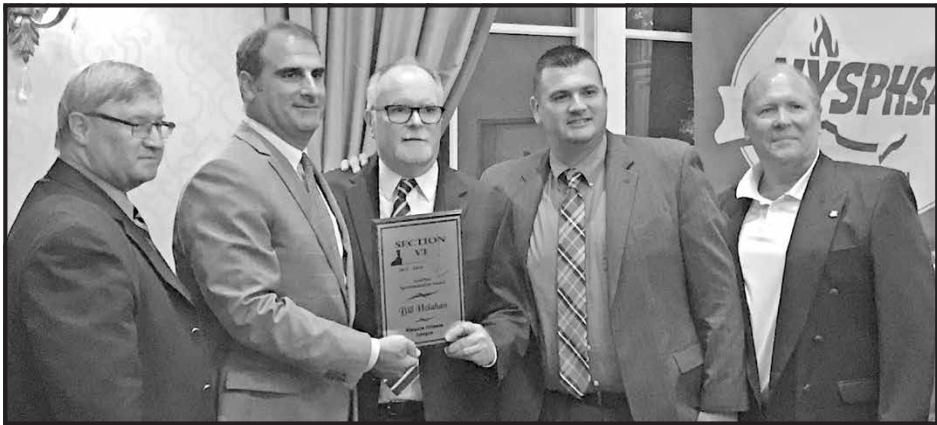

COACH HOLAHAN RECOGNIZED WITH SECTION VI SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

Royalton-Hartland Coach Bill Holahan was recently honored at the Section VI Coaches Sportsmanship Awards. The 19th Sportsmanship Recognition Dinner, held at the Columns Banquet facility, honored several coaches from various sports of the 95 schools that are members of the organization. Coach Holahan has coached his Lady Rams team to Niagara-Orleans Titles in 1983, 1991, 1994, 1996, 1997, 2008 and 2009. Under his leadership the team also has three Sectional titles in 1983, 1987 and 1996.

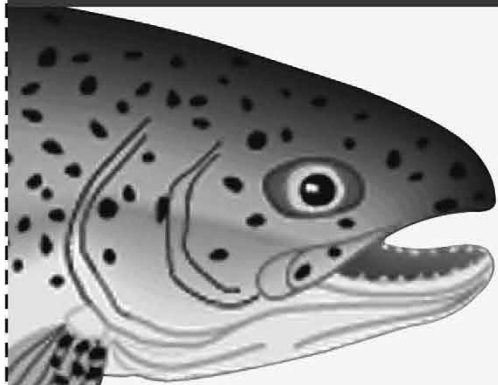

SHERIFF'S REPORT

In the month of August, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 2,191 police incidents, including 839 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 189 for the New York State Police and 1,163 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 584 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 367 of those emergency medical in nature and a total of 6 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 38 automobile accidents, including 13 with injury and 9 car-deer collisions. Road patrol, also, made 62 service attempts and served 30 subpoenas, civil, or court papers. The Marine Patrol handled 29 calls for service including boaters in distress, reckless operation, and marine vessel inspections on Lake Ontario, Lake Alice, as well as the Erie Canal and Glenwood Lake. In addition, Deputies and members of local law enforcement agencies participated in an "active-shooter" drill at Kendall Schools along with Kendall Fire Dept., Monroe Ambulance, and Orleans County Emergency Management.

The Orleans County Jail processed in 84 inmates with 4 incarcerated females boarded for other jurisdictions.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 153 incidents including 38 stray dogs, seven dog bite complaints, 17 neighbor dog problems, one domestic animal struck by vehicles, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 24 animals were taken in at the shelter on voluntary surrenders.

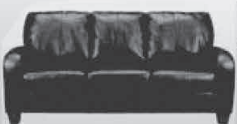

**IT IS RIGHT AROUND
THE CORNER!**

The first thing noticed was that I had to
start earlier in the evening to get sunset shots
with my camera. Then that there were only a
few hummingbirds coming to my feeders. A
lot of us are going to miss those little guys
and all the entertainment they provide. Yep, fall
is on its way!

A trip to Point Breeze the other night revealed that the cormorants were returning
to the trees on the west side of the Oak Orchard River near the boat launch. Their
numbers reach in the hundreds in early summer there, but some local residents had
driven them off for most of the summer with noise makers. Now they are returning,
maybe migrating from the Canadian side of Lake Ontario heading south for the winter.
Their roosting numbers (I counted over a 100 the other night on Ringneck Marsh on
the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge) are also building lately, although some of that
number comes from the this year's young from the nesting colony nearby. This bird
destroys a lot of fish on the waters it inhabits, which is of course takes away from
eagles, ospreys and local fishermen. Of course their habit of covering vegetation
with their toxic excrement under these roosting areas will eventually destroy the
trees and bushes, which is further destructive of the environment.

Not all is bad though, as with fall comes the beautiful fall foliage which is always
a marvel to behold. However don't except a super colored fall foliage this year as
the drought conditions we experienced this summer will have a dampening effect
on mother nature's show.

Those drought conditions have made for a great year for fawn survival however
which is the reason we have been seeing more fawns this summer than ever before.
I have photographed more fawns and seen more age classes of them this summer
then ever before. A word to the wise to drivers this fall, there will be more deer
crossing the roads than ever before!

Speaking of deer, the hunting season with a bow starts Oct. 1 and runs until Nov.
16 after which the guns season opens. Crossbows can be used starting Nov. 3 until
Nov. 16.

