Macomb Intermediate School District: Helping Special Education Students Succeed



The Macomb Intermediate School District (MISD) has been servicing students with special needs for over 70 years. The MISD's special education staff advocates for families, works with community partners and are enthusiastic champions for all students. "We have a strong team that helps families in many ways beyond the typical school day," says Justin Michalak, assistant superintendent for Special Education and Student Services. Disabilities can include autism, deafness, blindness, learning disabilities, developmental delays, emotional impairments,

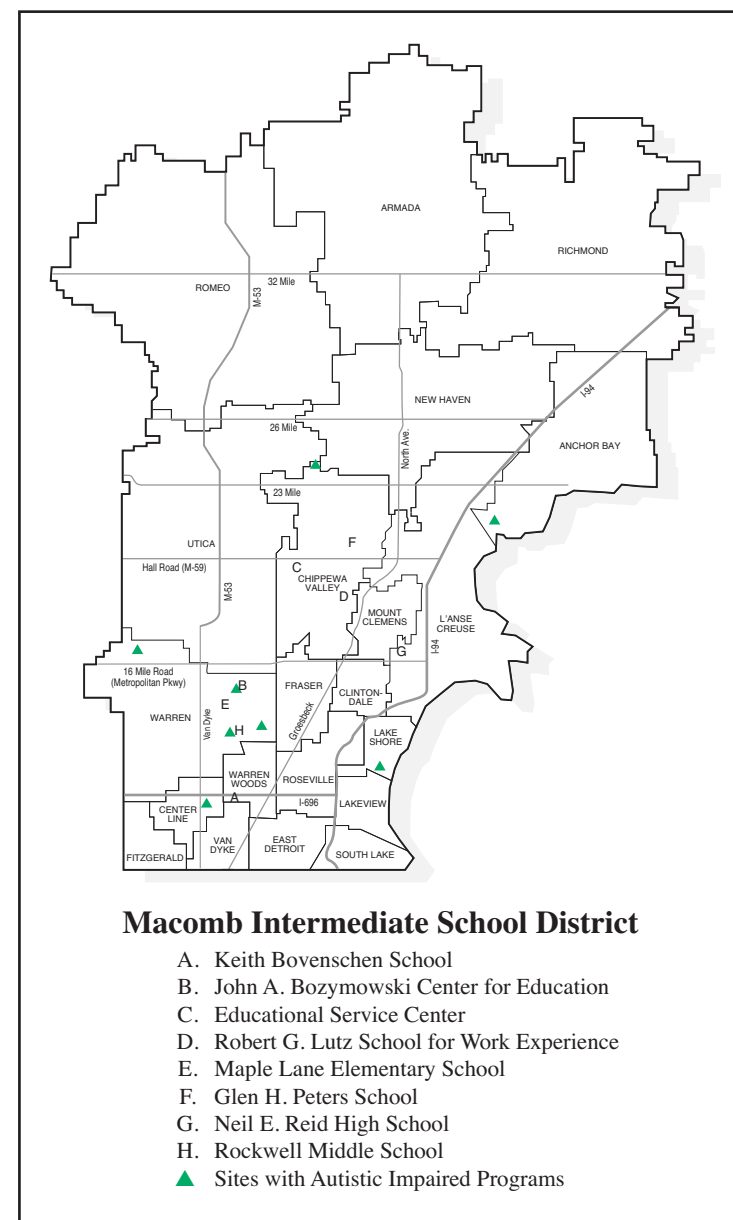
chronic health conditions, physical disabilities, speech or language impairments and more. In the past several years, Autism is the most rapidly increasing diagnosis for children. There is also an increase in children born prematurely that may also need services from the MISD.

Programs and services start from birth through age 26. The earlier a child is assessed for an emotional, cognitive developmental or physical disability, the sooner early intervention services can be implemented. Students at all ages and learning challenges are

provided with comprehensive programming based on their individual needs.

A connection to the community is key for families. Parents and caregivers need to know that they have a partner with the MISD's staff and services. "It's critical to provide support for families, said Mr. Michalak. We connect them with community resources. That close-knit community is where Macomb County shines as local leaders and businesses support the MISD's efforts in a variety of ways."

