## DCC President Announces Retirement

DANVILLE, VA., SEPTEMBER 11, 2018 –

Danville Community College (DCC) President Dr. Bruce R. Scism announced this week his plans to retire at the conclusion of the 2018 calendar year in December.

“This was not an easy decision as I have deep affection for this college and community and am appreciative of the opportunities provided to me,” Scism said in an email to the college campus Monday morning. “I have enjoyed the single best career experience of my life here at DCC and am delighted to have had the opportunity to work with all of you and the campus community over these past number of years. I stand in admiration of what has been, is being, and will be accomplished here at the college—owing to the tireless effort in this community to provide a service and experience that advances the lives of the students and residents of this community and region.”



Scism became the fifth president of DCC on August 1, 2013. Since then, he worked with faculty at the college to launch a number of initiatives and programs that lead to a stronger economy and a highly skilled and trained workforce, including the upcoming power substation electrician program, a robotics and automation program, an on-campus cosmetology lab and program, a new state-of-the-art welding building, and the rebuilt and modernized engineering and industrial technologies (EIT) building, which houses the precision machining, automotive, and dimensional inspection programs. The Advanced IT Academy and truck driving program were also developed during Scism’s tenure and the college earned the cyber security certification of program excellence by the National Security Agency and Department of Homeland Security in January 2017.

Other achievements of the college under Scism’s directive are the two-year welding program, including a focus on fabrication in the second year, competency-based education model, with DCC being one of only a handful of colleges in the U.S. authorized to do so, metrology/dimensional inspection program: The only community college in the nation authorized for graduates to sit for the ASQ CQI certification and normally requires two years of work-based experience, the Haas Machining partnership with the Institute for Advanced Learning and Research (IALR): DCC is one of only five institutions in the U.S. certified as Training Provider, covering the southeastern United States, and a Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) report, which noted DCC as second-highest performing community college in Virginia.

“Dr. Scism is a visionary and always seems to be a step ahead of national trends,” said DCC Vice President of Academic and Student Services Dr. Debra Holley. “He has done a great job moving the college forward, especially in the areas supporting economic development and improving student success. I have truly enjoyed working with him. He will be missed.”

Scism led the charge on strengthening relationships between the college and the community through expansion of the college’s partnership with IALR and DCC’s precision machining program, which most recently held the honor of hosting this year’s week-long national conference for the Haas Technical Education Center. Scism said he has focused on the college’s role in producing a pipeline of skilled workers in highly sought-after fields to support economic development in the City of Danville and in Pittsylvania County and Halifax County.

DCC recently earned the GoTec Award through the Go Virginia initiative, which places a career exploration lab in area middle schools with the intent to engage them with hands-on activities related to career fields such as engineering, information technology, and advanced manufacturing, and to provide a clear career and curriculum pathway to the jobs of their interest.

Scism’s legacy is evident in the impact that his time leading the college had on its procedures and personnel.

“Dr. Scism will truly be missed at DCC. Under his leadership, his excitement when sharing his vision for the future of our campus would be contagious,” said Financial Aid Director Angela Turner. “He has always listened and been supportive of tackling the impossible when it was for the good of the student.”

The student experience is also forever changed thanks to Scism’s leadership.

“Dr. Scism has helped us to make significant improvements in the student onboarding process. He brought with him experiences from other states and ideas of using technology to improve our existing, slightly dated process,” said Coordinator of Admissions, Enrollment Management, and Student Outreach Cathy Pulliam. “He challenged the Student Services Staff to create a one-stop, student-centered orientation program and from that we created DCC ROCKS (Registration, Orientation, Computer Knowledge, and Support), which has been our new and very successful student orientation program for the last three years. This program allows students to come to campus for one morning prior to the semester and leave with a class schedule, parking permit, and student ID in hand and ready to start classes, which is a vast improvement over the previous process. Dr. Scism’s student-centered vision also led DCC to be a build college for the Navigate Onboarding Software which was recently adopted by the VCCS, allowing DCC to be a front runner in college access tools for the entire system. Dr. Scism’s leadership has helped us make great advancements for our students and he will be greatly missed.”

Scism was born in Danville and his paternal grandfather was a tobacco farmer in Pelham after owning a grocery store near DCC. His maternal grandfather lived in Danville with his wife and they worked for Gulf Oil and Thalhimers, respectively.

In collaboration with the DCC College Board, the Virginia Community College System will conduct a national search for DCC’s next president in the coming months and may, depending on the timing, hire an interim president to lead DCC while the search process occurs.

Danville Community College is a two-year institution of higher education under the statewide Virginia Community College System. DCC’s service area includes the City of Danville, Pittsylvania County, and Halifax County. Denice Dawn Thibodeau, 65, a journalist who recognized every face on her beat and a fighter who didn't know how to quit, passed away Monday, September 3, 2018, at SOVAH Health-Danville following a

persistent illness.

Born on August 26, 1953, in Flushing, New York, she possessed a strong sense of irony and a contagious laugh that often punctuated such stories as hiking a deserted highway in search of a mechanic to fix an ailing Cadillac and other instances where she would pluck humor from amid chaos.

Mrs. Thibodeau, of 524 W. Main St., Danville, Va., had mastered just about every type of job worth discussing around the water cooler – from learning to fix typewriters at her parents' repair shop to running a weekly newspaper in Knoxville, Tennessee, and stints as production manager for Doubleday Books in New York City and Academic Press in Orlando, Florida, she'd probably done it all.

