THEY SEEM TO BE SHOWING **UP EVERYWHERE**

They are not only showing up around our area but also in Amherst, North Tonawanda, Wheatfield, Youngstown, Lewiston, Akron, Clarence, Ransomville and Lancaster. I'm getting a lot of calls and emails about it with some folks being very nervous about them.



Bears are being seen more frequently in our area.

One lady is worried about her goats, some about their dogs and another her cats.

So what is this creature, that seems to be showing up all around Western New York that we are not use to seeing? Black bears! According to the DEC this has been a record year for bear sightings in Western New York but that is really happening because the bear is expanding its range. In the mid-1990s their range was pretty much confined to the extreme Southern Tier area but they have been expanding northward until they are now in our part of the state too. In fact the hunting season for bears has been expanded into our area. And no, the DEC didn't start stocking them around here.

So why are these bears migrating north into our area? Well the young bear remains with his mother until his second year and then is driven away when she is ready to mate again. During the months of June and July these young bears are traveling looking for their own territories and mates. These "traveling" bears give the impression there are a lot of bears around when actually many are the same ones.

These animals are pretty interesting creatures with some unique life styles. Bears are meat eaters but they also eat plant matter. They love honey but get into beehives also for the bees and their larvae. They will eat about anything including carrion, garbage and can be a prime predator of fawns. In the fall black bears begin to gorge themselves especially on apples, corn, beechnuts and acorns to put on extreme amounts of fat to get them through their winter hibernation.

They mate in the summer but because of delayed implantation the fertile eggs don't start to develop until late fall. This protects the mother because she is in peak shape then and will soon be inactive and so the cubs and mother have the best chance of survival.

Although bears will hibernate in caves when available most of the time they also will use a hollow in the ground, a huge hollow tree, beneath a blown down tree or under a summer cottage.

In January or February the female will give birth to two or three tiny cubs weighing only ½ to ¾ of a pound. Bears don't really hibernate in the true sense but awaken frequently so the mother is quite aware of the cubs and takes care of them.

During this time the mother's heartbeat slows to 8 beats per minute. She absorbs her fat to survive and does not urinate or defecate.

Black bears only breed every other year so the female cares for the young for a year and a half. Mortality is high (50 percent or more) for the cubs their first summer.

A boar bear can reach weights of 700 or 800 pounds but the common range is from 150 to 350 pounds with females being smaller.

Not only do bears have tremendous strength but they show an ability to think o. In one case a bear that was only live trapped once would return later and stand with one hind foot raised while taking the bait thus preventing the trap door from unlatching and coming down to catch him. The bear would then simply back out of the trap with the bait! So are we endanger because of the increase of bears in our area? The black bear is normally an extremely shy and reclusive animal that will flee at the first sight or smell of a human. However foolish people who put out food for them can condition them to humans. The next thing you know the bear is begging for handouts by roadsides, backyards and campgrounds. They seem tame because they have lost their fear of man and this is what can make them so dangerous. So the real danger is from the dumba#\$es who put out food so they can see them. With their conditioning to humans they get bolder and start getting into garbage cans, bird feeders and may even break into cottages, sheds and garages. These "conditioned" bears may even get nasty when they don't get food. So if you see a bear consider yourself lucky and observe from a distance and don't try getting close to get that "great" picture. Their sense of smell is great but their eyesight not so much, which means they may not be too sure what you are or what your intentions. Bears can turn mean quickly and are extremely fast; much faster than you!



Warning Signs of Suicide

In June of 2018, the deaths by suicide of two high-profile celebrities garnered substantial attention. Within days of each other, fashion designer Kate Spade and television host and author Anthony Bourdain took their own lives.

The deaths of Spade and Bourdain prompted many to inquire about suicide, its causes and if there are any signs that might help them identify if a loved one is having suicidal thoughts. According to the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, no single thing causes suicide. The AFSP notes that suicide is most often a byproduct of the convergence of stressors and health issues that, when coupled, create a sense of hopelessness and despair.

Depression and anxiety are two conditions most commonly associated with suicide. But the AFSP notes that most people who have been diagnosed with these conditions and actively manage them go on to engage in life. Undiagnosed depression and anxiety, as well as undiagnosed or unaddressed substance abuse, increase a person's risk for suicide. That's why it's so important for men, women and young people to learn to recognize warning signs for suicide and put themselves in position to promptly address their own issues or those of a loved one.

Speech

The AFSP notes that people who take their own lives may speak about doing so prior to committing suicide. People should seek help if they or a loved one talks about feeling hopeless, having no reason to live or being a burden to others. People who speak of feeling trapped or feeling unbearable pain also may be exhibiting warning signs of suicide.

Behavior

Behavior, especially behavior that can be linked to a painful event, loss or change, is another potential indicator that a person is having suicidal thoughts. Such behaviors include:

- · Increased use of alcohol or drugs
- · Looking for a way to end their lives, such
- as searching online for methods
- Withdrawing from activities
 Isolating from family and friends
- Sleeping too much or too little
- · Visiting or calling people to say goodbye
- Giving away prized possessions

Mood

Mood also is a potential indicator that a person might be having suicidal thoughts. In addition to depression and anxiety, people who are considering taking their own lives may exhibit a loss of interest in things they once enjoyed. Irritability, humiliation, agitation/anger, and relief/ sudden improvement are other moods the AFSP notes may be warning signs for suicide.

The deaths of two highly regarded celebrities brought suicide to the forefront in 2018. Taking the time to understand suicide and its warning signs can help people prevent tragedies.
