# **Supplies for Teachers**







### **Spec Building** in Rogersville

ROGERSVILLE — Officials in Rogersville celebrated completion of the newest Shoals Economic Development Authority speculative building last week at Rogersville Business Park.

The \$550,000 structure has up to 80,000 square ft and is only 19 miles from Interstate 65. It sits on seven acres and has a 36-foot ceiling height. It represents the closest available SEDA structure to the \$1.6 billion Mazda Toyota Manufacturing USA plant under construction in the Huntsville. The plant is expected to open late in 2020 or early 2021 and will employ some 4,000 people.

Huntsville Mayor **Tommy Battle** recently said it is possible the Mazda Toyôta plant could produce as many as 25,000 spin-off jobs for the area.

### **Sheffield Eyes** 'Smoke Free'

SHEFFIELD — Smoke Free Shoals Coordinator, Melanie Dickens, discussed plans with the Sheffield City Council last week to help Sheffield to become the first city in the Shoals with a comprehensive nonsmoking policy. If enacted it would prohibit smoking in work places, including restaurants and bars, and in city parks.

restaurants in Sheffield that allow smoking according to Dickens. Cajuns, Casa Mexicana, and Fiesta Mexicana have smoking areas, and George's Steakhouse allows smoking in its bar area. The new law would prohibit smoking within 20 feet of any building entrance as

"Any decrease in exposure to secondhand smoke and environmental tobacco smoke is a healthy alternative for all the citizens of Alabama, Dickens said.

Mayor Ian Sanford is undecided on how he will vote on the proposed ordinance, and he wants to talk to business owners. "I'm not voting for it until I talk to them," he said. The council could vote on the ordinance as early as October 1.

According to Councilman, Steve Stanley, the ordinance would also prohibit smoking in public parks, and places where children play. Signs would be erected if the ordinance is approved, and police would have the authority to cite offenders.

Dickens said there are no Shoals cities that have comprehensive smoke-free ordinances.

### Watch Out for the Scams

Unsolicited investment offers and charitable solicitations seeking to capitalize on the aftermath of Hurricane Florence should be approached with extreme caution."

Red flags include unsolicited email, social media messages, crowdfunding pitches, or calls promoting investment pools. Scam artists may linger long after the storm has passed to prey on victims who anticipate receiving large lump-sum insurance settlements for damaged property and other losses.



I have been out of work for several months and do not believe I will be able to return to work. I want to file for social security disability, but I don't know where to start. What should I do? Thomas-Killen, AL

There are three ways to begin your application. 1) you can go to your local district social security office; 2) you can contact SSA by telephone at 1-800-772-1213 or 3) you can apply online at ssa.gov.

The first two forms you will have to complete will be the Application for disability benefits and the "DISABILITY REPORT – ADULT". The application itself is very basic,

asking such questions as your name, address, date of birth, social security number, etc. The disability report appeal is the form that begins to tell SSA the information they will need to determine if you are eligible for benefits. One section will ask you to list the types of jobs that you have performed in the last 15 years. In my opinion the most critical part of this form is where you list the doctors, hospitals, counselors, etc. from which you have received treatment for your impairments. Make sure you provide the address as well as the name of your treating sources.

Another section of the disability report requests that you list the medications that you are currently taking along with the doctor who prescribes them, the reason for the medication and any side effects.

After these forms have been submitted, your case will be sent to Disability Determination Services for medical evaluation. You will receive additional forms such as a work history report, a pain questionnaire, an adult function report or activity of daily living report. Return these forms as quickly as possible because no further evaluation of your claim will be made without those completed forms. There are no perfect answers to the questions, simply answer

truthfully and to the best of your ability.

The next step in the process will be the obtaining of your medical records. If you are able to obtain these records yourself and submit them to SSA it can help to speed up your case. The objective medical findings within your medical records will be the biggest factor used in determining if you are or are not disabled.

