

'New' Essex Day promises more music, added attractions, meaningful mascot

When Essex Day dawns at 10 a.m. on Saturday, a host of new offerings will await fairgoers, including a new mascot, a new day of the week and extended hours to host more music and activities.

The 43rd version of the longtime community celebration will be held on a Saturday (instead of Sunday) for the first time, which organizers are hoping will bring out bigger crowds now that the festival will not be competing with church services and professional football games.

Essex Day T-shirts - another first - will be adorned with "Cubey," a cartoon characterization of the iconic red Essex cube that has occupied a space at the gateway to Essex near the Back River Bridge since the late 1970s.

"When we were looking to create a mascot, we wanted something fun, something that would attract atten-

tion and something that would be iconic - that would immediately say Essex," festival committee member Brian Marchetti told the East County Times. "In recent years, the Essex Cube has been neglected and a lot of people don't even know why its there."

The goal, according to Marchetti, was to take that time-honored symbol of Essex and make something fun and memorable - and "Cubey" was born.

Cubey makes his - or her? - debut on Essex Day posters and T-shirts this year and organizers hope the image becomes synonymous with the annual festival.

The addition of a fourth entertainment stage and several hours of increased fair time will translate to significantly more live music available, according to organizers.

A new sponsorship deal with Starleigh Entertain-

ment has resulted in the main stage being renamed the Starleigh Entertainment Stage, according to Marchetti. The Christian music stage has been renamed the Circle of Faith Stage and a brand-new stage - the Homegrown Stage - will give local and just-startingout talent a place to shine.

Always a crowd favorite, the Karaoke Stage will be managed by DJ Leon Moses and Karie Karaoke and will be open the entire eight hours of the festival, according to committee member Lisa Harlow.

Another first will be the addition of a beer garden, which will be sponsored and operated by the owners of PatRick's bar and restaurant, according to Essex Day President Paul Rufe.

"It will be near the main stage by Woodward Avenue, and will be fenced in and monitored," Rufe said.


Local nationwide insurance agent Ed Young is sponsoring the appearance of the NASCAR Nationwide 88 show car and a simulator that will give visitors the experience of driving a race car.

"Something else new is our pie-eating contest, with Dangerously Delicious Pies, which are about the best you can buy," Rufe said. "And they're going to be blueberry, so they're going to be really messy.'

The committee has worked hard to improve the festival, according to Rufe.

"We have a really good team working on this and this is our learning year," he said. We're going to build and refine for next year and just keep making it better

Iconic Essex Cube, garden plot spruced up in time for annual festival

The iconic red Essex Cube, which has perched on its little piece of the world near the Back River Bridge since at least the late 1970s, has been spruced up just in time for a renewed prominence in Essex Day festivities.

The cube served as the inspiration for the creation of "Cubey," a cartoon caricature of the local landmark.

And thanks to the generosity and hard work of several local business owners and volunteers, the garden plot the cube sits on has a new lease on life as well.

"It was very overgrown, it was a mess," local business owner Cliff O'Connell told the East County Times.

O'Connell and his wife, Debbie, own Cliff"s Direct Effect on Stemmers Run Road. The couple contacted Scott Smith of Smith's Lawn Care to get the garden weeded and cleaned up before the festival.

unteers willing to pitch in and asked me if I could help clean that space up," Smith told the Times. "And I told them that if they had volunteers, put them on something else and I'd go bang that out."

Smith said there was "a lot of overgrowth" at the garden, which he believes hadn't been tended to in quite some time.

"The grass was several feet tall in some spots and the total curb line was gone," he said. "We trimmed the trees back from the cube, cut the grass, did some edging and trimming and put down mulch."

Before Smith worked his landscaping magic on the plot of ground, electrician George Lang of Power Factor gave the cube new electrical life, according to O'Connell.

"George went in there, fixed the electric, and replaced the lighting system with all new LED lights," O'Connell said. "And then we went up and gave it a bath; it was pretty dirty."

Lang donated all the materials and labor to relight the cube, according to O'Connell.


Item by item, O'Connell and other members of the Eastern Baltimore County Task Force are accomplishing small projects to improve the image of downtown Essex and to make it more attractive to visitors.

"We're just doing small, little things, like fixing and resealing the wood benches," he said. "And my company just paid to put new banners outside the Heritage Society."

He also hopes to procure grant funding for other projects, like repainting some light poles.

O'Connell said that he thinks it's great that the work the Essex Day committee and others have done has spurred "some new interest and excitement" in the cube and its meaning to Essex.

"We're slowly getting some things done, slowly doing those small, little things that people notice," he said.







George Wilbanks and others to be honored at Essex Day

This year marks the first time in decades that George Wilbanks, the late former publisher of the *East County Times* and former president of the Essex Day Committee, will not be at Essex Day, but his presence will certainly be felt.


A memorial tribute is planned for Essex Day, with Wilbanks being honored along with writer and activist Anna Renault, former County Executive Kevin Kamenetz and Officer Amy Caprio.

To honor the aforementioned community figures, reserved chairs will be set up and adorned with black bunting and white flowers. Jamie Costello, of the local ABC affiliate, will say a few words about each of those being honored.

"We just felt it was important to honor these members of our community," said Delegate Ric Metzgar (R-7), an Essex Day Committee member.

While all four will be the subject of tributes, more is planned for Wilbanks due to his time both as president of the Essex Day Committee and stature within the community.

"He was an inspiration to the community," said Paul Rufe, the current president of the committee. "He was a great asset to this area because of the things he did and his continued service."

Along with the chair tribute, Metzgar said he plans on honoring Wilbanks with a joint resolution from the rest of the District Six Delegation.

"George was such a powerpoint in Essex, and nobody ever recognized him," said Metzgar. "We thanked him in public but we didn't do it like this, and we need to do it."

Metzgar said Wilbanks loved meeting with the local politicians at Essex Day, but overall he loved the sense of community togetherness that came with the day.

"George lived for Essex Day. He talked about it constantly," Metzgar said.






