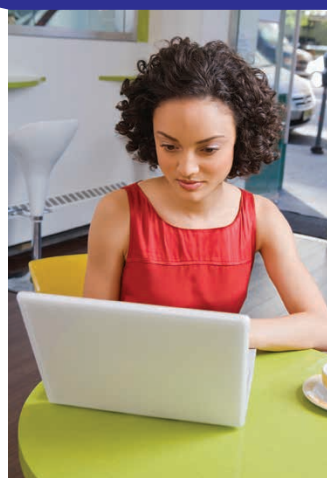
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Obituaries

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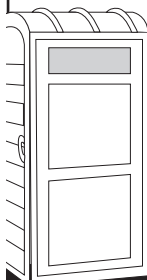
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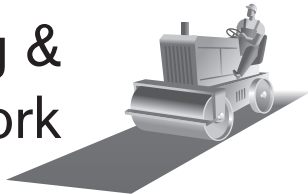
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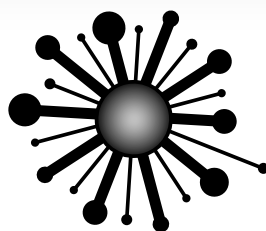
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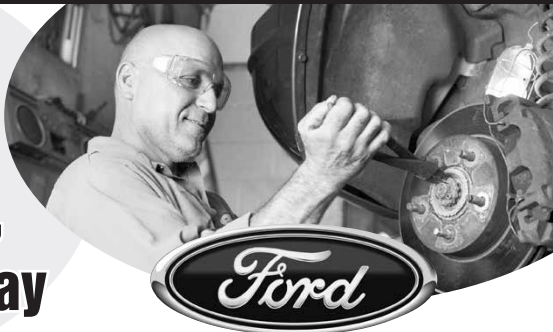
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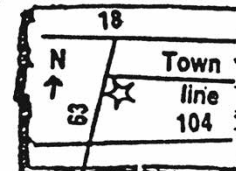
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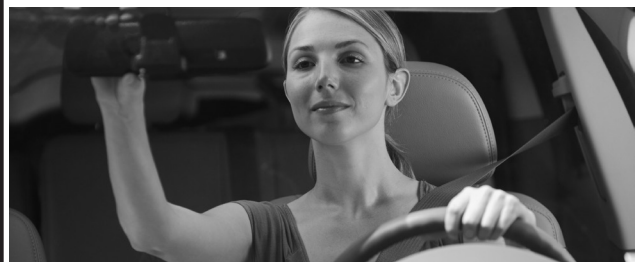
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MISUNDERSTOOD AND UNIQUE

They look really nasty but aren't.

Many people still think they are basically flying mice, like to get into folks' hair and are the major threat of rabies.

Actually bats are very beneficial in controlling insects especially many that are very unpleasant to us. A Brown Bat can devour up to 1200 mosquito-size insects in an evening.

During the summer I usually take a swim in the pond down at the cabin at the end of the day. Swimming around the pond, I can't help notice all the flying insects just above the water. However they never seem to multiple or become a problem. There is also about a dozen bats that are constantly flying back and forth just above the water catching these insects. Sometimes they buzz very close to my head, grabbing an insect before it grabs me but I have never had one hit, bite or get tangled in my hair (like I have enough to get tangled in!).

People think that bats flying close to their heads are trying to fly into their hair. Actually they are "homing in" on some insect that is attracted to the person.

I have found them so beneficial that I have put up several bat boxes near the pond to provide places for them to hide and rest during the day.

A close look at a bat will reveal a very unique wing structure. Four elongated fingers that compare to the "arm" bones in a bird's wing support their wings. The fifth finger or "thumb" has a small hook on the end of it that is used for climbing and walking on the ground. Yes bats will occasionally walk on the ground to seek food.

The wing covering is a double membrane of thin skin. This provides a very large wing surface for its weight and thus gives the bat incredible maneuverability.

If you have ever watched bats flying in and out around a street light you have seen how quick they can change direction to grab an insect.

The saying "blind as a bat" is also another misconception. They actually see quite well but flying in the dark has its limitations for catching small insects. Bats actually have a system similar to radar known as echolocation to aid them in this night hunting.

What the bat does is emit high-frequency sound pulses, which return or bounce back to the bat when they hit something. With their incredible hearing they are able to identify the object and its location.

The amazing thing about this system is that the bat is gathering information not just for one object but for all of the objects around it. This is what allows a bat to fly through a maze of branches, twigs and leaves to catch an insect without hitting anything.

