For a little more than half of the 1980s, I lived in Utah. I worked at Brigham Young University for over three years, moved back to Danville for a few years, and then moved back to Provo where I worked at a bank for a few years. Danville, though, called me back and I answered.

When my niece, Jenny, graduated from high school and was accepted at BYU in 1993, I was the natural choice to fly to Utah with her and help her learn her way around. My Utah friends and I went to a favorite park and had a cook-out. While there, we all noticed a dog on a chain. He had a broken down doghouse, but it was his body language that haunted me. He was lonely. He had completely worn a circle in the ground. His entire life consisted of that small little radius of chain, dirt, and loneliness.

My friends all commented, "Someone should do something." Have you ever heard yourself or someone else say that? Who is the "someone" who needs to do "something?"

What should you do if you see an animal that you believe is being neglected? The answer always is – call the authorities. Maybe nothing can be done, if the legal minimum standards of care are being done. However, perhaps your phone call is the one hope for help that animal has.

In Danville, if the animal control officer

is off-duty, regular police officers investigate the complaints of neglect or pick up strays and injured animals. Call 799-5111, and press 8 to reach the animal control dispatcher.

Pittsylvania County does not have 24 hour a day, 365 days a year help, unless it is an emergency, but you must still call 432-7937 so at least the animal control officers will know that there may be an animal in need.

In my mind's eye, I can still see that hopeless dog. He has been dead for many years now, but I hope that the phone call I made when I returned to Virginia two days after the picnic brought him some relief.

Maybe you can be the "someone" who does a life-saving or life-altering "something" for the animals.

Bell Toys

Bell toys, a type of pull toy that had moving parts that rang a bell, were made in America just after the Civil War. The Gong Bell Co. of Connecticut made the first one. It was an iron four-wheel platform, holding a bell and an animal. The animal kicked or hit the bell when the platform moved. A popular bell toy featured an elephant that stepped on the bell to make it ring. The 9-1/2-inch-long toy is made of decorated metal. It was estimated to be worth about \$800 to \$1,200.



This bell toy elephant has the tip of his trunk up, signaling the good luck he rings. The 19th-century toy was offered for sale at a James Julia auction a few years ago.

Later bell toys used wood, tin or other metals and added realistic hair or animal hide. The toys all were painted. The 1880s-1890s were the golden age for the bell toys, and in the 1900s, copies were made of metal and eventually plastic. Today, the bell toys are wood or plastic made by Fisher Price or Playskool.

•I have dishes with bowls that look like heads of lettuce and plates that are a single lettuce leaf. They are marked with the signature "Dodie Thayer." Can you tell me anything about them?

A • Large leaves probably were • one of the first "plates" used at a feast. So it is not surprising that

plates were shaped like cabbage or lettuce leaves by the 1600s. Leaf-shaped European majolica plates were made by Delft, and by the 18th-century they also were crafted by English potteries Wedgwood, Longton Hall, Chelsea and Minton, and French potteries Jacob Petit and Palissy. There was Etruscan Majolica from Pennsylvania, and modern giftware items like California Dodie Thayer ceramics. This Palm Beach dishware was made during the 1960s and '70s. Dishes were made from molds of actual cabbage or lettuce leaves, or full heads of the vegetable. Pink, red, yellow and green sets were made. They are signed with the artist's name.

Recently, the Lettuce Ware dishes were reproduced for the Tory Burch shops in green or white. Full sets are made with cups, plates, tureens and more. A new salad plate costs \$40. Leaf-shaped dishes of all ages are popular with collectors, but only those made of porcelain or after 1900 should be used to serve food.







Dyer elected into the Virginia Motorsports Hall of Fame

Three legends, each who impacted motorsports in a different but significant way, were inducted into the Virginia Motorsports Hall of Fame Saturday night at South Boston Speedway.

In a trackside ceremony before Saturday night's races, Curtis Turner, Hubert Hensley, and Bill Dyer were honored as the latest inductees into the Virginia Motorsports Hall of Fame.

Dyer, Danville native, was inducted as a journalist after chronicling short-track racing around the Commonwealth in a weekly syndicated column that ran for $40~\rm years$. But his involvement in the sport runs much deeper than that.

Dyer was working at the Danville Register & Bee when he got permission to start writing a column about NASCAR racing. It was one of the first columns in a daily paper to chronicle mostly short track and weekly NASCAR racing and it quickly grew in popularity and was picked up by several other newspapers in syndication. Its popularity grew and spread from just short-track racing into NASCAR's premier series, known now as the NASCAR Monster Energy Cup Series.

