





Dear "Speak Out"

The Mount Morris Village government has been advertising for a Part-time Police Chief. Not only is this idea right up there with some of their more ludicrous ideas, but it is a monumental insult to all parties involved.

Chief Mignemi has served this village as Police Chief for several years and is now planning to retire. As a native son, he has been a loyal and hardworking Public Servant and given back to his community. He has lead a group of fine police officers who are professional and compassionate and who care about the citizens of this community. What a slap in the face to him to imply that any organization involved with the public so directly can be run appropriately on a part—time basis. What a punch in the guts of the police officers who provide safety and protection while risking their own lives every day.

There's a lot of crime in this village. There are places in this village that you shouldn't be walking around in. That was never the case when I was growing up here, nor when my mother was growing up here or her mother before her. Not only are we a major thoroughfare for all the tractor-trailers in Western New York to come speeding through Main Street, putting us all in danger because the Village Government sold our collective soul to the devil that is New York State, but we are also a major pipeline for drugs. The recent drug arrests made by the Livingston County Drug Task Force included 5 people from Mount Morris. What a dubious honor. The unsavory characters that keep moving into the village are living here first to be closer to their Welfare checks and services at DSS on Murray Hill, and/or to be closer to their unfortunately incarcerated loved one who is a guest at one of our fine New York State facilities in nearby Sonyea. They have no interest or loyalty to Mount Morris. Nor do they pay taxes. The old, established families who have lived here for generations, and made MM "The best Town by a Damsite" are paying the taxes and deserve a safe and reasonably crime free existence. These are the hardworking people who deserve a Full-time Police Chief whose purpose is to manage, instruct, inspire, inquire, understand, interact, and direct police officers and the public into peaceful coexistence, and the Village Fathers just kicked them all in the teeth.

And IF there is a candidate who is willing to manage and operate a decent and functional Police Department, while being available 24/7 and most likely required to jump at every finger snap of the Village Fathers and get half the pay of what is most likely not much pay anyway, I doubt if said candidate will be able to function from beneath that bus under which the Village Fathers has already thrown them.

I wish Chief Mignemi well in the next chapter of his life and I pray for the rest of us.

Newly Renovated County Auditorium



June 19, 2018 was a special day in Mount Morris. A special ribbon cutting ceremony was held to rededicate the newly renovated Auditorium within Building 1 of the Murray Hill County Campus in Mount Morris.

The County Auditorium is part of a system of buildings that were originally completed in the 1930's as a NY State-run Tuberculosis Hospital. Livingston County acquired the campus of buildings in 1971 and has since worked to restore many of the buildings to house various county departments such as the Department of Health, Office of the Aging and Social Services.

The Auditorium facility is one of the final renovation projects to be completed on campus.

The ribbon cutting ceremony featured an introduction by David LeFeber, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and a brief historical review of the Murray Hill Campus by County Historian Amie Alden. Judith Berman, who resided on Murray Hill during her youth while her father was the Superintendent of the hospital, reminisced about those years and how special it was to grow up in such a unique place. Mrs. Berman was thrilled to see the newly renovated auditorium and thanked the County for maintaining the campus on the hill. Closing remarks were given by County Administrator Ian Coyle thanking the County Central Services Department for the many hours of work they put into the renovations.





Music was provided by the Mount Morris High School Jazz Band offering the audience a glimpse of the possibilities that could be featured in this versatile space. The County plans to use the space for conference type events and also intends to offer access to local organizations and the general public. Creating a unique venue for assemblies, conferences, celebrations and other performances, the Auditorium will provide a space unlike anything currently in the County.
