



Lyndonville Native Named USAF Flying Group Superintendent

340th Flying Training Group **Public Affairs**

JOINT-BASE SAN ANTONIO-Randolph, Texas - Chief Master Sgt. Scott A. Goetze has been selected as the group superintendent for the 340th Flying Training Group here. As the superintendent, he will advise the commander on all issues pertaining to the group enlisted force, including health, morale, welfare and personal and professional development.



The 340th Flying Training Group supports Air Education and Training Command's specialized undergraduate pilot training, joint primary pilot training, pilot instructor training, introduction to fighter fundamentals, Euro-NATO joint jet pilot training, basic military training and the United States Air Force Academy airmanship

The 340th is the largest flying group in the Air Force, consisting of 425 instructor pilots and 125 enlisted members assigned to six squadrons at Vance Air Force Base, Oklahoma; Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph and JBSA-Lackland, Texas; Columbus AFB, Mississippi; Laughlin AFB and Sheppard AFB, Texas; and USAF Academy in Colorado.

Goetze is a native of Lyndonville, N.Y. He entered the Air Force in July 1986, serving as an aircraft technician on the F-4 Phantom, F-16 Fighting Falcon, F-117 Nighthawk, C-141B Starlifter, C-17 Globemaster and C-130 Hercules aircraft.

He separated from active duty in June 1997, transferring to the Air Force Reserve, serving as a traditional Reserve, while working as a NASA product support engineer in Seattle, Washington. He accepted an Air Reserve Technician program position in 2004.

He has served in various operational and strategic level leadership roles, and deployed multiple times to Al Udeid AB, Qatar, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, and Djibouti, Africa, in support of the war on terrorism. Previous assignments include bases in Germany, Korea, Nevada, Washington, New York and Texas. Most recently, the chief was the Reserve Military Training Leader Liaison Superintendent at Sheppard AFB.

Goetze and his wife, Jeanne (also from Lyndonville), have two sons: Justin, employed by Mid-Western State University, and Thomas, a second lieutenant in the United States Air Force.

AGRICULTURE CLASS USES ALPACA FIBERS FOR DRYER BALLS

School's Medina High Agriculture Exploration class has taken on a cool project. They are making dryer balls out of alpaca

An alpaca is a species of South American camelid and is very similar to a llama. The district's farm houses several of the animals, and agriculture teacher and FFA advisor Todd Eick thought it would be a great project for his students to make all-natural dryer balls. The balls are a friendly alternative to chemicals on fabric

softeners and dryer sheets that reduce static and wrinkles. "Most of the students in the Ag Exploration class are in eighth and ninth grade and have been spending class time skirting alpaca fibers," he says. Skirting means cleaning out vegetation from the fibers. "We make the dryer balls out of the skirted material and the waste that is picked out is either turned into mesh balls for bird nest makers or put into our compost bin. It is a zerowaste project."



AMeditation on Local History

By Adrienne Kirby, Gaines Town Historian

Since being appointed Gaines Town historian in January, I've spent a good deal of time reflecting on the nature and importance of local history. I offer you my thoughts, not on the merits of my position, but on several decades of observing local history up close as a daughter of Bill Lattin.

In broad terms, the history of Gaines is much like the history of hundreds of other rural communities that sprang up along well-used thoroughfares. Every hamlet had churches, shops, and experienced devastating fires. Almost all rural communities can point to a boom period, and more often than not, to either a rapid or slow decline. In broad terms, the history of Gaines is similar to a lot of other places.

But people who love local history don't speak in broad terms. Local history is related in terms of locale, and it is very particular. Local history is about a particular building, a particular road, or a particular artifact.

Modern society has this mistaken notion that we are autonomous. We are not. We didn't clear the roads we travel. Most of us did not build the homes we live in. Nor did we establish the churches we worship in. We enjoy the shade of trees planted by hands not our own. Every day, we speak the names of those who cleared the roads, who built the homes and churches, who have somehow impacted our lives today. We talk about Beardsley Creek, Childs, and Densmore Road. It is because we enjoy the fruits of others' labors that local history matters.

Moreover, local history is very personal because it ties a person and place in the present, to people in the past. It creates a bond of sorts. You might have something in common with someone who lived 100 years ago — all because you live in the same house! We all can enjoy the same vista and cloud formations that the Bacon family did on Rt. 98 just north of Five Corners. The Village Inn has offered hospitality to guests and travelers for nearly 200 years. As for Beardsley Creek, every single child who has lived on that creek since the dawn of the 19th century has climbed the willow trees that grace its banks, tried catching the minnows that show up in early summer, and observed the snails that reside there.

Local history is philosophical. It answers the big questions. For instance, it answers the question, Why are we here? The short answer in Gaines is, because of Ridge Road. Another big, philosophical question is, Where do we come from? The short answer in Gaines is mostly New England, especially Vermont. Local history also answers the not-so-big questions such as: Why are there so many cobblestone houses? Why does Sawyer Road have that funny jog? What is the story behind the Brick Pond?

