





I was driving on a four lane road when a pickup truck from the other direction began swerving. This truck was hauling firewood on a small trailer behind it and some of the logs came off and hit my car, flattened my tire, bent my rim, and damaged the underside of my car. The estimate for my repair is over \$3000 but I let the guy go without calling the police because I just thought I had a flat tire. I did get his name and insurance information but the insurance company says that he doesn't have insurance on that truck and they won't pay without a police report. What can I do?

- Kristina, Tuscumbia, AL

As you now know, a police report would help you resolve this matter. I hope everyone who reads my column understands that insurance companies are not helpful. Mayhem may be funny and talking geckos are great but insurance companies do not pay claims they do not absolutely have to pay. They dispute every claim they can and when liability is clear they claim that the

damages were caused some other way or are less than claimed. There is no reason why the insurance company will take your word for the fact that your car was damaged by their insured. Without a police report, they will simply dispute your account of the facts unless their insured admits to what happened. They will not make much of an effort for that to happen. They will drag it out and never pay you unless you make them.

I don't think you will ever be paid voluntarily by the insurance company in this case. A trailer being towed is generally covered by the insurance on the vehicle towing it. If the vehicle was borrowed, insurance will follow the vehicle.

My advice is to get a thorough estimate of the damage by an experienced and licensed repair facility and then file a complaint in small claims court in the county in which the accident happened. Small Claims Court goes up to \$3000. District Court goes up to \$10,000 anda any asuit for damages above \$10,000 must be filed in Circuit Court.

If the person has insurance, the suit will get the insurance company's attention and you may get paid or you may have to have your repair person present in court to testify about how much it will cost to repair your vehicle. That is an easy four questions: What do you do? How long have you done it? Did you examine my car? How much will it cost to fix?

Just because an insurance company refuses to accept responsibility in no way means that the judge who listens to the evidence and the parties won't find in your favor. People are supposed to drive safely and secure their loads properly. Failure to do so is negligence. Remember that the Small Claims system is set up for people to use without the expense of an attorney.

t making sure that they had workers compensation insurance. Otherwise, for small jobs you're probably not going to be responsible unless there is some danger or hazard that you know about and don't tell them about.

When dementia has been diagnosed, why should that influence your decisions about other medical problems?

Because each physician is trained to focus on their own subspecialty, what's best for the 'whole' patient can be overlooked. The AGS (American Geriatrics Society) encourages doctors to look for the geriatric 'syndromes' that seniors develop: not just

a 'heart problem', or a 'lung problem', but an 'aging person problem'! This is especially important when dementia develops.

Why? Because it has been described by families as 'a disease worse than even cancer': it robs them of the person they knew, and causes great physical, mental, and spiritual

Much has been written about the distress families are forced to endure when we fail to take a more 'holistic' approach. Katy Butler's article in the New York Times, My Father's Broken Heart: how a pacemaker wrecks a family's life, describes how both her demented father's and their whole family's suffering was prolonged: a pacemaker was inserted to 'fix' the heart to keep him alive; that action interfered in what could have been his escape from a *fate* worse than death, and allowed his dementia to deteriorate

More patients and families who, once dementia has been diagnosed, want to avoid a similar situation, are choosing 'Comfort Care Only', which means, do nothing which could prolong their suffering and dying: this includes "No CPR", "No ventilator", "No feeding tube", "No surgery", "No dialysis", and "No antibiotics". They hope that some other terminal event, such as a cancer, or a heart attack, or a pneumonia (the "old person's friend"), will allow them to die before they reach dementia's final stage.

And yet, some adult children struggle to accept this, wanting 'everything done'. Unfortunately, that misguided love may worsen the suffering everyone wants to avoid.

missions from bases in England deep into enemy territory. There were 12,732 B-17's produced from 1935-1945, of these 4,735 were lost in combat. The B-17 saw combat in three more wars following WWII. The B-17's saw service in Korea, Israel used them in the war of 1948, and some were even used



Medicare Minute

"Physician Charges"

There are three ways your doctor can be paid if you are on Medicare. The three ways are through Medicare assignment, Medicare excess charges or by not taking Medicare at all. Today we will discuss these three methods.

