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



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

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Coconut-Pumpkin

Ingredients Bread

1/2 cup butter softened

1 cup granulated sugar

1/3 cup packed brown sugar

2 eggs



1 teaspoon vanilla

1/2 cup flaked coconut

1/2 cup chopped walnuts

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon. baking powder

1 tablespoon pumpkin pie spice

Glaze

1 cup white vanilla baking chips

2 tablespoons whipping cream

2 tablespoons flaked coconut

Steps

- 1. Heat oven to 350°F. Lightly spray 9 x 5 inch loaf pan with cooking spray.
- 2. In large bowl, beat butter and both sugars with electric mixer on medium speed until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs, pumpkin and vanilla. Stir in 1/2 cup coconut and the walnuts. Add flour, baking soda, baking powder and pumpkin pie spice; gently stir in. Pour batter into pan.

 3. Bake 50 to 60 minutes or until toothpick inserted in

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PUMPKIN BREADS

4. In small microwavable bowl, microwave vanilla baking chips and whipping cream on High in 30-second increments, stirring between microwaving, until mixture is smooth and creamy. If too thick, add small amount of cream. Drizzle over cooled loaf; sprinkle with coconut. Let glaze set before slicing.

RUSTIC PUMPKIN

Ingredients

3 cups sugar

1 can (15 ounces) solid-pack pumpkin

1 cup canola oil

4 large Eggs

2/3 cup water

3-1/2 cups all-purpose flour

2 teaspoons baking soda

1 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/2 teaspoon ground cloves

1/2 cup chopped pecans

TOPPING:

1/3 cup all-purpose flour

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

2 tablespoons cold butter

1/4 cup chopped pecans

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Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, beat the sugar, pumpkin, oil, eggs and water until blended. In a large bowl, combine the flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves; gradually beat into pumpkin mixture until blended. Stir in pecans.
- 2. Pour into two greased 9 x 5 in. loaf pans. For topping, in a small bowl, combine the flour, brown sugar and cinnamon; cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in pecans. Sprinkle over batter.
- 3. Bake at 350° for 60-65 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks.

PRALINE PUMPKIN DATE

Ingredients

Praline Topping


1/3 cup packed brown sugar 1/3 cup chopped pecans 1 tablespoon butter or margarine, softened



Date Bread

- 1 2/3 cups granulated sugar
- 2/3 cup vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 4 eggs
- 1 can (15 ounces) pumpkin (not pumpkin pie mix)
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1 cup chopped dates

- 1. Move oven rack to low position so that tops of pans will be in center of oven. Heat oven to 350° F. Grease bottoms only of 2 loaf pans, $8 \% \times 4 \% \times 2 1/2$ inches, or 1 loaf pan, $9 \times 5 \times 3$ inches, with shortening.
- 2. Mix all Praline Topping ingredients until crumbly; set aside.
- 3. In large bowl, mix granulated sugar, oil, vanilla, eggs and pumpkin. Stir in remaining Date Bread ingredients except dates until well blended. Stir in dates. Pour batter into pans. Sprinkle with topping.
- 4. Bake 8-inch loaves 50 to 60 minutes, 9-inch loaf 1 hour 10 minutes to 1 hour 20 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes. Loosen sides of loaves from pans; remove from pans to wire rack. Cool completely, about 1 hour, before slicing.

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


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Veterinarian Scam



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
BLIND SPOT

What's the first thing you think of when you hear the word "blind spot"? Yes, operating a motor vehicle is what comes to most of our minds when we think of a blind spot. It is an area that is



not able to be seen, either due to its location outside of the field of vision or due to some physical obstruction or a defect in one's vision. It's often used to describe the areas around a car that cannot be seen with the rearview or side mirrors.



Take a moment to think about a motor vehicles blind spot. If you are driving in a car and relying on your rearview mirrors to check the lanes, then there are some spots that you still will not be able to see such as the back right and

left corners. Those are considered the blind spots. Now, you can turn your head and take a gaze at those spots so that you will know if there is anything there, but for that one moment that you are checking your blind spots, you are now unaware of what is happening in front of your vehicle. In our spiritual walk with God, we may encounter or at some point have some blind spots in our lives. John 9:39 Then Jesus declared, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind may see and those who see may become blind." In John chapter 9 Jesus said the Pharisees were blind. The irony is that Jesus had just healed a blind man. In the aftermath of the story, when the Pharisees tried to find a legal technicality to undo the miracle that Jesus had performed, they reveal themselves to have a blind spot where Jesus is concerned. Jesus said that He came so that those who do not see may see, and that those who think they see will realize that they are blind. Revealing their arrogance and pride, the Pharisees responded to Jesus by saying, "Surely we are not blind, are we?" Jesus had just cured blind eyes, and the Pharisees were trying to say that He wasn't of God. "Blind Spots"

Some things that can be considered blind spots in our lives are: our Pride, Religious beliefs, Self-

Righteousness/Selfishness, Unwillingness to submit to God's Word, Bitterness (Are you angry about something in your life?) Unforgiveness/Justifiable Resentment, and Disobedience. These are some of the ill feelings and negative emotions that will obstruct, defect and skew our spiritual vision of the will of God for our life and create "Blind Spots". Isaiah 42:6-7 "I, the LORD, have called you for a righteous purpose, and I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and appoint you to be a covenant for the people and a light to the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring prisoners out of the dungeon, and those sitting in darkness out from the prison house. Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

There is a "Remedy" for the Blind Spots! Go to the Lord in prayer, God is faithful to forgive when we ask. His Spirit will be our eyes in areas we cannot see.
