**Colbert TCB
Earns PEAK**

DECATUR—The Colbert County Tourism and Convention Bureau has been named Organization of the Year by the Alabama Mountain Lakes Tourist Association.

The award was one of eleven given out last week during the organization's PEAK Awards ceremony and annual meeting.

The Organization of the Year award is presented to the group that has contributed most significantly to the betterment and development of tourism in north Alabama in the past year.

The honor is primarily result of Colbert Tourism's role in marketing the music studios in Colbert County, reaching new visitors with materials, and assisted with tremendous growth in the county, especially with music attractions.

Colbert County Tourism consistently branded the music of Muscle Shoals using, "We Rocked the World" on all marketing materials.

Colbert Tourism Director **Susann Hamlin** and her office staff recognized that there were no music related materials to give potential visitors who were being drawn by the sudden attention brought about by the documentary "Muscle Shoals," the renovations at Muscle Shoals Sound, and so forth.

"We just really hit on a need and it paid off as more and more visitors started coming in," Hamlin said. "We're getting repeat tours and instead of staying one day, they're staying two or in some cases longer."

After going through 30,000 brochures in 14 months, a second printing is underway. "We're a small staff operating on a small budget but we managed to address these needs and it's been a good thing for tourism in our county," Hamlin added.

MONTGOMERY—The Alabama State Parks Foundation was incorporated earlier this year. It will work in a private-public partnership with the Alabama State Parks Administration to support and enhance one of our State's great treasures.

The passage of Amendment Two in the 2016 election ensures future funding integrity for the State Parks system. The Alabama State Parks Foundation will advance funding initiatives to help ensure another century of park service

to all the citizens of Alabama.

State Parks Director, Greg Lein, and newly elected Chairman and President of the Parks Foundation, Dr. Dan L. Hendricks, were in town recently to discuss the opportunity with Florence Rotary Club members.

The Parks System encompasses 22 parks spread throughout the state. The system hosts over 5 million visitors annually from just down the road

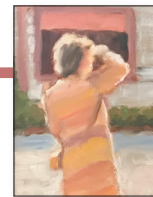

and around the world. Its \$40 million budget is a major driver of economic development in Alabama.

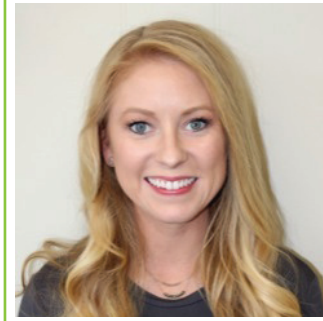
"The Foundation Board of Directors represents regions across the state, Hendricks said. "These are leaders in business, art and culture, environmentalism, and recreation who have a passion for our wonderful parks system. We are delighted to partner with the State Parks to advance its mission of service to the citizens of Alabama."

The first state parks were constructed over 75 years ago in cooperation with the Federal Government and local communities. Several of the earliest parks were constructed by young men working in the Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC).

Lein also serves as the Foundation's Treasurer.

"With this Parks Foundation effort led by Dr. Hendricks, our state joins 47 other states in America that work to support and develop our beautiful parks," Lein said. "Now funds can be raised through estate giving, philanthropy, or other tax-efficient options."

"The budget is nice, but Joe Wheeler and all our parks need more for needed upgrades and to remain prime destination points. That's where the Foundation comes in," he added.

The video of him straining against the 'huge gusts' has been a source of amusement all over YouTube and other social media platforms as two men in shorts casually stroll through the frame...twice.

The scammers simply copied my stolen email address and password into their form letter and sent it to me hoping that I had signed up for some naughty website sometime in the past.

There is a website you can use to see if your email address and password has been hacked called haveibeenpwned.com. I

plugged my email address in there and it does show that a trial account I used for Netflix was hacked back in 2014.

So what should you do if you receive one of these? First, give your cardiologist the good news that you passed a stress test. Next, calm down. You aren't about to be exposed. I promise.

Seidel's actions were a means of sensationalizing the story, not just reporting it. Of course company executives were quick to defend the behavior throwing out long hours, fatigue, and a grass base as reasons for his footing being so tenuous. Even that didn't explain why he was bracing in the wrong direction to offset the wind speed.

If this represents something acceptable to Weather Channel officials, it's no wonder that its founder, John Coleman, decreed the politically-funded and agenda-driven global warming proponents associated with the company.

Scientists and researchers share much of the \$2.6 billion allocated in annual

federal grants for global warming/climate change research. Coleman knew that building their careers and living well based on that theory was neither genuine nor fair to the taxpayer.

It's a good point. The money flow is in direct conflict to a purely scientific perspective, especially when the baseline for all the subsequent scientific climate figures was falsified from the outset.

ASK THE ATTORNEY

Q I was in an automobile accident and went to the ER by ambulance. After a couple of weeks I went to (a chiropractor) and after a month or so of weekly treatments began to feel a lot better. The accident was caused by the driver who hit me from behind but his insurance company says that because my Blue Cross Blue Shield paid most of the bills that they will not pay me without paying Blue Cross and if they do that there won't be any money for me. I really hurt for a while and missed three days work which I needed and think I am due some money. How much should they have to pay me and what does blue cross blue shield have to do with it?

Thomas-Killen, AL

A You should be reimbursed for the pay you missed and you should be compensated for the pain you suffered. I guarantee you that if it were the insurance adjuster who had missed his pay check and had been injured, he would insist on the same.