### E=MC2 Does Not Spell "GOD"?

Will Rogers once quipped, "We are all ignorant; we are just ignorant about different things." I thought about this quote when I read an article published on MSNBC.com a while back titled, "Einstein's 'God' Letter Fetches \$404,000." No one would question the brilliance of Einstein as a physicist. Today, even his name has become synonymous with high intellect. However, this article revealed a great deficiency in his thinking concerning God.

It all revolved around a handwritten letter addressed to philosopher, Erik Gutkind in January, 1954. It was sold by

Bloomsbury Auctions to an undisclosed collector for the whopping sum of \$404,000. But it was not only the sale price that raised eyebrows; it was also the content of the letter. Here is one of the quotes: "The word God is for me nothing more than the expression and product of human weaknesses, the Bible a collection of honorable but still primitive legends which are nevertheless pretty childish."

When I read this it reminded me of the words of Paul speaking of some of the "great thinkers" of his day: "For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent'. Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe" (1 Corinthians 1:18-21).

It is hard to comprehend that someone of Einstein's intelligence could weigh the evidence that abounds of God's existence and draw such a meaningless conclusion. Yet, he was not the first to do so and we know he was not the last.

In his letter to the Romans, Paul was very straightforward when talking about skeptics by pointing out that God had sufficiently revealed Himself through His creation. He penned, "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse..." (Romans 1:20).

However, before I finish, I have to say that mental brightness does not always equal spiritual darkness. For many among the wisest from the beginning of time have acknowledged Him and submitted to Him. Further, men and women (regardless of IQ) still wisely do! (cf. Proverbs 1:7).





# **Medicare Minute**

"Medicare Pre-AEP"

Each year anyone who is on Medicare and enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) has an open enrollment period to make changes in their plan if they wish. This open enrollment period is called the Annual Election Period (AEP). It extends from October 15th to December 7th. There is also a period from October 1st to October 14th that is commonly called Pre-AEP.

Pre-AEP is an important time for Medicare beneficiaries. Insurance companies who offer MAs or PDPs cannot release their plan information for 2019 until October 1st. You can use this time to review your current plan to see if there has been any significant changes in your premium or copays. It's also a good time to review the prescription drug coverage of your plan, especially if you have had changes in the drugs you are taking. If any new plans are coming into your county, this is the time they are announced so be on the lookout for those.

Pre-AEP can also be a confusing time. Although it's designed for you to gather information on any changes that are coming for 2019, you may get phone calls or letters from insurance companies or your local agent. Local agents, in particular, like to use Pre-AEP to reach out to their clients and do policy reviews for the next year. This is totally acceptable under Medicare rules. It is also acceptable for you to attend a meeting or seminar during Pre-AEP to hear the details of 2019 plans. The one thing you cannot do is officially sign up for a new plan until after October 15th.

The good news is if you're happy with the plan you are in you won't have to do a thing. You will automatically roll into the 2019 plan as long as it's still offered in your area. If you have any questions about Pre-AEP you can contact our office for more information.

### Give to Where **Money Works**

To the Editor:

Extraordinary caution is necessary in disaster donations.

It is commonplace these days in the aftermath of natural disasters for charities to swarm the airways and printed media soliciting donations. makes marketing sense to take advantage of the public giving mindset set in motion by wall to wall nonstop news coverage. The American Red Cross is infamous for this tactic, but it is hardly alone in the practice.

We the public would be better served if we examined closely the record of distribution of donated funds as cash direct disbursements to those in need. The Red Cross and the Salvation Army are in the forefront of assisting victims in disasters. How do they compare? CNN published an recently insightful revealing report that discloses that the American Red Cross actually dispenses only nine cents of every donated dollar to victims. The Red Cross CEO salary is currently reported at \$661,957. Fundraising work, overhead and salaries and benefits comprise 93% of every dollar! Furthermore, Red Cross officials have conceded that the sales pitch soliciting donations earmarked for the specific disaster at hand is simply a marketing ploy and that earmarking for a specific cause is NOT POSSIBLE! On the other hand, the Salvation Army has an entirely different positive image. A dramatic 85% of every donated dollar goes directly to needy recipients. At the same time, the Salvation Army CEO earns \$126,920 yearly!

