PIEDMONT PETS

In 1992, shortly after I began working for the humane society, I received a call from a man who said he had heard a dog barking in the woods behind his house for several days, but he didn't hear the barking anymore. An animal control officer went to the address, and found the body of a dog. The dog's chain had become entangled in bushes, and he simply starved to death. At that time, I was more protected from such things, and was haunted by that story. The officer (at that time, Animal Control officers were police officers with that special assignment) told me I should work on making it illegal to keep dogs on chains. The task seemed too great at that time. Through the years, the officer kept asking when something was going to be done about keeping dogs off chains.

A first step we took to help chained dogs was about 20 years ago when the board changed the adoption guidelines to not permit adopted dogs to be kept on chains. A couple of years after that, City Council approved an ordinance that prohibits dogs from being chained at empty houses.

In 2009, City Councilman Adam Tomer introduced legislation to prohibit tethering under certain conditions. We gave a PowerPoint presentation at a City Council working session, showing horrible pictures of the dogs with embedded chains, the skeletal ones, the ones who died from heatstroke or strangulation, the ones who were hanged jumping over fences, and the ones who had been attacked by other dogs. That ordinance was passed, enacted, and enforced.

After Mr. Tomer was re-elected to Council, he contacted me and asked if we needed to strengthen the ordinance. Working with Animal Control Officer Jessica Hodges, suggestions were made. The changes were presented during a work session and at the

regular Council meeting on July 17th, they passed with a unanimous vote. The ordinance in the City of Danville now has the following provisions:

- No companion animal can be chained for more than 2 hours in a 24 hour period.
- If the temperature is 32 degrees or below, 85 degrees or greater, or if there is severe weather advisory, no companion animal can be chained.
- No companion animal under the age of 4 months can be chained at all.
- No sick or injured companion animal can be chained.
- No female companion animal in heat can be chained.
- Companion animals cannot be chained to a fixed point during the 2 hours.
- Violation of this ordinance is a Class 4 misdemeanor, with subsequent violations a Class 2 misdemeanor. With subsequent violations, the animal is subject to seizure.

It may have taken about 26 years, but through baby steps, Danville now has a progressive anti-tethering ordinance that could be the model for other localities.

Chinese Porcelain

Chinese porcelains are among the hardest for an average collector to identify and date. They have been made for centuries, and it is considered a tribute — not an attempt to fool a customer — to copy a piece perfectly, including the original mark. Unfortunately, today there also are some

ic book figures. The name Cranch is in block letters, and the usual Rookwood marks also are on the bottom. It is yellowish-white with black lines. Who is Cranch?

A. E. P. Cranch was a lawyer in Cincinnati who also was working for the Rookwood pottery from its beginning, as well as a poet, a storyteller and an artist. Cranch used the words and often humorous pictures of activities described in ballads and folklore. He remembered a ballad sung to him by Noah Webster's nephew 50 years earlier and wrote it down and illustrated it. Cranch seems best-known for his Rookwood pieces decorated with the Uncle Remus stories. His art appears on beer mugs, pitchers, jugs, plates, bottles and vases, most made in the 1880s. Although they are very different in style than most early Rookwood, with colored glazes and realistic decorations of flowers or perhaps Indian portraits, Cranch's work sells quickly. A 6 3/4-inch-high Cranch jug sold recently for \$1,610. It was decorated with scenes and the words of the poem "Three Wise Men of Gotham Went to Sea in a Bowl."