We go to such great lengths to enjoy our lives and be comfortable and safe that an injury caused by someone else's inattention while driving is unacceptable. Alabama law provides, just like the Bible and other codes of justice, for compensation for wrong. Alabama law says that you are entitled to be reimbursed for your loss wages and that people sitting on a jury just like you get to decide how much money it is worth to be injured through not fault of your own.

Blue Cross Blue Shield is entitled to be paid back for money they spent for your medical bills. They have to share in the cost of the recovery meaning that they have to pay their fair share of the attorney's fees and costs for recovering that money. Occasionally this is extremely important in cases where the medical bills exceed the amount of available insurance coverage. In those cases we can negotiate with Blue Cross Blue Shield to lower the amount they claim so that everybody gets some monetary compensation. If Blue Cross paid \$30,000 in medical bills and all the available coverage totaled \$30,000, Blue Cross would have to take under \$20,000 and would likely accept \$10,000.

One of the most unfair laws ever passed in this State is the law that says that if someone like you injured through no fault of their own has insurance to pay their bills the jury is told of the injured party's insurance. The jury can never be told that the defendant has insurance and as I have stated many times before insurance defense attorneys go to great lengths to hide the fact that the defendant has a lawyer paid for by the insurance company and an insurance company to pay the jury verdict. So the person who did wrong hides the fact that they have insurance and the person who was injured through no fault of their own gets less money because they had the foresight to have insurance.

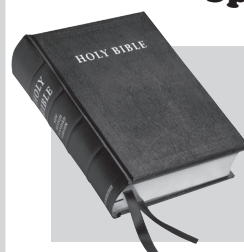

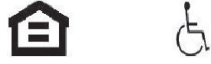

I'm really sorry about your dad. I'm also sorry this was never taken care of or discussed while he was still alive.

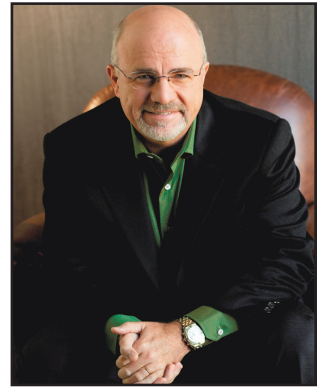
There are a lot of emotions at play, so I don't want to beat you up too much. But legally, he didn't have to leave you anything in his estate. The stuff we're talking about, money included, was his to do with as he saw fit. It was a little odd that he didn't address this with you beforehand, but there are lots of instances where kids get nothing from an estate or not as much as others. It's not uncommon.

In my mind, and, from the sound of it, his too, he left you an equal share minus what you still owed. He loaned you the money, and he had the right to set terms on that. I understand your frustration. You feel like he took something away that was yours. My point is it was never yours; it was his.

I know it still hurts though. This is one of the reasons I advise never borrowing money from, or loaning it to, relatives. The best of intentions can end up in places like this.

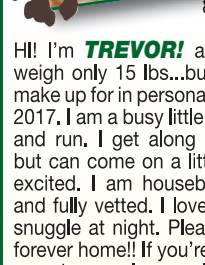

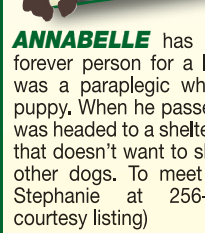

Medicare Minute "Annual Enrollment Period"

Open enrollment season for Medicare beneficiaries begins on October 15th and extends through December 7th. This is also known as the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). AEP is an important time for anyone who is already on Medicare. These dates are very specific. You cannot enroll in a plan prior to October 15th or after December 7th unless you have a special circumstance.

AEP is specifically designed to give you an opportunity to enroll into a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or prescription drug plan (PDP) for 2019. If you are already on a MA or PDP it is the time for you to review your plan and determine if you want to make any changes for the next year. Either way there are some things that you'll want to consider.

If you are currently on or are considering a MA or PDP you want to look at the premium, copays, deductibles, coinsurance and the providers that take the plan. You will also want to look at the plan's drug formulary to be sure the prescription drugs you are taking are covered. Plan details can change from year to year so don't assume the 2019 plans will be exactly like the 2018 plans. Also, companies may introduce a new plan in your area for 2019 that may fit your needs better than the plan you are currently on.

A confusing thing about AEP is how Medicare supplements are treated. If you are on a Medicare supplement you do not have to wait until AEP to change plans. If you want to change to another supplement you can do that at any time during the year if you meet the new plan's guidelines. But if you are enrolled in a stand-alone PDP with your supplement the only time you can change the PDP is during AEP.

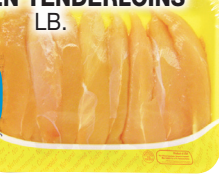

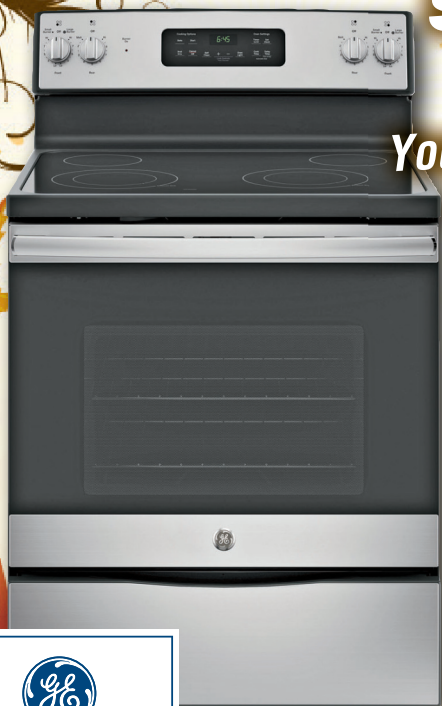