# ON YOUR DEBT

# Will Filing a Bankruptcy Help Me Get My Suspended Driver's License Back?

Yes, in most circumstances, filing either a chapter 7 or chapter 13 bankruptcy will allow you to get your suspended driver's license reinstated.

### The Domino Effect of a Suspended License

Even though it is a requirement in many states to carry a bare minimum of liability insurance, unfortunately, many folks are just simply unable to afford to do so. Many times, this results in an uninsured auto accident. If the uninsured driver is at fault and unable to pay for the damage to the other party, it can result in several bad things including a lawsuit, judgments and even the suspension of the uninsured's driver's license.

Although none of these consequences are good, the suspension of the driver license can be crippling! Without a license, one cannot get a car registered in their name, a valid tag for a vehicle they already have and take great risk of driving on the suspended license. Therefore, the uninsured person typically cannot remain employed. If not employed, it might seem impossible to ever climb out of this situation.

### How Bankruptcy Can Help You

If you are in this situation, I recommend exploring the filing of a chapter 7 or chapter 13 bankruptcy that will allow you to immediately get your driver's license reinstated in most circumstances. There are some nuances as to whether you can or cannot discharge this type of debt in bankruptcy, but as stated above in most cases you are able to do so.

For instance, if you were charged with driving under the influence (DUI) in conjunction with the uninsured accident, the debt typically cannot be discharged in any kind of bankruptcy. Another example would be a judgment for negligence or wantonness in conjunction with the accident. This is a little more of a gray area than a DUI charge and may still be able to be included in a bankruptcy. These nuances are why it is very important to consult with an attorney who is specializes in bankruptcy. In most cases, where I see a suspended license because of an uninsured accident (a non-serious, run of the mill accident), we are able to successfully file a chapter 7 or chapter 13 and get your driver's license reinstated in a timely manner.

The process can actually be quite quick to get your license reinstated once you file your bankruptcy petition. Typically, once filed, we write a letter to the Department of Public Safety with proof of you bankruptcy filing. You then take the letter with you to the Department to begin the reinstatement process. There is a reinstatement fee for which you are responsible so include this fee in your planning.

### Ask Dr. Webb



Can a patient in hospice be taken to the ER, or admitted to hospital, if necessary? Some people have been told Medicare will not pay and want to know what to do if pain isn't controlled.

There are really two issues here.

1. Can hospice patients still go to the **ER/hospital?** Yes. The primary goal of Medicare for hospice patients is to help

them to remain at home, and die there comfortably, with dignity. Therefore, a hospice is obligated to do whatever's necessary to achieve that, including continuous care by an RN during times of any symptom crisis.

The hospice cannot make a patient revoke hospice [give up their hospice service] just because they need to be in the hospital to control symptoms.

When symptoms can't be controlled, or some unrelated crisis occurs [such as falling and breaking a hip], a hospice should arrange for patients to be taken to the ER, stabilized and return home, or to be admitted. And these services are covered, either through the hospice benefit or under 'regular' Medicare.

2. How to control someone's pain? Hospice staff are responsible for controlling a patient's symptoms, whether it's pain, shortness of breath, etc.

Suggestions for pain: start with extended-release acetaminophen [Tylenol Arthritis] combined with non-drug options [such as rubbing a mentholated cream, like Bengay or Biofreeze, into the painful area]. If that doesn't help, adding much stronger drugs, like the narcotics morphine or methadone is usually successful. In our hospice, many patients requiring a narcotic are using methadone with good success—although more sedating, it has better pain relief and is less expensive than other narcotics.

Just because a drug didn't help one person, doesn't mean it won't work for someone else. Each of us is unique and often require a 'trial-and-error' approach until something is found to work!





### **Editor's Comments:**

Anita Hill supposedly had "nothing to gain" by her accusations as is the claim with Dr. Christine Blasey Ford. Once headed for what would likely be a ho-hum government or teaching position, Hill used her lies to capitalize on premium speaking opportunities, movie deals, book deals, and so on. Her current estimated net worth is \$6.3 million.