Local history is also ideological. We live in an age where efficiency and convenience are prized above all else. This attitude has led to the homogenization of the landscape. Strip malls and housing tracts all look the same no matter what state of the union you are in. In the face of this, local history cries, "This Place Matters!" Local history values the individual, and the uniqueness of our communities. We celebrate the accomplishments of those who came before us. We cherish what is one of a kind. Local history reminds of us of what we have done, that we might be either inspired or forewarned to do better in the future.

In light of this, historic markers and monuments in reality have two messages. The first is obvious – they tell about a person, place or event of local significance. The second message is "This Place Matters!"



WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING?

Well we are headed into another fall season and with it comes new stuff and the loss of others. Our hummingbirds have gone to Mexico for the winter. We will get over it though and be eagerly waiting for them this spring.

The monarch butterflies have produced their fourth generation which will be headed to Mexico, too. The last couple of weeks a lot of them have been spotted. I hit one on the motorcycle the other day and really felt bad, but he was crossing the road without looking first!

Migrating geese are moving in as they to head south for the winter. Our local birds stick around (to leave their crap everywhere they go) until they absolutely have to move out and then most just head to the big waters that usually stay open like the Niagara River, Lake Ontario and Finger Lakes.

Double-crested cormorants are on the move, too. Although we have resident nesting birds with their young hanging around our swamps, their numbers are increasing as the northern birds start their migration south. I have noticed many more at Ringneck Marsh recently with a few more scattered around other spots in the refuge areas. Point Breeze recently has seen a good influx of them roosting in the trees on the west side of the Oak Orchard River. Many folks have built a real hate for these birds because of their habit of destroying trees and shrubs under their roosting areas with their toxic crap. They also consume a lot of fish which doesn't make fishermen happy either. In a future column I will give you a little more insight about these "new" birds that have swooped down on our waterways.

There have been some super sunsets this month and my passion for nature photography has had me chasing them from the swamp to the lake and back. As the days get shorter I find myself missing some just because I haven't gotten it through my head that the sun is setting sooner. To catch a good one, know your camera and you can expect some spectacular images.

Some sunsets are short in duration, but others like two last week last a long time. I love it when that happens as it gives me a chance to capture it in different areas and ways. The sky didn't look very promising for the best one last week, but the plan was to head up to the lake anyway. However, realizing my start was a little late the van was pointed towards the swamp. Well I no sooner got there and the sky opened up presenting fantastic color. Some good spots were visited and it just keep getting better so another area was checked out where the sunset would be reflecting in the water. It got even better so after a few shots a cormorant roost was visited and here I was able to use the orange sky as a background for the birds. The birds cooperated nicely giving me fighting, flying and feather preening images. The sun had long set, but the color was still there and even though I was leaving the marsh some great "after glow" shots were gotten. Nature had put on a tremendous show for me and I knew there were some great images in the camera.

So what makes these great sunsets? At sunrise and sunset, the light has farther to travel due to the low angle of the sun in the sky. This causes the blue light to be blocked and scattered away, allowing the longer wave lengths of red and yellow colors to appear in the sky. Clouds are a crucial factor to sunsets and serve as the canvas to display the colors that the light is painting. High- to mid-level clouds are the most effective canvases, as they will reflect the colors of the setting sun. Low clouds often block this "painting" light. The amount of humidity in the air will also have an effect on the colors of your sunset, with lower humidity producing more vibrant colors. Clean air is very effective at scattering the blue light and so one of the best times for dramatic sunsets is right after a rain or windstorm.

It can be difficult to predict super sunsets, but the best bet is to be at your favorite place early to photograph them, and of course know your camera. Placing the camera on an automatic mode doesn't always bring out the best and of course you learn nothing for future shots as you let the camera made all the decisions.

Before long the leaves will be giving us another great "nature show," get out there and enjoy it!







Make a Home Offer They Can't Refuse

Buying a home can be very competitive. A well-maintained property with all of the bells and whistles that today's buyers demand figures to attract many offers, and buyers who have found their dream homes must be prepared to make an offer that sellers can't refuse.

Standing out in a sea of other potential home buyers is not always so easy, but there are steps buyers can take to ensure their offer is the one sellers

- Get preapproved for a mortgage. Sellers' patience may wear thin with buyers who are not preapproved for a mortgage when making their offers. Preapproval can speed up the selling process, as buyers won't need to secure financing afterward. - · Include an escalation clause. When making an offer on a home, prospective buyers can include an escalation clause. Such a clause acknowledges that a potential buyer is willing to increase his or her initial offer by a predetermined amount to exceed any bids that are higher than that initial offer. When sellers trigger such clauses, they are often required to show the other offers they received that triggered the escalation clause. Escalation clauses show the sellers you really want the house while keeping potential buyers' hopes of buying the home alive when the bids are competitive.