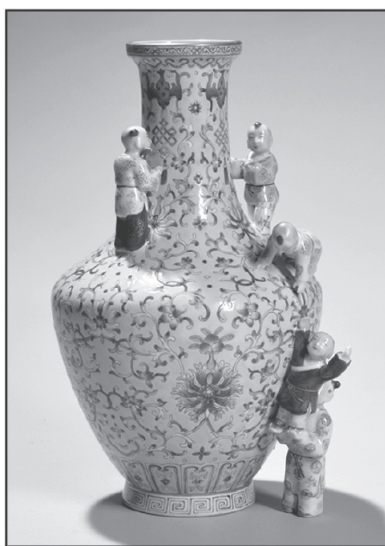

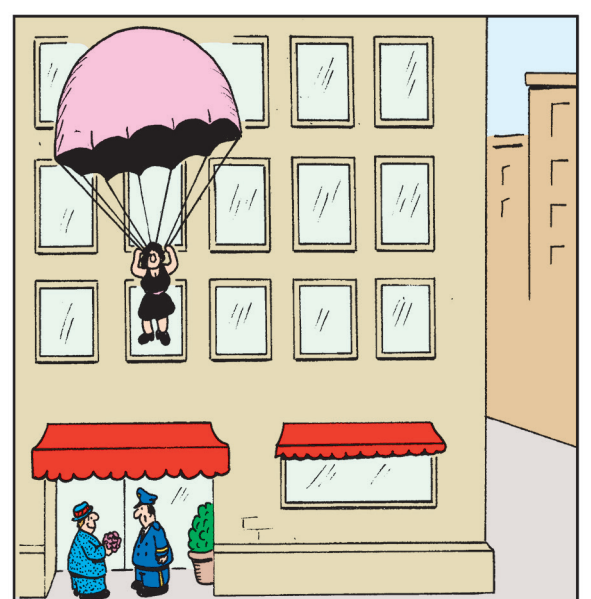

Know the ABCDE's of Melanoma

DEAR DR. ROACH: In 1976, I had a mole on my right calf about the size of a pencil eraser. A biopsy showed it to be melanoma, and they thought they had removed all of the cancer, but they did another surgery to be sure that I was cancer-free. I am a natural redhead and never sunbathed or used a tanning bed. It has been 38 years, and I am still cancer-free. I get a skin check from my dermatologist every six months. At the time of my diagnosis, my family doctor said that if the melanoma spreads inside the body, "the ball game is over." Is that still true? I know melanoma can be deadly. -- W.K.

ANSWER: Melanoma is the most commonly lethal skin cancer. Although there have been some exciting new developments in treating advanced melanoma, the survival rate for stage IV melanoma, where the cancer has spread to internal organs, is only 15 percent to 20 percent at five years.

Fortunately, the survival rate for melanoma caught early, at stage I, is greater than 90 percent, which is why it's so important to know the ABCDE's of melanoma recognition:

- A: Asymmetry -- one half looks different from the other half;
 - B: Border -- the border in a melanoma is often irregular, not a near-circle;
 - C: Color -- melanomas usually are not a uniform color, like most benign lesions. Some areas are light brown, others brown-black, others red or pale;
 - D: Diameter -- greater than 6 millimeters, the eraser on a standard pencil;
 - E: Enlargement or Evolution -- any change in color, shape, size or symptoms (including bleeding).
- Any of these should prompt a visit to your regular doctor or a dermatologist. As an internist, these are the features I look for, and I have a very low threshold for sending suspicious lesions to my colleagues in dermatology.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am wondering how safe "energy drinks" really are. My daughter is a recovering alcoholic, sober for three plus years, but she has at least five of these drinks a day. Can they be good for her, or are they another addiction? -- N.N.

ANSWER: I've recommended against energy drinks in previous columns due to the whopping amount of sugar they contain. However, I am going add another reason: Using this large a number of energy drinks constitutes a potentially dangerous caffeine intake. There has been at least one related death -- a young man consumed seven or eight energy drinks and suffered a heart attack.

This obviously is a rare event, and caffeine is generally safe at reasonable doses, but "at least" five a day is way too much caffeine. Depending on the brand, five cans would contain perhaps 800 mg of caffeine (about a half-gallon of brewed coffee), and 270 grams of sugar (over a third of your entire day's recommended calories and over a week's worth of sugar). I can't comment on "addiction," but I certainly would strongly recommend that your daughter reduce her consumption.