His column, Pit Stop, was the source for fans of racing in Virginia for many years until he retired in 1992. He was honored several years ago by South Boston Speedway when the press box was named the "Bill Dyer Press Box."

Dyer's career went well beyond pen, paper, and typewriter. For more than 23 years he worked at either South Boston Speedway, or Orange County Speedway starting in 1966. He served both tracks as general manger, promoter, and public relations director.

He was also Tommy Ellis' public relations representative on the Busch Grand National circuit for two seasons. Ellis is a previous inductee into the Virginia Motorsports Hall of Fame.

All the time he was employed in the sport, he continued to pen his weekly column. His last columns appeared in the Piedmont Shopper for two years, before finally retiring from the sport after more than 42 years in racing.

- * Whenever I'm at the dollar store, I make sure to pick up an assortment of general purpose greeting cards. People really love to get snail mail. There's just something about a colorful envelope addressed to you sitting in the mailbox that makes you smile. So I send cards for special occasions and often for no reason at all. The cost -- \$1.50 for card and postage -- is small compared with the joy they bring.

2 2/3 cups flour (1/2 all-purpose, 1/2 cake flour)

2 cups sugar

2 1/2 tsp baking powder

1/2 tsp salt

5 lg egg whites

1/2 cup milk

1 TBL natural coconut flavor (if you can't find this in your local store, you can order it here.)

1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened but not melted

3/4 cup unsweetened coconut milk

Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease and flour two 8 or 9-inch cake pans.

Whisk the egg whites, milk and coconut flavoring until frothy. (We will use these bubbles for the leavening to expand as the cake bakes). Set aside.

In a mixer bowl, add the flours, sugar, baking powder and salt. Mix with a whisk. Add the butter and coconut milk and mix on low with a paddle attachment just until moistened, then beat on medium for two minutes.

Add the egg white mixture in a few additions, mixing just until incorporated.

Pour the thick batter into the prepared pans. . . Bake for 36 to 40 minutes, then test with a toothpick to see if it comes out clean.

Remove from the oven and let cool for about 10 minutes, then remove from pans and cool completely on a rack.

Toasting coconut

Sprinkle coconut in a thin layer

While the cakes are cooling, use the warm oven to toast your coconut. Simply sprinkle the coconut on a cookie sheet in a thin layer and set it in the oven at 350 F for about two minutes. Stir the flakes and watch them for another minute or so. When they've toasted to golden, remove and cool.

Icing

8 oz. cream cheese, softened

1/2 cup butter, softened 4 cups powdered sugar

1 tsp natural coconut flavor

Filling

1 cup of the icing from above

1 cup of heavy whipping cream

Cream together the cream cheese and butter. Add the coconut flavor. Then add the powdered sugar, one cup at a time. Once it's smooth, add a tablespoon of the coconut milk or regular milk to achieve a spreadable consistency

For the filling, simply whip 1 cup of heavy whipping cream until medium peaks form, then gently blend in 1 cup of the cream cheese icing.

I divided my cake layers into four pieces, using a cake leveler. I used the whipped cream between each layer, then iced the outside of the cake with the cream cheese frosting. Lastly, I sprinkled the toasted coconut, using my palm to "bounce" the flakes onto the sides of the cake.

Thermostats

UNDERSTANDING HVAC **EFFICIENCY RATINGS**

An HVAC system can be rated in a number of different ways. While some of these ratings may be confusing, it is helpful to understand what they mean.

AFUE: An Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) rating is important if you are purchasing an oil or gas furnace. The AFUE rating measures the amount of fuel used to heat your home against the amount of fuel wasted. A higher rating indicates a more efficient system. The more efficient your system, the less fuel it takes to heat your home, which translates into lower heating bills during the winter.

SEER: The higher the Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER), the more efficient your system and the less it will cost to heat and cool your home. Federal regulations require all new HVAC systems to have a SEER rating of 13 or higher.

The more efficient heat pump runs until the outside air temperature falls below a certain level, at which point the system automatically switches the heat source to the furnace. This option is more expensive up front, but can generate significant savings in terms of monthly utility bills long-term.

Ductless systems are a flexible, efficient choice for homeowners looking for simple solutions. These systems can be easily mounted on the wall or ceiling, and don't require ductwork, making them ideal for a converted attic space or room addition.