The most common way a physician gets paid is by Medicare assignment. These physicians are called "participating doctors". After the Part B deductible of \$183 is met, participating doctors will accept the Medicare approved amount for their services. These doctors charge Medicare 80% and the beneficiary 20% of the cost of the benefit. For example, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, and you would be responsible for the other 20%, or \$20.

A "non-participating doctor" can choose to accept or not accept Medicare assignment. If the doctor does not accept Medicare assignment you may have to pay an additional 15% of the cost of the service the doctor provided. This is call a Medicare excess charge. It means you would be responsible for 35% of the Medicare reduced amount instead of 20%. If we follow the example in the previous paragraph, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, but you would be responsible for 35%, or \$35.

Doctors who opt out of Medicare can charge whatever they want for their services and you are responsible of 100% of the cost. The majority of doctors in north Alabama accept Medicare, so you won't be faced with this situation very often.

Most people who have Medicare also have a supplemental policy that helps cover the 20% Medicare doesn't cover. If you are just entering Medicare and would like to know which policies cover what Medicare doesn't pay, you can contact our office for more information.



Thousands of Cherokee Indians passed through Waterloo in the 1830s when they were forced by the U.S. government to move West on the "Trail of Tears." Most came by boat from Tuscumbia and camped here to await transfer to larger steamboats. During the encampment several births. deaths, and escapes occurred.

One party of 1.070 Cherokees traveled overland from Ross' Landing

one party of 10.70 cherokees traveled overland from 10.55 challing in Tennessee due to low water in the upper river. Following the general route of U. S. Hwy. 72 to Florence, they arrived here July 10, 1838, in miserable condition after a 23-day journey.



Dear Patrick,


They might be taxed, but it won't be much to worry about. EE bonds make less than one percent, so you haven't really earned much. Never buy those things, man. They're a horrible investment, with an even worse rate of return.

I'm glad you're working out a plan and moving toward getting out of debt. A \$30,000 truck doesn't work with a \$50,000 income. So, cash in the bonds immediately, sell the truck, and use some of the money from the EE bonds to pay off the school loans. Then, find yourself a cheap, little truck that will get you around for a few years.

You can do this, Patrick. I want you to have a nice truck one day, but I don't want that truck to be a burden. This one's got you by the throat, and you're feeling it, aren't



Championships Return

Fame coach C.T. Manley coached Colbert County state championship back in 1972, players and fans alike have practically expected the Indians to make a charge to the state title each season.

It wouldn't take the Indians long to claim another title. Former Indians player and Hall of

Since the late Hall of Famer Don Creasy coached the Indians to two state titles-in 1979 and 1985. The High School's first football Indians went through some growing pains for the next eight years, failing to win the big prize. In 1993, the Indians hired the late Hall of Fame coach Jimmy Moore to head up the program.

Moore had won back-toback state championships in Mississippi in 1981 and 1982. Moore's first team at Colbert County finished the 1993 regular season with a modest 6-4 record, but still qualified for the state playoffs. You've heard about teams peaking at the right time. That's exactly what the Indians did over the next five weeks.

In game 1, the Indians downed Colbert Heights 40-0. The Tribe defense turned three Wildcats turnovers into touchdowns and Freddie Ingram rushed for 149 yards to pave the win. The Indians won game 2 by defeating South Lamar in

overtime 13-7. Corey Cobb blocked a game winning field goal attempt by South Lamar with 12 seconds remaining in regulation. In overtime, The Indians' Steve Stanley scored the

winning touchdown.
The Indians went up against Plainview in the quarterfinals the following week. Plainview was no match for the Indians. Dennis Lewis caught a 66-yard pass for a touchdown and Gary Hampton scored twice Mondale Bates caught a 73-yard TD pass from Stanley and Colbert County cruised to a 38-15 win.