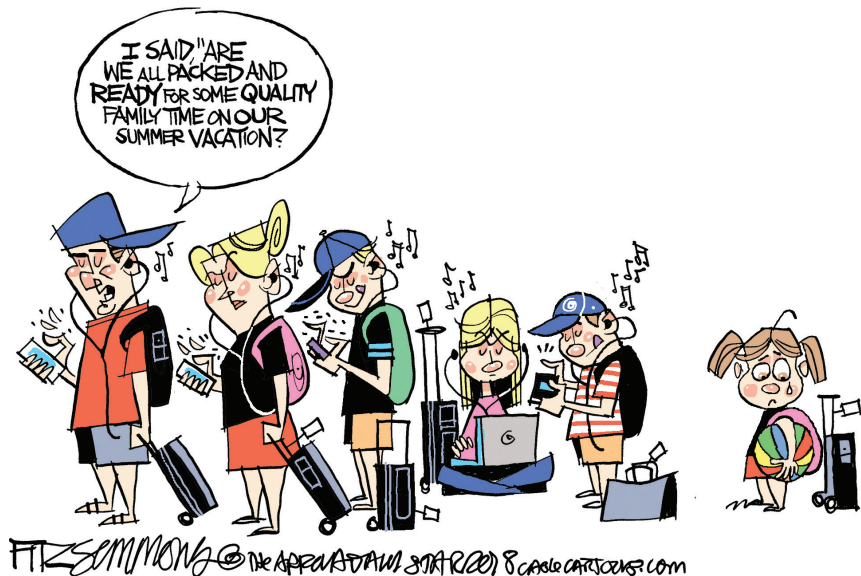

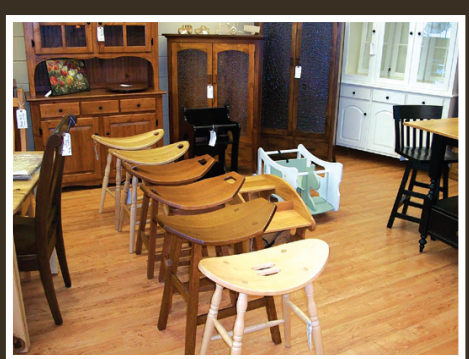

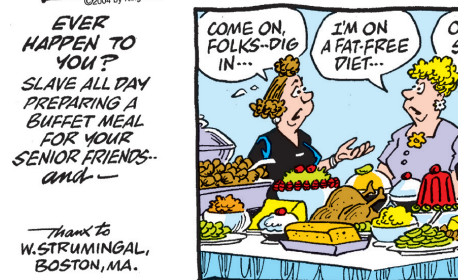
John 8:12 says, "Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."

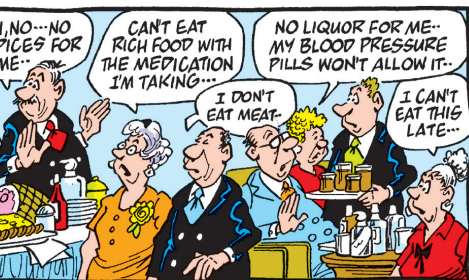
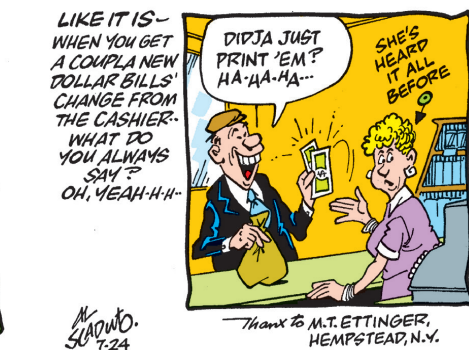
There is light in Jesus. There is a remedy for the darkness. You do not have to shiver in the cold of sin, there is a much better way.

Thermostats

While servicing or replacing an HVAC system may be the obvious change when it comes to conserving energy, you can also see reductions by using an upgraded thermostat, such as a "smart" or connected model. These devices can help you monitor the temperature setting in your home while maximizing efficiency. For example, a connected thermostat that's synced to your smartphone may allow you to adjust temperature settings when away from home. This way, if you forget to bump the air conditioner up a few degrees while you're gone more than a few hours, you can log-in remotely and set an appropriate temperature.