Monetary issues aside, any accusers against prominent pro-life candidates receive instant sainthood status by abortion advocates - however inappropriate my wording. Hill is actually making recommendations to the current judiciary committee in the Kavanaugh case.

In a recent New York Times Op-Ed, Hill said that the senators failed her.

"In 1991 the Senate Judiciary Committee had an opportunity to demonstrate its appreciation for both

the seriousness of sexual harassment claims and the need for public confidence in the character of a nominee to the Supreme Court," she wrote. "It failed on both counts.

With such glaring vagaries and inconsistencies in Ms. Ford's account, there is no reason her claims should be given any credence, either.

candidly. "By the time I was 13, my mother kicked me out of the house. That opened up the door to drugs and homelessness. I moved from friends to family. At the same time, I still was able

to graduate high school."

Although she made a profession of faith in Christ at age 16, the Grant, Alabama native didn't understand the need to change her lifestyle to match her newfound faith. By age 19, Roland was pregnant and single with little hope for a stable or successful future.

Asking God to give her a reason to quit using drugs, Roland's pregnancy became that motivation. "God was like, 'Okay, here's your reason to stop.' That's when I quit doing the drugs." I quit doing the drugs. I wanted to be a better mother for my child than what I had growing up."
At the same time, Roland

said she began visiting area churches as she started searching for God more on a deeper level. That led to a church member introducing her to Christian Women's Job Corps.

She went through the program twice at the CWJC site in Guntersville. Roland acknowledged that she still struggled a little bit. She eventually moved to Florence, got a job at an area hospital, and discovered that through her CWJC classes, mentoring and Bible studies she had gained the tools that she needed to succeed.

Working at the hospital as a phlebotomist for five years, "I was able to save up enough money to work on my credit to be able to buy a home," Roland explained.
"Once I was able to sign the contract on my home is when I decided that I wanted to help other women overcome the same obstacles that I have. That's when God started putting Christian Women's Job Corps on my heart. That was in 2016 and now we are going into our second year of classes.

One of the primary goals

of Christian Women's Job Corps and Christian Men's Job Corps is to equip men and women for life and employment, said Lena Plunk, WMU's ministries consultant for mobilization and national CWJC/CMJC coordinator. "When we see CWJC/CMJC graduates continuing to move forward, we have accomplished this

"When a CWJC/CMJC participant graduates from the program and gives back to the community, it is evidence of the impact the ministry has had in his or her life," she emphasized. "They are able to use what was once seen as a weakness in their life as a strength to empower others.'

In Roland's case, Plunk affirmed that her desire is to serve women who have been in similar places that she has been. Her commitment to achieve that goal is a picture of the continual cycle of change that can happen in the lives of those this ministry serves.

"Her life has been changed and she now wants to share that change with others in hopes that their lives are also transformed through Christ," Plunk said. "This is a pattern that has the potential of being ongoing and reaching the lives of many other people for years to come."

According to Roland, one of the most inspiring aspects of the program is seeing what all gets poured into this ministry from the volunteers, the instructors, the mentors, the site coordinator - the work, the tears, the prayers. She said, "All of that has impacted me on another level. Having someone believe in me and not giving up on me as a participant has got me to where I am. It has strengthened my relationship with Jesus and just being able to be more successful."

That same passion that was given to me is now what I want to do for others," she declared. Although she readily admits that she feels unqualified to be in this role, Roland added, "The more I feel that God does not call the qualified. He qualifies the called. Seeing that I can relate to the participants on a whole different level has given me the ability to keep going. However, it is still a challenge. I have to give things over to God daily." As a site coordinator,

Roland enlists church and community leaders to provide such resources as Bible study, mentoring, job readiness, computer skills, and more to benefit participants enrolled in the program. Many churches through several denominations are involved locally. The organization is currently conducting a needs assessment and reaching out to other groups and organizations to expand networking efforts in the community before starting CWJC's next session of classes.

