adjusting blower components to provide proper system airflow; lubricating all moving parts; inspecting the condensate drain for clogs that can cause water damage, affect indoor humidity levels and breed bacteria and mold; checking thermostat settings and system controls to ensure proper and safe operation; and tightening all electrical connections and measuring voltage and current on motors.

Stay On The Road To Safety

(NAPSA)—The number of senior drivers on the road continues to rise. Have an emergency preparedness kit in the trunk that includes phone numbers to call in an emergency (relatives or neighbors, tow ing company, local garage or dealership), quart of motor oil, tire gauge, white cloth or sign that will help you signal for help, jumper cables, flashlight and

important to follow regular maintenance practices. Check the air pressure and condition of your tires and have them rotated. A good rule of thumb is to rotate them every other oil change. 

And to help control allergies and asthma, it has disposable HEPA dust filter bags that trap 99.95 percent of the dirt and germ particles that the vacuum kills and suctions from carpets.

The technology was tested by Dr. Charles P. Gerba from the University of Arizona, as well as Dr. Stanley Kikkert, the biotechnology program director at Mesa Community College, who used it to kill strands of E. coli and other bacteria.

Healthy Cleaning As more families look for nat-

ural ways to fight germs and allergens, UV-C light has become increasingly popular in household products ranging from toothbrush holders to knife blocks. Other chemical-free ways to keep microorganisms at bay include:
• Air It Out—Open a few win-

dows. The American Lung Association says circulating air can help prevent mold growth.

• Water Works—A portable

steam cleaner can blast germs and mildew off of bathroom walls and tile grout. • Zap It-Two minutes in the



Moments in time

- On Aug. 5, 1957, "American Bandstand" goes national on television, hosted by 26-year-old Dick Clark. He pushed hard for a 3:30 p.m. time slot, when teenagers were out of school and most likely to watch.
- On Aug. 3, 1988, Soviet authorities free Mathias Rust, the daring young West German pilot who landed a rented Cessna on Moscow's Red Square in 1987, from a labor camp as a goodwill gesture to the West.
- On July 31, 1990, Nolan Ryan wins the 300th game of his career. A believer that pitching power, as well as consistency and endurance, comes from the legs, not the arms, Ryan ran every day.