THE RIGHTS **OF RENTERS**

As the state of the housing market leads increasing numbers of people to consider renting as a housing option, they should know that they have certain rights. Landlords are well within their rights to reject a person with a poor credit history, insufficient income to pay rent, negative references from a previous landlord or employer, or a prior eviction lawsuit. On the other hand, the Federal Fair Housing Acts prohibit discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, age, familial status (having children), and physical or mental disability. With this in mind, anyone who feels that he or she has been unlawfully discriminated against may try to negotiate an acceptable settlement or file a lawsuit.

While some landlords don't like renting to tenants with children, fearing the noise and wear and tear that kids might cause, the federal Fair Housing Acts prohibit discriminating on this basis. Also keep in mind that landlords cannot require proof of citizenship or immigration papers from applicants of one ethnicity but not from others, as doing so places a burden on one group that is not imposed on everyone else. Vocational Schooling Can Pave the Way to High-Paying Jobs

Many students believe that the next natural step after graduating from high school is to go off to college. Secondary education has become such a common transition that many parents begin saving for college tuition as soon as their children are born. Although college can be the next chapter in a student's education, many teenagers still choose to attend trade school.

Television personality Mike Rowe says the country is in the midst of a skilled labor shortage because workers lack the necessary training to fill the hundreds of thousands of available jobs. Lack of information may drive the notion that trade jobs are nothing more than a backup plan if college doesn't pan out. However, by realizing that trade jobs, along with short-term vocational training, is a smart investment - and eventually a lucrative career choice - attitudes about trade schools and labor-intensive jobs may shift.

- \cdot Dental hygienist: Cleaning teeth and inspecting mouths for disease is an important role. Job growth is still hovering around 20 percent, and hygienists can expect to earn up to \$98,000.
- Electricians and plumbers: Electricians and plumbers are continually in demand. With a short amount of trade school and apprenticeship, it's possible to earn up to \$90,000 per year.

These are just a few of the many skilled professions that vocational schools prepare their students for. Scholarships and funding programs are available to help make vocational training an affordable possibility.

How Common is Carpal Tunnel?

Increased hours spent on computer keyboards and digital devices can put have own people at risk for a relatively common and oftentimes painful condition that affects mobility in the wrist. Carpal tunnel syndrome, or CTS, can cause numbness, pain and tingling in the hand or arm as a result of one of the major nerves of the hand - the median nerve being compressed in the wrist.

The American College of Rheumatology says that CTS may be the most common nerve disorder experienced today, affecting between four and 10 million people in the United States alone. Middle-aged to older individuals are more likely to develop CTS than younger persons, and females are diagnosed three times more frequently than males.

What is the carpal tunnel?

The carpal tunnel is a passage that forms in the wrist on the palm side of the hand. It is located just beneath the skin surface. The National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke HELP says the carpal tunnel is a narrow, rigid passageway of ligament and bones. Eight small wrist bones form three sides of the tunnel. The width of the inflammation to the tissues inside of the **runs.** carpal tunnel can shrink the space of the tunnel, eventually pressing on the tendons and the median nerve that runs through this narrow area.

The role of the median nerve

When compression occurs in this area of the wrist, a key nerve is affected. The median nerve passes through the carpal tunnel at the wrist and goes into the hand, providing feeling to the palm side of the thumb and to the index, middle and Entry-Level and Experienced part of the ring fingers (although not the little finger). It also controls some small muscles at the base of the thumb.

Symptoms of carpal tunnel

Weakness of the hand as well as tingling and numbness are the two most common symptoms of CTS. The numbness particularly affects four of the fingers. It can occur when holding a phone, book, newspaper or steering wheel or engaging in just about any activity that involves the hands. CTS also may wake a person up from sleep.

There are a number of other compression issues that can occur in the hand and arms, causing similar pain and tingling in other areas. Ulnar nerve compression in the elbow can cause part of the ring finger and pinky finger to tingle and may be indicative of a different ailment. That's why a professional diagnosis must be sought when experiencing symptoms related

When to see a doctor

If pain and tingling are affecting activities and sleeping patterns, individuals should see their doctors. Various nonsurgical remedies and therapies may help. If left untreated, any condition that affects nerve function may lead to permanent nerve and muscle damage.



Creative Ways to Recycle Leaves

Leaves cascading down from trees indicate the arrival of autumn. However, colorful and awe-inspiring autumn leaves can be a hazard if left to lie on the ground too long.

Fallen leaves form a dense insulator to protect trees' roots and prevent competing plants from growing. Decomposing leaves also provide nutrients for the tree. But wet leaves can be a safety hazard and leaves left on the lawn through the winter can pose a threat to the grass. These are just a couple of reasons why so much effort is placed on leaf clean-up in the fall. The following are some creative ways to recycle leaves that fall from your trees in the weeks to come.

· Mulch: Shredded leaves can make for a great amendment to fertilizer for garden beds and even the lawn. Leaves lying on the grass can be mulched into small pieces with a mulching mower so they don't choke the blades of grass. Leaves also can be broken down with a string trimmer, a leaf blower that has a vacuum function or a commercial shredder/ chipper.
