Responders search for Murdoch Edward Crust, 13, of Minneapolis, in Armour No. 2 mine pit lake near True North Base Camp in Crosby on Saturday, July 21.

The Crow Wing County Dive Team recovered the body of a 13-year-old Minneapolis boy Saturday, July 21, from the bottom of Armour No. 2 mine pit lake, located in the City of Crosby in Crow Wing County.

On Friday, July 20, at 7:33 p.m. the Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office received a report of a possible drowning that had occurred in the mine pit lake. Murdoch Edward Crust had been swept away in the current of the inlet from Serpent Creek, while trying to retrieve a Frisbee.

In addition, brief but heavy rain on Friday evening accelerated and strengthened water current of the creek. That coupled with the fact that the lake bottom in the area drops off quickly from one foot down to 20 feet and then down to 92 feet, contributed to the accident.

The Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office responded boat and water units, the dive team with assistance from the Crosby Police Department and the Minnesota State Patrol Helicopter. The Search was called off at approx. 10:15 p.m. on Friday due to uneven and hazardous terrain beneath the water's surface.

The search for Crust's body resumed at 7 a.m. on July 21. Using side scan sonar, the

to search for Crust with boy's body was discovered and recovered from water 92 feet deep near where he was likely swept away by the strong current, according to the sheriff's office.

The boy's body was transported to the Ramsey County Medical Examiner's Office for autopsy.

The victim was visiting the area with his family and was staying in a cabin at True North Base Camp.