Weatherproofing

A great deal of energy is lost through cracks, holes and faulty seals. Take time to assess all windows, doors and openings for air leaks, adding caulking or weather stripping where needed. Don't overlook culprits like openings around lighting and plumbing fixtures, switch plates and other electrical elements. Also assess potential losses from the fireplace, attic, garage and crawl spaces, where it's common that less attention is given to thorough sealing, and determine whether additional insulation can help contain energy.



UNDERSTANDING HVAC EFFICIENCY RATINGS

An HVAC system can be rated in a number of different ways. While some of these ratings may be confusing, it is helpful to understand what they mean.

AFUE: An Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) rating is important if you are purchasing an oil or gas furnace. The AFUE rating measures the amount of fuel used to heat your home against the amount of fuel wasted. A higher rating indicates a more efficient system. The more efficient your system, the less fuel it takes to heat your home, which translates into lower heating bills during the winter.

SEER: The higher the Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER), the more efficient your system and the less it will cost to heat and cool your home. Federal regulations require all new HVAC systems to have a SEER rating of 13 or higher.

HSPF: The Heating Seasonal Performance Factor (HSPF) measures the efficiency of a heat pump when it is used to heat a home. A higher rating indicates greater efficiency and greater monthly savings on energy bills. New HVAC units are required to have a rating of 7.7 or higher.

Take Control of Your Climate

Managing your home's climate control is typically no small task or small expense. These options offer flexibility and efficiency.

Heat pumps pull from the ground or outside air temperature to both heat your home in the winter and cool it in the summer. Since heat pumps move heat instead of generating it, they're energy-efficient year-round.

Hybrid systems or combination systems combine elements of both a furnace and heat pump.

The more efficient heat pump runs until the outside air temperature falls below a certain level, at which point the system automatically switches the heat source to the furnace. This option is more expensive up front, but can generate significant savings in terms of monthly utility bills long-term.

Ductless systems are a flexible, efficient choice for homeowners looking for simple solutions. These systems can be easily mounted on the wall or ceiling, and don't require ductwork, making them ideal for a converted attic space or room addition.

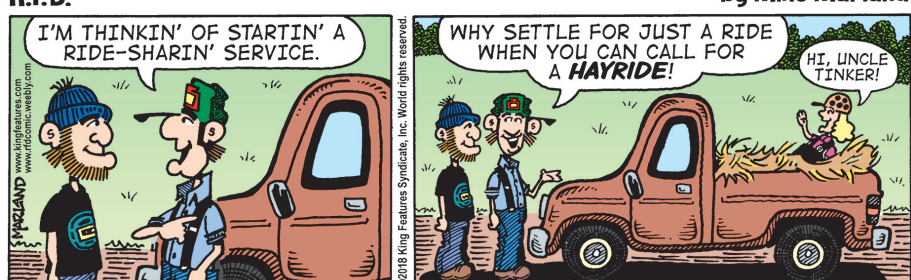

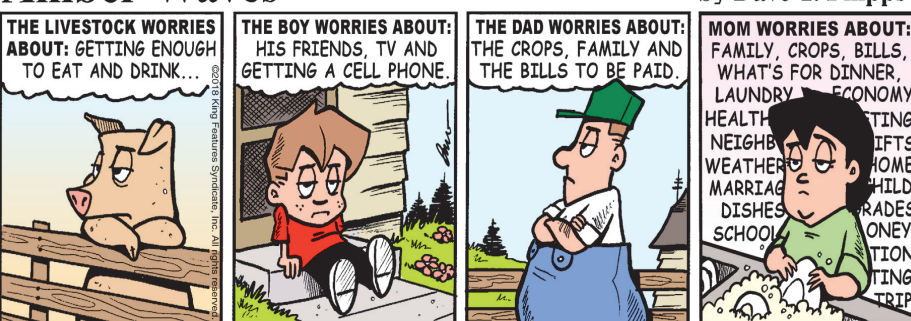
