A grassroots group...literally!...is thriving with purpose at Yantis, Texas. What's their purpose? To educate the public about the value of our world's bees and butterflies, and the benefits of maintaining a natural habitat for these and other creatures. The movement began last year by Miss Kacey Rhodes, an 11-year-old student at Thee Treehouse Christian School, located in northern Wood County. Kasey first stood up for the Monarch butterfly in 2017 with her Mayor's Monarch Pledge, where city officials were encouraged to create pockets of natural habitat within their town's landscape for these insects to feed and reproduce. After all, we do live on land that was once prairie! Now, with the help of her mom Debbie Rhodes, other teachers at Thee Treehouse and a landowner in Yantis, the movement is expanding in leaps and bounds! The students recently organized a small trade show and educational program held at the Yantis School Cafeteria and invited everyone to the first Yantis Prairie Day.

Here's how it happened. Kasey and her classmates were contacted this summer by a landowner within the town of Yantis who, three years ago, decided to undertake a campaign to return her hayfields to natural tallgrass prairie plants and wildflowers. With the assistance of Texas Parks and Wildlife and by U.S. Fish and Game certified programs, Julie Maddox is now in Year 3 of conversion of her 25 acres from a monoculture to a diverse natural habitat. When Julie realized that the students had an environmental movement in motion similar in nature to hers, she jumped aboard by donating a plot of five acres adjacent to Yantis ISD..

On Saturday September 29, 2018, the plot was officially dedicated as the Future Home of the Northeast Texas Prairie Community Outdoor Classroom. A walking tour of a portion of the land verified the presence of native clumping grasses, blooming herbaceous perennials and Vitex trees, all of which work together to support a population of pollinators, prairie birds and raptors, bobwhite quail and small wildlife. As it is developed, the Outdoor Classroom will be available to the City of Yantis citizens and Yantis ISD students and staff as well as community leaders, homeowners and landowners.

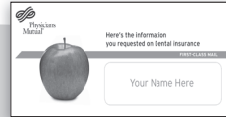

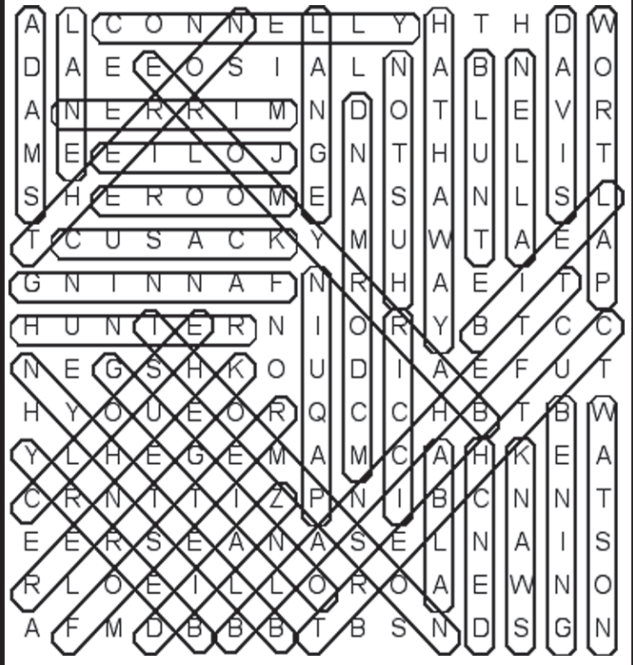

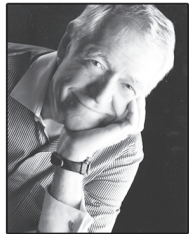

TERROR TRAILS IN THE NORTHEAST TEXAS WOODS

Gary Hughes has a scary place near Yantis in Northeast Texas. It's called Terror Trails and gets lots of visitors on weekends in October.

“On our busiest weekends we'll have more than a thousand people on a Saturday night,” says Gary, who runs it with a staff of more than fifty people. “There's at least an hour and a half wait on our busiest nights, but no one seems to mind.

They're with their friends; they're having fun cuttin' up. While they're waiting we show scary movies on a big screen. We also serve pizzas. We've had people who come out just to eat pizza and watch a movie. They don't even go through the trails. Every once in a while we'll have someone run through who acts like a crazy person with a chainsaw. That keeps them entertained.”

The place has been scaring people for twenty years.

“You really can't tell who you can scare. Our toughest customer is a thirteen-year-old male, you know, the type that says 'nothing scares me.' Then you'll see fully grown cowboys running like little girls to get away from the scary stuff.”

A lot of the same people show up every year.

“We're more like a family tradition now. Every year, the same families come out and have fun together. That's what I've always wanted to do, just give families a nice place to come and enjoy themselves for the evening.”

A highway splits the venue in half. On one side of the highway is a haunted half-mile trail through the woods, which features a ghost train, clowns, a bat cave and mazes. On the other side is a haunted house that is full of mummies, coffins, skeletons, eerie laughter, creaks and groans, all controlled by sophisticated electronics.

“We're using more projectors now,” says Gary. “We have a witch in the window stirring her brew. My background is in lighting. We used to do entertainment lighting for discotechs and roller-skating rinks and that kind of stuff. I'm really into electronics. I enjoy twisting wires.”

Some things are replaced every year, keeping it interesting for visitors who come back on an annual basis. Gary has investments and doesn't depend on income from Terror Trails. Much of the profits go to help various groups like first responders, the Lions club and others. Gary has had the property for sometime. He used to ride his mountain bike on trails around Dallas. When he moved to his property he rode for a while, then converted the trails into what they are today.

Ten dollars gets you in the haunted house or trails. Combo tickets are nineteen dollars. Discounts are offered for military, police and firemen. Everything closes around midnight except on Halloween when it shuts down at 11 PM. Visitors come from Texas and surrounding states, some by the busload. His website is terrortrails.com
