Colbert TCB Earns PEAK

"We just really hit on a need and it paid off as more and more visitors started coming in," Hamlin said. "We're getting repeat tours and instead of staying one day, they're staying two or in some cases longer.

After going through 30,000 brochures in 14 months, a second printing is underway. "We're a small staff operating on a small budget but we managed to address these needs and it's been a good thing for tourism in our county," Hamlin added.

After that I made a double video. were watching (you have a fine taste :)), and second part displays the recording of your web camera, yea it is u.

The email goes on to threaten to send the salacious video to all my friends unless I send them a \$7,000 ransom within 24 hours. Is that scary or what? Well, since I have not subscribed to any website like that, I'm gonna say, "No." But there is something a

bit unsettling about this that certainly got my attention. The password "FordF150" actually is a "throwaway" password I used long ago when I actually owned a Ford F150. I used it for one-time logins for websites such as newspapers that require an account to view an article. So how did they know my password?

These scammers know that most of us use the same password across many websites. Email and passwords have been stolen from legitimate websites such as Netflix over the years. These leaked email addresses and passwords are shared between scammers. They also know that many of us have signed up for naughty websites. Mix these facts together and you get a recipe for extortion. The scammers simply copied my stolen email address and password into their form letter and sent it to me hoping that I had signed up for some naughty website sometime in the past.

There is a website you can use to see if your email address and password has been hacked called haveibeenpwned.com. I


plugged my email address in there and is does show that a trial account I used for Netflix was hacked back in 2014.







what does blue cross blue shield have to do with it?

You should be reimbursed for the pay you missed and you should be compensated for the pain you suffered. I guarantee you that if it were the insurance adjuster who had missed his pay check and had been injured, he would insist on the same.

We go to such great lengths to enjoy our lives and be comfortable and safe that an injury caused by someone else's inattention while driving is unacceptable. Alabama law provides, just like the Bible and other codes of justice, for compensation for wrong. Alabama law says that you are entitled to be reimbursed for your loss wages and that people sitting on a jury just like you get to decide how much money it is worth to be injured through not fault of your own.

Blue Cross Blue Shield is entitled to be paid back for money they spent for your medical bills. They have to share in the cost of the recovery meaning that they have to pay their fair share of the attorney's fees and costs for recovering that money. Occasionally this is extremely important in cases where the medical bills exceed the amount of available insurance coverage. In those cases we can negotiate with Blue Cross Blue Shield to lower the amount they claim so that everybody gets some monetary compensation. If Blue Cross paid \$30,000 in medical bills and all the available coverage totaled \$30,000, Blue Cross would have to take under \$20,000 and would likely accept \$10,000.

One of the most unfair laws ever passed in this State is the law that says that if someone like you injured through no fault of their own has insurance to pay their bills the jury is told of the injured party's insurance. The jury can never be told that the defendant has insurance and as I have stated many times before insurance defense attorneys go to great lengths to hide the fact that the defendant has a lawyer paid for by the insurance company and an insurance company to pay the jury verdict. So the person who did wrong hides the fact that they have insurance and the person who was injured through no fault of their own gets less money because they had the foresight to have insurance.

After this, we never seemed to get around to paying him back. He died earlier this year, and when we got together with my brother and sister for the reading of the will, we realized he had deducted the amount of the loan from my inheritance. Everything was equal between us before that. I think that's wrong. What's your opinion? Karen

Dear Karen, I'm really sorry about your dad. I'm also sorry this was never taken care of or discussed while he was still alive.

There are a lot of emotions at play, so I don't want to beat you up too much. But legally, he didn't have to leave you anything in his es-tate. The stuff we're talking about, money included, was his to do with as he saw fit. It was a little odd that he didn't address this with you beforehand, but there are lots of instances where kids get nothing from an estate or not as much as others. It's not uncommon.

In my mind, and, from the sound of it, his too, he left you an equal share minus what you still owed. He loaned you the money, and he had the right to set terms on that. I understand your frustration. You feel like he took something away that was yours. My point is it was never yours; it was his. I know it still hurts though. This is one of the reasons I advise never borrowing money from, or loaning it to, relatives. The best of intentions can end


up in places like this.



Since we returned I have been asked several times which wild animals we got to see and which one I enjoyed the most. Even though I could name most of the animals we

saw, picking out a favorite would be a tough task. There is one animal I saw in a refuge, however, that would not actually be my favorite, but it is one that I will remember for a long time. It is not the most graceful creature. It is not majestic. It will never be known for its beauty. And probably most people are not even familiar with it, but it is an interesting animal named a "muskox."

I am sure that in the wild it would have to be aggressive to survive, but in the refuge this animal was about as laidback as it comes. But here is the characteristic that I remember the most. The guide pointed out that the weather conditions have to be "somewhat ideal" for the muskox to move around much. If it is too hot he tends to just stand in one place. If the weather is too cold he also tends to just stand in one place. Much like in the story of Goldilocks and Three Bears, the muskox prefers for everything to be "just right." As I thought about what the guide said about the muskox, I could not help but think about some people who live by the same rule. Especially when it comes to spiritual matters they are waiting for everything in their life to be "just right" before they "get right" with God. Solomon wrote in the long ago, "He who observes the wind will not sow, and he regards the clouds will not reap" (Ecclesiastes 12:4). He was making this same point. If one is always looking for an ideal time for doing what needs to be done he will never find it. He usually finds himself only making excuses. Do you remember the old religious song, Excuses Excuses, dealing with why folks don't go to church? *In the summer it's too hot.* And, in the winter, it's too cold. In the springtime when the weather's just right You find someplace else to go...

Medicare Minute "Annual Enrollment Period"

Open enrollment season for Medicare beneficiaries begins on October 15th and extends through December 7th. This is also known as the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). AEP is an important time for anyone who is already on Medicare. These dates are very specific. You cannot enroll in a plan prior to October 15th or after December 7th unless you have a special circumstance.

AEP is specifically designed to give you an opportunity to enroll into a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or prescription drug plan (PDP) for 2019. If you are already on a MA or PDP it is the time for you to review your plan and determine if you want to make any changes for the next year. Either way there are some things that you'll want to consider.

If you are currently on or are considering a MA or PDP you want to look at the premium, copays, deductibles, coinsurance and the providers that take the plan. You will also want to look at the plan's drug formulary to be sure the prescription drugs you are taking are covered. Plan details can change from year to year so don't assume the 2019 plans will be exactly like the 2018 plans. Also, companies may introduce a new plan in your area for 2019 that may fit your needs better than the plan you are currently on.

A confusing thing about AEP is how Medicare supplements are treated. If you are on a Medicare supplement you do not have to wait until AEP to change plans. If you want to change to another supplement you can do that at any time during the year if you meet the new plan's guidelines. But if you are enrolled in a stand-alone PDP with your supplement the only time you can change the PDP is during AEP.