Another myth about bats is that they can be the major carriers of rabies. Yes they can and do contract rabies and can transmit it to humans. How much of a threat is this? From 1980 to 1996 there were a total of 36 cases of human rabies that were diagnosed in the United States. Of these 21 were attributed to bats. Only two of these were from the Big Brown Bat and none from the Little Brown Bat (our two most abundant species). The Silver-haired Bat accounted for 15 of those 21 cases.

So why is it that bats cause human rabies more often than that from dogs, cats, raccoons or foxes? It maybe that people who receive minor bites or scratches from bats may not consider them serious, whereas people bitten by larger mammals go get rabies shots unless of course the animal proves negative for it.

Bats are the only mammals that fly, but they are not flying mice like many folks think. They are not even related to mice.

Another neat feature is that they are able to hang by their hind legs while roosting for even months. This allows them to see approaching danger and spring into flight. If we hang upside down for any length of time we would suffer very ill effects.

Bats usually have only one young per year but it weighs a quarter of its mother's weight when born (like a woman giving birth to a 30-pound baby)!

Some bats live for up to 20 or 30 years. During hibernation they can survive with a body temperature of only 23 degrees.

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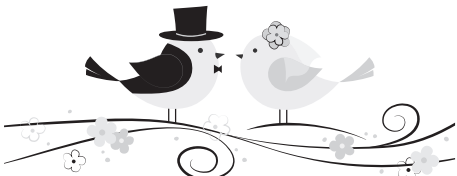
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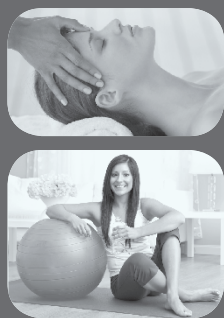
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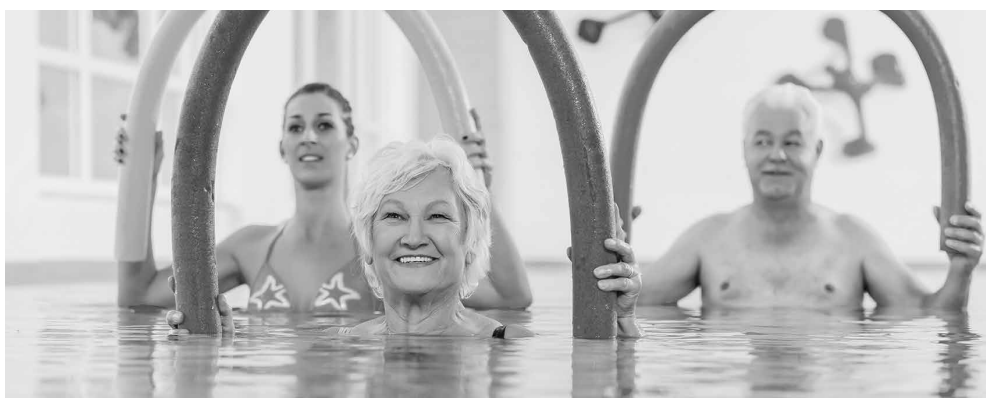
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Exercising Outside of the Box

- Say "bon voyage" to the conference room. Professionals who spend lots of time in meetings can add a simple twist that incorporates exercise into a typical business meeting. Rather than conducting the meeting in a conference room, propose a walking meeting when

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

1 Ask the person to **SMILE**.

2 Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.

3 Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.

4 Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking, dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

possible. A walking meeting is the same as a standard business meeting, but it's conducted on foot outside of the office. Many adults find they simply don't have the time to commit to routine exercise. But there are several simple ways to incorporate exercise into your existing routine without taking time from your already busy day. ■



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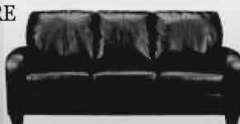
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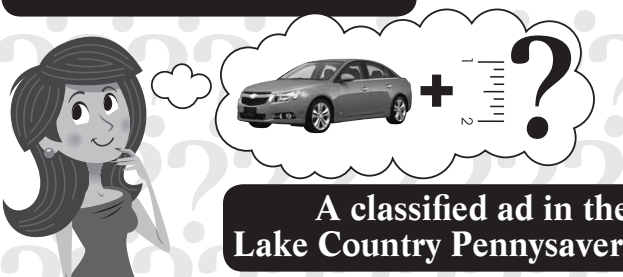
