





In November of 2010, Rick and Cathie Barry (aka Side-by-Side Productions) inquired through Louise Wadsworth if Greg O'Connell might have a small space to rent on Main Street, Mount Morris for the following summer. Their hope was to not only bring quality entertainment to the community, but to encourage the summer traffic passing through town to stop. Once they did, they could then see a show or a concert, and maybe even shop or dine in the newly established (and long-established) local businesses.

When they subsequently met for a lunch, O'Connell surprised them by offering the use of 101 Main Street as a venue without any cost to them. He hoped such a space would do for Mount Morris what he had seen the arts do in other places he had helped develop: be the attraction that creates business opportunities for others.

As it was way more than they needed or wanted to manage, they reluctantly accepted his offer. When Greg handed Cathie the key with its tag that read "101",

she got an idea. She walked home and asked Rick "How about 'Theatre 101' as a name?" And the rest, as they say, is history.

Louise asked if they could prepare something for Christmas in Mount Morris (about three weeks away at the time) so they began casting and rehearsing their first production there, Truman Capote's "A Christmas Memory." It was performed five times for FREE over the two weekends including Christmas in Mount Morris. But first, on December 4, 2010, they set up the 50 folding chairs that came with the building and hosted the kickoff of the Angels in Mount Morris event, with over 200 people attending!




They have since hosted more events than they can name (literally 100s), including (but not limited to) plays, musicals, concerts, children's plays and musicals, acting classes ending with performances, quilt shows, craft shows, benefits (they helped raise \$5225 for Red Hook, Brooklyn after Hurricane Sandy in 2012!); annual Bob Dylan Birthday Bashes, 101st birthdays: Lucy, Tennessee Williams, Dylan Thomas and others; a year-long celebration of Charles Dickens at 200, the World Premiere and encores of their *Beautiful Dreamer*, eight annual workshops and shows with ARC Drama Club; Idol Contest preliminaries (both for Italian Fest and ARC); and always their First-Thursday-of-the-Month Open Mic, which became one of the most popular in the area for musicians and performers.

As they look back at their Wall of Fame, they realize that more than 75% of their events were FREE and open to the public, usually with refreshments provided! They have a small core of fabulous supporters who have donated advertising, money, treats, toilet paper, and much more, but most importantly, they CAME to Theatre 101 to enjoy whatever they had to offer.

For the other 99% of Mount Morris citizens, they're sorry you missed it. It was grand, and they are still so grateful for the opportunity given them by Greg O'Connell to serve their community, and the folks who kept them going for these 7 1/2 years.

Their plea: **SUPPORT** your local businesses. **GO** to their places, shop, eat, drink, play, **TALK** about it to others! The Barrys wish all the best for the future of Mount Morris.

Al Lorenz Park is an 80-acre county park in Mount Morris, located between the Genesee River and Letchworth State Park. Facilities located in the park include four open pavilions, two gazebos, a 1.5-acre mowed field, numerous ponds and biking and walking trails. The acreage was acquired by Livingston County and became the County's first park on July 14, 1974.

SHINGLES

Almost 1 out of every 3 people in the United States will develop shingles, also known as herpes zoster, in their lifetime. There are an estimated 1 million cases of shingles each year in this country. Anyone who has recovered from chickenpox may develop shingles; even children can get shingles. However, the risk of shingles increases as you get older.

Some people have a greater risk of getting shingles. This includes people who have medical conditions that keep their immune systems from working properly, such as certain cancers like leukemia and lymphoma, and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), and receive immunosuppressive drugs, such as steroids and drugs that are given after organ transplantation.



Most people who develop shingles have only one episode during their lifetime. However, a person can have a second or even a third episode. The only way to reduce the risk of developing shingles and the long-term pain from postherpetic neuralgia (PHN) is to get vaccinated. There are two shingles vaccines currently available to prevent shingles and its complications for adults over 50 years of age. Shingles vaccines are available in pharmacies and doctor's offices. Talk with your healthcare professional if you have questions about shingles vaccination.
