BIG BIRDS!

I had decided to sleep in, as a couple early rises to catch a redheaded woodpecker and some monarch butterflies had me tired (you know how that goes as you get older and have retired!). When I got up, I saw there was a message on the cellphone. When I



turned it on, I discovered that Mike Fuller had left me a message at 6:58 a.m., "A flock of sandhill cranes on and". Oh great, it's now 8:30 a.m., and I'm thinking they are probably gone by now. And a flock? We don't have only a few sandhills around here and if you're lucky you usually only see two or maybe three.

So off I rushed and guess what? There were seven birds waiting for me to photograph them, and later there were nine! One pair had two young with them (colts) and another pair had one. Soon they decided I was OK and went about their business of parading around the field looking for snacks. I was just ecstatic with the great opportunity I got to photograph these huge birds with red caps. Of course, like I've always done with rare encounters like this, I take way too many pictures!

Sandhill cranes are relatively "new kids" in our swamp and have started nesting here only a few years ago. They are huge birds similar in size to our great blue herons except they have slightly larger wing spans and are a heavier bird (10 pounds versus 5 for the great blue). Their huge wings make them great soaring birds, and during migration they will use thermals to carry them along with little wing flapping. They also have a red "cap" and fly with their heads and necks stretched out in front of them, where as the great blue flies with his neck and head coiled back near their bodies. The young of the year lack the red cap and are more of a reddish-brown than the adult gray color. Over time, the adults have brown reddish "stains" over their bodies. They have a very unique and loud rattling call that can not be mistaken for anything else.

Although not that common around here they exist by the thousands in our midwestern states and there is a hunting season on them. In fact, in some areas there are nuisance permits issued for them as they can do great damage to crops. They are mainly herbivorous, but eat various types of food which includes corn, wheat and cottonseed and will eat berries, small mammals (mice), insects, snails, reptiles and amphibians. While photographing them I saw dew worms taken, and I'm sure that some of the cover crop seeds recently sowed to this field were also taken. They usually "root" around down in the ground with those long bills to collect this food, which is evident by the dirt stuck a third of the way up those beaks.

Sandhill cranes raise one brood per year and nest sites are usually marshes and bogs, though occasionally on dry land. One to three (usually two) oval, dull brown eggs with reddish markings are lain with both parents incubate the eggs for about 30 days. The chicks (often called colts) are able to leave the nest within a day. The parents brood the chicks for up to three weeks after hatching, feeding them intensively for the first few weeks. They remain with the parents for 9 or 10 months and then form nomadic flocks with other juveniles and non-breeders remaining in these flocks until they form breeding pairs at between 2 and 7 years old. As a conspicuous ground-dwelling species, sandhill cranes, especially the young, are at risk from predators. Raccoon are a problem with nesting, and later the young can become prey to fox, coyote and larger birds of prey such as eagles. Another interesting characteristic of these birds are their mating season when they perform dancing displays. Although the dancing is most common in the breeding season, the cranes can dance all year long. Sometimes the dance involves wing-flapping, bowing, and jumping. They might also throw a stick or some plants into the air. Lucky me got to see and photograph this actively! So I lucked out not just that first morning when Mike alerted me, but for two more days which gave me way too many photos to choose from, but also a close look at their habits.

room, dining room, den, eat-in Of the 29 projects it studied for its 2017 "Cost vs. Value Report," Remodeling magazine found that the average payback in resale value was 64.3 cents. The lone project in the 2017 report to return a higher value than its cost was the installation of loose-fill insulation in an attic, which provided a return of 107.7 percent. Homeowners who replaced an existing entry door with a 20-gauge steel unit recouped 90.7 percent of their investment at resale, placing that project second on the list. What helps homeowners who finance such projects recoup their associated costs is the relatively low sticker price of the projects, which both rank among the five least expensive projects examined in the 2017 report. But a recovering real estate market has helped homeowners recoup more month, security & references of their investments on some expensive projects as well. For example, the 2017 report saw the biggest year-over-year percentage increases in value on expensive projects like upscale bathroom remodels, upscale master suites, two-story additions, grand entrance installations, and family room additions. The increase in value on those projects ranged from 5.6 percent to 7.4 percent from a year earlier.
