Dear Speak Out,

My last letter to Speak Out was during the 2000s, long before Greg O'Connell started his rehab/gentrification of our Main Street business district. At the time, conditions here inspired me to incite a revolution via the now defunct Yahoo Groups. I wanted to facilitate peaceful dialog between concerned citizens to improve life in Mt. Morris by whatever strategies that made sense - political or otherwise. Unfortunately, a troll or two created some challenges that made the group not so peaceful. I'm hopeful that in the Facebook era a similar gathering can occur with more control over who/how people slink into the discussion.

Are things better now than they were ten or fifteen years ago? Absolutely. But a recent development has once again stirred my itchy typing fingers into action: The constant stream of out-of-state speeders who use our Main Street as if it's their personal, toll-free Thruway from NY City, NJ and PA to the Niagara Falls/Canada area. Okay, calling them "speeders" is not sufficiently descriptive: Cars consistently drive through at +/-50MPH, sometimes more, throughout the day every day of the week. If they're behind you, they tailgate if you're lucky - otherwise, they pass at full throttle.

Why is this suddenly an issue? Firstly, blame Google Maps. Smartphones weren't prevalent a decade ago. Open your Google Maps app and navigate from NYC to Niagara Falls. Then, set your route to avoid tolls. It will take you through Mt. Morris.

Secondly, and the crux of my concern, is that there appears to be a significant drop in speed enforcement by the MMPD.

I used to see multiple traffic stops a day near the Mt. Morris Veterans Park trap. Now, I see one or two per week. Granted, I don't have hard stats to back up my impression, which is based on casual observation, but I am confident that there have been fewer pull overs this year.

Why? I've heard rumors of personnel changes at our police department - officers leaving or being forced to leave. Have they been backfilled? Is officer head count the issue?

Or, was there a change in directive by leadership?

Regardless of the cause, I maintain that this issue has become epidemic and must be summarily dealt with - rather than waiting for a major accident to take action as often happens with traffic situations. And since I'm not one to point out an issue without also providing possible solutions, I offer this help to existing Village leadership as a courtesy because, I believe, this is a major safety concern: There needs to be a police car, preferably manned, at each end of this Village from 6am to midnight every minute of every day of the week.

Period.

I don't care if we have to call a temp agency for contract officers, or draw a nose and mouth on a balloon wearing a pair of Ray Bans to stick behind the wheel of a parked police cruiser at Veterans Park, there should always be police presence there.

I have no idea how much revenue the village earns from ticket fines, but if it's not sufficient to offset the cost of additional personnel, then I'm sure the budget can be massaged as necessary to get those dollars considering the community's safety is at stake.

We could also contact the Sheriff's office to pursue those "Your Speed is..." radar trailers. Less effective than real officers, sure, but better than the current system where I flail my arms at oncoming speeders.

I've resorted to putting signs in my front yard out of desperation; I shouldn't have to. I also doubt they help. If I stand practically in front of these cars waving my arms, it doesn't help - I know this, as I said, because this is the current speed prevention system and I do it daily to generally poor results.

No citizen should have to put signs in front of their house because they don't feel safe... One of the key services provided by our tax dollars isn't providing adequately for our safety.

I fully support our police officers and understand that not every problem perceived by the community is solvable. But, history has shown that frequency of this problem can be greatly reduced simply by greater police presence and speed enforcement.

Make Your Child's Lunchbox Safe



With school back in session, parents often wonder what can be done to keep their children healthy. Packing children's lunches is a great way to save money, ensure that they get the nutrition they need, and can make lunchtime more fun. However, parents need to be sure that they prepare and pack food properly to prevent food-borne illnesses.

The Children's Nutrition Research Center of Baylor University offers the following tips for lunch box safety (www.kidsnutrition.org).

- Wash hands, food preparation surfaces and utensils with hot soapy water before making lunch. Wash raw fruit and vegetables thoroughly.
- After preparing lunches, remember to immediately return unused portions of perishable foods, like cheeses, deli meats, and mayonnaise, to the refrigerator. Don't let them sit on the counter.
- Make sure that cold foods are cold before packing them in a lunch box. If possible, prepare the lunch the night before and store it in the refrigerator.
- Insulated lunch bags or boxes are the best way to keep food at a safe temperature until noon. Put a frozen juice pouch or ice pack inside and cold foods will stay extra cool.
- At school, instruct children to store their lunch box out of direct sunlight and away from radiators or other heaters if possible.
- Keep hot foods, like soups, stews or chilies, hot! In the morning, bring the food to a boil and then immediately pour into a hot, sterile vacuum bottle.
- Lunch foods that can be eaten at room temperature include:
 - Peanut Butter
 - Jams and jellies
 - Breads, crackers, cereals
 - Clean fruits and vegetables
 - Canned meat or poultry products that are eaten immediately after opening.

Packing children's lunches can turn into a fun event for your children. Often times, parents use this time to connect with their children, and to let them know that they are thinking of them. One idea is to make cookie cutter shapes out of their sandwich. This makes an unexpected change to their daily menu. Another way to make lunch fun is to write a silly message or quote, and position it in a noticeable spot in their lunch box. Always remember to include at least one serving of fruits or vegetables in every lunch to help them meet the goal of 5 a day!