In addition to providing



academic support, the MISD is charged with handling administrative services, which includes working with the Michigan Department of Education, collecting assessment data, staff training, coordinating

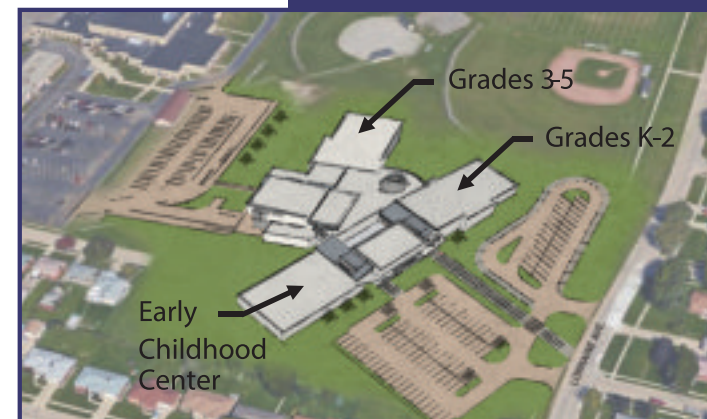

Students Benefit from "Real World" Experiences at South Lake Schools



21st century jobs require 21st century skills.

South Lake Schools continues to prepare students for success in the competitive workforce they will face following graduation in a safe, innovative environment focused on student safety. Students enrolled in South Lake Schools learn to be global citizens through participation in on site dual-enrollment, STEM, and Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs and activities. South Lake students develop lifelong skills through clubs such as First Robotics (SLHS) and the First Tech Challenge (SLMS). Once in high school, students can learn career skills in our state-of-the-art Auto Tech and Culinary Arts classrooms, including our brand new student-run restaurant the South Lake Bistro!

Students earn Wayne State University credits while enrolled at South Lake High School.

South Lake High School students may enroll in dual enrollment classes through Wayne State University without ever leaving the high school campus. Students enrolled through Wayne State University receive three (3) credits per course upon successful completion at a cost of less than \$100 per course.

Global citizens contribute to the development of shared values and practices.

Students in the Global Studies program at South Lake Middle School learn about the world through classes in Mandarin and Spanish, in addition to global connections made in the core content classes. Students learn the language of other people, learn about different cultures, and interact with students from other parts of the world. South Lake Middle School has an exchange program through our partnership with the Xian Greenwich School in Xian, China. Students from Xian visit South Lake Middle School in the fall and our students visit China in the spring.

Students engage in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) experiences through a partnership with the Wayne State University College of Nursing.

South Lake High School students have the opportunity for an hour of after school academic support, followed by an hour and a half of activities that focus on 21st century skills. Students also have exclusive opportunities to attend camps at Wayne State University and learn what it is like to be in college.

South Lake Schools continues its focus on student safety with up-to-date facilities and transportation opportunities for all students

Through our bond passed by the South Lake community, we updated all school buildings with secure entryways, card-only access doors, and added additional security cameras to maintain a safe environment. Summer bond projects include parking lot enhancements with improved drop-off and pick-up areas for students. All SL students also have access to transportation to and from school.

Macomb County K–12 public school enrollment has remained constant at 135,000 students during the population downturn in the state over the past decade. People are moving to Macomb County because of quality education offered by our schools, affordable housing, and safe neighborhoods. Some highlights of superior programs and supporting services from the 21 local school districts and the MISD for Pre K–12 public education in Macomb County are:

- Services for over 19,000 special education students (ages birth–26) in collaboration with and support from the MISD.
- Great Start Readiness Programs for over 3,500 identified 4 year olds in all districts with leadership from the MISD.
- Two International Baccalaureate Programmes for 1,000+ students in grades 9–12 that are open to all county students.
- Early College of Macomb partnership between the MISD on behalf of the public school districts in Macomb County and Macomb Community College. Enrollment in this program is 700+ students (grades 11–13) from throughout the county. General Motors partners with this program by offering a Design and Development Academy.
- Four Math/Science Centers supported by all districts where students may attend either partial or full days.
- Over 250 award-winning Career Technical Education Programs offered and supported by all districts with leadership from the MISD. Manufacturing Day for high school students – largest participation in the country.
- Programs and tutorial services for English Language Learners in over 110 languages in collaboration with the MISD.
- Programs for guidance and support in the areas of health, safety, crisis management and drug-free schools in collaboration with the MISD.
- Collaboration between local districts and the MISD related to business processes.
- Collaboration with local districts and the MISD to operate consolidated technology services for over 17 years. Key shared services include Internet access and content filtering, web site and application hosting, electronic mail, and help desk services for **all** districts. Professional development for blended and distance learning opportunities is also available.
- Professional development opportunities that are evidence-based. These are developed and implemented by the MISD and provided for administrators, teachers, and support staff throughout the county.



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