Her most dynamic tales revolved around parties thrown in her New York apartment unit, situated so high up that she placed drinks and food on each stair landing for guests lacking the stamina for the entire climb. But the tale dropping jaws involved loaning her typewriter at a book-publishing job to office mate and American writer Kurt Vonnegut Jr. whenever his broke down and was sent to the shop, even if she did know how to fix it.

Her most recent career, a journalist at the Danville Register & Bee for 11 years, involved chasing down city councilmen for quotes on the latest budget vote, snapping photos at ribbon cuttings of the newest business in the River District and hanging in the summer heat to call in snippets about an escaped jail inmate.

Even with a trove of bylines and awards to her name, her Register & Bee fame revolves around winning her battle against cancer in 2017, which included bouts of chemotherapy, a myriad of hats and wigs and a victorious return to relieved coworkers.

Mrs. Thibodeau is preceded in death by her husband Percy Thibodeau, who passed away November 14, 2003. The pair met while she lived in Maine.

She is survived by sisters Lisa Mellin, of Orlando, Florida, and Wendy Evans, of Princeton, Louisiana; daughter Amanda Fulton, of Danville, Virginia; nieces Cari Mellin, of Orlando, Florida, and Becky Jones, of Princeton, Louisiana; cousins David Robbins, of Biloxi, Mississippi, and Gayle Pietrzak, of Sun City, Florida; and many other family members who will miss her.

**BEST PIMIENTO CHEESE**



**Ingredients**

- 3 oz cream cheese softened to room temp.
- 1/3 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 1/2 tsp apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 tsp hot sauce (optional)
- 1 tsp sugar
- 1 tsp dried mustard
- 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- 1/4 tsp freshly ground black pepper
- 1 4 oz jar diced pimiento drained well
- 1 1/2 cups shredded colby cheese
- 1 1/2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- Optional: 2 tbsp sliced green onion

**Instructions**

In a medium bowl, combine cream cheese, mayonnaise, Worcestershire sauce, apple cider vinegar, hot sauce, sugar, dried mustard, salt and pepper. Then stir in green onion (if using). Finally, stir in shredded cheese and drained pimientos until fully coated with mayonnaise mixture.

Cover with plastic wrap and put into the refrigerator to chill for at least 8 hours. This helps the flavors really come together.

Then dig in! Serve on crackers or sandwiches or stir into grits (yum!)

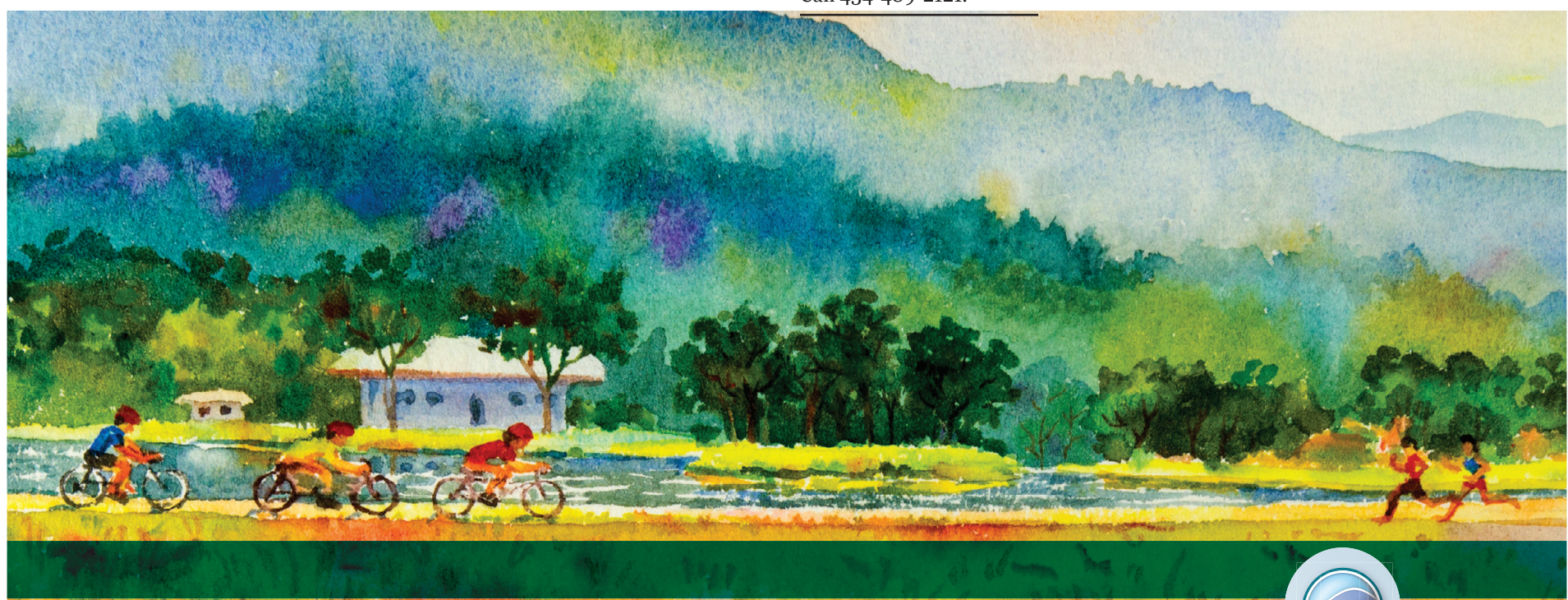