A local matchup for a spot in the state championship game pitted The Indians against the Central Wildcats. Quarterback Steve Stanley had a career game, rushing for four touchdowns and completing a touchdown pass to Brent Austin. The 40-15 victory sent the Tribe to the state championship

The Indians would have to travel the length of the state to Mobile for the finals to play the St. Paul Saints. The Saints jumped out in front 10-0 but the Indians cut the lead to 10-7 at halftime. The Indians established momentum by taking the second half kickoff 75 yards in 12 plays to score what turned out to be the winning touchdown. The defense stood tall when Corinthian Ricks sacked the Saints quarterback on fourth down with one minute to play, the Indians had won their first state championship in eight years.

It would be the beginning of a new era in Colbert County football lore, as the Tribe would win two more state championships under Jimmy Moore over the next three years. This year marks the 25th anniversary of the beginning of one of the greatest eras in Colbert County High School football history.





Stumbling Block

The story is told of a traveler who once stopped at an old country store. As he entered there was a big sign on the door that warned: "Beware of the Dog!" He thought that rather strange for a place of business, but opened the door and cautiously went on in. He picked up the few items that he needed and took them to the register to check out. It was then that he spotted an old hound sleeping behind the counter. He asked the store manager, "Is that the dog folks are supposed to beware of?" "Yep, he's the one," the manager answered. Too curious to let it go,

the customer said, "He certainly doesn't look like a dangerous dog to me. Why in the world would you post that sign?" "Because," the owner responded, "before I posted that sign, people kept tripping over him."

This story reminded me of an expression used in some of the older translations of the New Testament, "stumbling block." The word quite simply defined is: "an obstacle or an impediment to progress." The Bible uses this word specifically or in principle in relation to spiritual matters. In principle, it is used of the scribes and Pharisees by Jesus to warn against stumbling over their bad influence (cf. Matthew 16:6; 23:13).

On the other hand, there are other passages where we are specifically warned not to be a "stumbling block" to those around us. For example, Paul taught "that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way" (Romans 13:12). The context of this verse has to do with those who are "strong" spiritually not imposing their liberties to the point to where they cause those who are "weak" spiritually to stumble. Yet, the bottom line is: we must be careful to not be a stumbling block to anyone- - at any time.

Unfortunately, there are too many times when "stumbling blocks" enter people's lives. They have been known to pop up between husbands and wives. It often happens when the level of commitment to spiritual things is higher in one or the other. The less committed often becomes a discouragement (stumbling block) to their mate, often leading to them abandoning their walk with the Lord.

Beyond husbands and wives stumbling blocks sometimes exist between parents and children; between friends; et.al. It would be nice if they were all clearly marked by a large warning sign, but they are not. Thus, the best you and I can do is to be advised to watch for them and more importantly, never to be one!

I also have 24 EE bonds that were gifted to me that haven't fully matured. Right now, they're worth a combined \$12,500. Should I cash those in, and use the money to pay off some of my debt, or let them fully mature before cashing them in? Also, are there any tax ramifications from cashing them in?

Dear Patrick,


They might be taxed, but it won't be much to worry about. EE bonds make less than one percent, so you haven't really earned much. Never buy those things, man. They're a horrible investment, with an even worse rate of return.

I'm glad you're working out a plan and moving toward getting out of debt. A \$30,000 truck doesn't work with a \$50,000 income. So, cash in the bonds immediately, sell the truck, and use some of the money from the EE bonds to pay off the school loans. Then, find yourself a cheap, little truck that will get you around for a few years.

You can do this, Patrick. I want you to have a nice truck one day, but I don't want that truck to be a burden. This one's got you by the throat, and you're feeling it, aren't you?