There is also a special Youth Firearms season which runs Oct. 6-8. Rifles will
again be legal in Orleans and Genesee counties. Deer Management Permits (DMPs)
allows the shooting of a female deer for population control, will be available until
Oct. 1 at all licensing-issuing agents.

If you hear gunfire here in September it could be for the early Canada goose
season which started Sept. 1 and goes to Sept 25, or the squirrel season which
also started on Sept. 1 and runs until Feb. 28. Rabbit season opens Oct. 1 and goes
to March 17, and pheasant season from Oct. 20 until Dec. 31. Turkey season is
from Oct. 1-14. On Oct. 27, the regular duck and goose season opens with the duck
season closing on Dec. 8 and then opening again from Dec. 26 until Jan. 11. The
regular goose season closes on Nov. 26, but opens again on Dec. 26 until Jan.13.

Other folks you may see out in the woods, fields and streams are trappers. This
is a sport that is not nearly as popular as it was in my day, but still provides a means
of population control for animals that are not hunted and it gives a young lad a great
insight to nature. I did a lot of trapping when I was young and that made me even
more interested in nature and how it "ticks." It led to going to college to earn a
degree in Forestry and Wildlife Management and today it is a big factor in my ability
to capture it all with my camera and write about it. In our area, mink and muskrat
seasons start Nov. 25 and ends Feb. 15. Raccoon, fox, skunk, coyote, opossum and
weasel seasons start Oct. 25 and end Feb. 15. Beaver season opens Nov. 25 and
ends Feb. 15. On the Oak Orchard and Tonawanda Wildlife Management Areas and
the John White Area the muskrat and mink seasons do not start until Dec. 1, with the
upland trapping starting Nov. 1 with them ending Feb 15.

So as the days get shorter, the leaves begin to change and eventually fall with
wildlife coming alive with it's preparation for winter. We lose the extreme heat we
endured this summer and get to watch nature's new shows. You don't have to be a
hunter or trapper to enjoy this annual wonder, just get out there and look!

Steps to a More Organized, Functional Garage

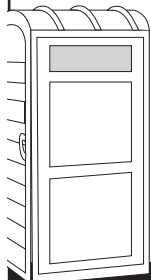

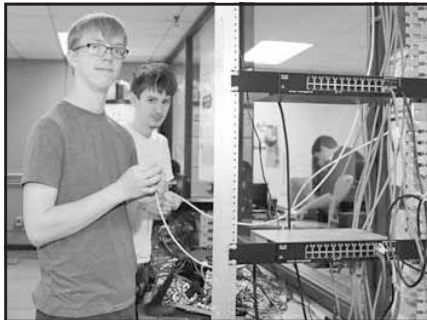

The Computer Technology students at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center have been hard at work using the skills they picked up in junior year to set up the class's computer lab.

They really enjoy being in this class and talk to the students who are touring the program about what they like about it. So I owe them all the credit for these record breaking numbers."

Tips for Buying a Home in a Seller's Market

The real estate market can be difficult to navigate for both buyers and sellers. First-time buyers can easily become overwhelmed as they search for homes, while sellers hoping to get the best price for their homes might be frustrated if offers are slow to come in or fall short of their asking prices.

If met with an underwhelming market, many sellers can pull their homes off the market and wait until it becomes more advantageous to sell. - Be ready to compromise. Unless they have unlimited budgets, buyers often must compromise when purchasing a home. That's especially true in a seller's market with limited inventory. Buyers who need to buy a home must identify their needs versus their wants and recognize the likelihood that they will have to compromise.

Gourds, Squashes and Pumpkins, Oh My!

Halloween takes place during
a time of year characterized by
earthen-colored chrysanthemums,
leaf-lined walkways and crisp
autumn air. As colorful as the
costumes children wear for trick-
or-treating may be, nature's beauty
is unsurpassed this time of year,
and the scores of pumpkins,
gourds and squashes on display
only add to that colorful melange.

The Cucurbitaceae family may be
best known for pumpkins, squash
and gourds, but there actually are
800 species that belong to this
family. While they share many of the
same properties, these fruits each
have their own unique attributes.

The main differences between
squashes, gourds and pumpkins is
their intended purposes - whether
they're ornamental or edible.

Squash

Squashes come in summer and
winter varieties. Winter ones do
not actually grow in the winter;
in fact, they're harvested in late
summer and early fall, but the
name references the hard shell
casing that protects the tender
pulp inside. Zucchini are summer
squash because their outer flesh
is tender, while butternut, acorn,
spaghetti, and hubbard squashes
are winter squashes because they
feature a tough skin. Even though
it takes some effort to crack that
shell, the dense, nutrient-rich flesh
inside is well worth the workout.

Gourds

Gourds are essentially ornamental
squashes; they aren't cultivated for
eating. Instead they are bred to look
beautiful and unique in autumn
centerpieces. Types of gourds
include autumn wing gourd, warted
gourds, turban gourds, and bottle
gourds. Each gourd is unique in its
shape and color.

Pumpkins

Pumpkins come in ornamental
and edible varieties. Even though
all pumpkins can be consumed,
some taste better than others. Small
pumpkins tend to be decorative
because, according to Nutritious
Life, they do not have enough meat
inside to make them worthy of
cooking. However, sugar pumpkins
are best for baking and cooking
favorite recipes, states the resource
Pumpkin Nook.

The festive hues and flavors of
squashes, gourds and pumpkins
are one more thing that makes
Halloween and autumn special. ■
