Need Help Paying for Medicare?

The Medicare Savings Programs can help with Medicare costs, like your monthly Part B premiums and sometimes also Part A and Part B coinsurance and deductibles.

September is Baby Safety Month

According to the New York State Department of Health, injuries are the leading cause of death among children. Unintentional injuries such as motor vehicle accidents, falls, and burns represent the greatest threat to your child's health. Children are more likely to die from injuries than from all other causes combined. Fortunately, many of the childhood injuries are preventable. The key to preventing childhood injuries is to make your home and car as safe as possible.



The Government Traffic Safety Committee states, "Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of unintentional injury-related death among children ages 14 and under. Most parents believe they are using child safety seats properly, but it is estimated that four out of five children are not properly restrained." Make sure that the child safety seat you are using is the proper type for your child. Child safety seats should be based on your child's weight and height and on the compatibility with your vehicle. Weight and height guidelines can be found on the child safety seat and in the seat's instruction manual. New York State's Occupant Restraint Law states:

- In the front seat, the driver and each passenger must wear a seat belt, one person per belt. The driver and front-seat passengers aged 16 or older can be fined up to \$50 each for failure to buckle up.
- Every occupant, regardless of age or seating position, of a motor vehicle being operated by the holder of a Class-DJ Learner Permit, a Limited Class-DJ, or Class-DJ Driver License must be restrained by a safety restraint.
- Each passenger under age 16 must wear a seat belt or use an appropriate child safety restraint system. The restraint system must comply with the child height and weight recommendations determined by the manufacturer. Depending on the size of the child, the restraint system may be a safety seat or a booster seat used in combination with a lap and shoulder belt.
- The driver must make sure that each passenger under age 16 obeys the law. The driver can be fined \$25 to \$100 and receive three driver license penalty points for each violation.
- Seat belt use is not required in emergency vehicles, 1964 or older vehicles, or by passengers in buses other than school buses (seat belt use may be required by the school district). Rural letter Carriers are also exempt while they are delivering mail.
- Effective November 1, 2017, the driver and each front seat passenger aged 16 or older must wear a seat belt in taxi and livery vehicles. The directions for child safety seats are not always clear, so to be sure that your seat is installed properly, contact the Cornell Cooperative Extension's Traffic Safety Program at (585) 991-5420 or (585) 335-1752 or visit www.ccelivingstoncounty.org to locate a child safety seat inspection station near you.

In addition to motor vehicle accidents, children often get injured in their own homes. Childproofing your home is very important, especially if there are infants in the home. Parents should examine every room for potential hazards. All stairways should be blocked by a baby gate both at the top and bottom of the stairs. Doors that lead to the outside or down steps should be locked. Windows are especially dangerous when left opened because babies can fall through the screen from higher heights. If it is necessary for windows to be opened, open them from the top rather than bottom.

Burns to babies are very common because we tend to let them explore while we are cooking, or giving them a bath. While cooking, you should use the back burners of the stove with the pot handles facing inwards. This will prevent children from tipping hot water onto themselves. Bathwater temperature also needs to be checked to avoid burns. Children should never be left unattended in the bathtub. Children can drown in as little as one inch of water.