What is the payoff as she invests her time and energy in women facing some of the same struggles she has overcome? "Seeing lives changed and seeing the ladies have hope. Knowing that they can do better and knowing there are people out there who want to see them succeed."

Roland encourages other individuals and churches to consider hosting Christian Women's Job Corps or Christian Men's Job Corps ministries. She said, "If your heart is in helping others, this is a ministry to get plugged into.'

### PRINCIPAL BASED **NEGOTIATION**

There was once a story about two chefs who were fighting over the last orange in the kitchen. They both needed an orange for their recipe. After bickering over it they decided to split the orange 50/50, and each take half.

One chef squeezed the juice from his half of the orange into his special sauce and threw the peel in the garbage. The other chef carefully grated the peel of his half into his cake mix and discarded the rest. Neither chef had quite enough of what they needed but would have to make it work.

Negotiating on position or "digging in" to one side can be detrimental to the outcome of what you're trying to achieve. Instead of negotiating on the "what", ask questions and find out the "why". Focus on principal, not position.

This is the main point of the book I'm currently reading: Getting to Yes: Negotiating Agreement Without Giving In, by Roger Fisher, William Ury, and Bruce Patton from the Harvard Negotiation Project.

Think of the two chefs mentioned above. What if they had discussed what it was that they needed from the orange? One needed only the juice, and the other chef needed only the peel. They both could have benefitted from the entire orange instead of

Negotiation is a major part of a real estate transaction. First, you negotiate price. Then, who pays closing costs, possession dates, etc? Next, there will likely be negotiations on repairs once the home has been inspected. It will always help to ask questions when negotiating these terms. This will allow you to find out what is really important to each party.

Too many times a negotiation will fail to come to an agreement because someone thinks they have to "win".

If a buyer is not willing to meet your price, ask why. It could be that they are concerned about the age of your central unit. In this case, you might offer to pay for a two-year home warranty, which will give them piece of mind for the first couple of years.

Asking the right questions may allow you to benefit from the whole orange instead of only half. On the flip side, not asking "why" may leave you holding on to that house until the next offer comes along, which will most likely be less than the offer you have right now. -mr

Family and friends maintained a 24hour vigil throughout the 15 days he was hospitalized.



Dear Robin,

There's nothing wrong with small beginnings. On top of that, you should always keep your business and personal finances separate. Aside from the debt, it sounds like he's off to a good start.


I think you'll be able to pay off the debt from your future income. If your husband started his business less than a year ago, he has spent that time trying to get things off the ground and working with very little name recognition. If he's good at what he does, and he continues to work hard and market himself properly, he should be able to double what he made in the last year.

To do that, however, he's going to have to spend some time in accountant mode. He needs to figure out the types of jobs he makes the most money on for the time he puts into them. I know a guy in our area who made more than \$100,000 as a handyman in the last year. I'm talking about \$100,000 in profit! His prices are higher than most in that line of work, but he's the best. He provides superb quality work, and he's always polite, on time, and on schedule.

If your husband does the research and crunches some numbers, I think he can dial it in and make a lot more money than he's making now. Find that sweet spot, and he'll continue to grow the business! —Dave

### **FORGIVE THE DEBT?**

Dear Dave,

Recently, I loaned some money to a good friend. He's going to help me with a big home project over the next few weekends, so do you think I should pay him for the work or forgive the debt?

Marvin

Dear Marvin,

First, I don't recommend loaning money to friends or family. Once in a while, things may work out and everyone ends up happy. But in most cases, it changes the dynamic of the relationship. The Bible savs the borrower is a slave to the lender, and there's a lot of truth in that — financially and emotionally.

The big question is whether you've already agreed to pay him for the work. Another consideration is how he views the situation. He may be looking at this as just helping a buddy, and he still owes the money.

Ask him what his expectations are before you guys start the job. Just talk to him, and figure out what seems fair to you both. If you've already agreed on a certain amount, and the value of the work is close to what you loaned him, you might discuss the idea of paying back the debt that way.

But in the future, if someone close to you really needs financial help — and you're not enabling bad behavior in the process — just make the money a gift.


