UNA Adds Ceremony

FLORENCE – The University of North Alabama will add a third ceremony for December 2018 commencement.

A new ceremony on the evening of Friday, December 14 will honor graduates of the Anderson College of Nursing and Health Professions and the College of Education and Human Sciences.

The usual two Saturday ceremonies taking place December 15 will recognize graduates from the College of Arts and Sciences in the morning and the College of Business in the afternoon (all times TBD). Tickets will not be required for audience admission to any of the three ceremonies.

Officials listed several reasons for this change. There has been a greater than

expected number of December graduates; ongoing construction in Flowers Hall that will result in the permanent reduction of nearly 800 seats; and feedback from students and parents regarding the proposed plan to issue tickets for admission.

The University will continue to utilize a three-ceremony commencement in May and December exercises, while also adding an August commencement in 2019 for summer graduates.

Enrollment is **Up at NWSCC**

Student Count at 3,543

NW-SCC sees increase in

fall enrollment with the help of Distance Ed.

MUSCLE SHOALS- Northwest-Shoals Community College enrolled 3,543 credit students for the fall 2018 semester. This is an increase of 101 students, or just under three percent from fall 2017 figures (3,442).

According to NW-SCC President, Glenda Colagross, the College must continue to listen to the needs of traditional and non-traditional students in the area in order to continue to grow. "It is always exciting to see growth in our student population. However, to continue this growth we have to be flexible," said Colagross. "The needs of our students have changed so much through distance education. Many of our traditional and nontraditional students prefer taking classes online instead of in the classroom. It is all about flexibility and convenience."

The largest increase in student enrollment came from students taking only distance education courses. NW-SCC saw a 65% increase in distance only students from fall of 2017 to fall of 2018. Students taking at least one distance course increased by 47%.

"Our students are more technology driven now than ever before," said April Cookson, Director of Distance Education.



Have Mercy!

Mercy is a wonderful word with an interesting etymology. It comes from a Hebrew root word meaning, "To get inside another's skin to see with his eyes, think with his mind and feel with his feelings."

When we are merciful to others we are reflecting a Godly trait, because He is truly "rich in Mercy" (Ephesians 2:4). Not only that, God is the originator of mercy. Paul wrote: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies..." (2 Corinthians 1:3). Further, without the great mercy of God we could not be saved! Note these words:

"Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit" (Titus 3:5).

Hence, we all desire and need the great mercy of God. However, in order to receive it, we must learn to be merciful to our fellowman. And not just showing mercy by our standards, but showing mercy that is patterned after the mercy of God. Jesus said, "Be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful" (Luke 6:36).

So, number one, God is merciful. Number two, without His mercy we cannot be saved. Number three, we must show mercy to others in order to receive God's mercy. And that leads to the next point, which is, what does showing mercy "look like" in everyday living?

Thankfully, Jesus answered that question in one of the most familiar stories of the New Testament. We know it as the story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:30-37). In summary, a Jewish man was traveling from Jerusalem to Jericho. He was attached by thieves who beat and robbed him and left him to die. There were two Jewish men, a priest and a Levite, who happened to pass by. Not only were they kinsmen, but they were men who performed religious duties. You would think they would surely help the wounded man, but instead they passed by on the other side.

Later a Samaritan came along and "had compassion" on the Jewish man. Interestingly, the Jews and Samaritans had been feuding for generations (cf. John 4:9). You would think he would not care- - but he did- - and his loving actions perhaps saved the man's

Jesus then asked His audience, "Which of the three do you think was a neighbor to him?" The answer was, "He who showed mercy on him." It was obviously the right answer because Jesus followed with, "Go and do likewise" (Luke 10:36, 37).

What is the message for you and me? Be compassionate. Be forgiving. Be loving. Be understanding. In short, Have Mercy!

in each case. The new law would also prohibit smoking within 20 feet of any building entrance.

I have to side with mayor Ian Sanford and councilman Steve Nix in a dissenting position on this. It's not bad policy, it's bad for government to decide this policy. It should be up to the business owner to make the decision to allow tobacco products or not, period.

Let's say it is 40 degrees outside with a blowing mist. Very few people will be burdened by the guy walking through a city park with a lighted cigarette. The same with a guy walking downtown at midnight. The blanket policy is overkill. If I don't like the smoke, I

don't patronize the business and I don't fill out an application to work there. It is very simple.

The city is not paying the sales tax for any businesses. Neither is it paying the property taxes, employee health insurance, benefits, the utility bills, or for any business licenses.

Therefore, the city has no business deciding what legal substances can or cannot be smoked inside a business or on its property.

What's next under the guise of public health? Will they ban smoke escaping outside from George's Steak Pit to an unwitting public? Ban tornado sirens because they exceed a certain decibel level?

In a few years is the city going to décide that your HVAC unit is not set at an acceptable temperature? That you are wasting energy and customers with compromised immune systems are at risk of getting a chill?

Are the windows of your business not shaded adequately from harsh morning sun which may result in high glare and adverse vision conditions for customers?

Of course, the ordinance does not prohibit the sale of cigarettes, cigars, or other tobacco products because the council still wants all the tax revenue associated with smoking.

When the council comes down off the temporary high they can take a look around on addressing some REAL issues within the city.

Extension Filers Need to Avoid Making These Common Filing Errors

If you filed for an Extension of time to file your 2017 Federal Tax Return, you have until October 15, 2018 to submit your return.

To make sure you meet your tax obligations, you should file an accurate tax return. If you make an error on your tax return, it will likely take longer to process and could delay a refund. You can avoid many common errors by filing electronically, which is the most accurate way to file a tax return.

Here are several common errors to avoid when preparing your tax return:

- 1. Missing or Inaccurate Social Security numbers You should check to be sure and enter each SSN on your tax return exactly as it is printed on your Social Security card. This includes any dependents.
- 2. **Misspelled Names.** You should double check that you have spelled all names listed on a tax return exactly as listed on your Social Security card. Again, this includes any dependents.
- 3. **Filing Status.** Make sure you do not claim the wrong filing status, such as Head of Household instead of Single. If you are unsure, use the following link on the IRS website called the <u>Interactive Tax Assistant</u> to help you choose the correct status. Most E-file software also helps you this prevent mistake.
- 4. Math Mistakes. Math errors are one of the most common mistakes, ranging from simple addition and subtraction to more complex items. Figuring the taxable portion of a pension, IRA distribution or Social Security benefits is more difficult and results in more errors. You should always double check your math. Better yet, using tax preparation software does it automatically.
- 5. **Figuring Credits or Deductions**. Another common mistake is the figuring of Earned Income Tax Credits (EITC), Child and Dependent Care Credit and the Standard Deduction. Each form has detailed step-by-step instructions, so please follow them carefully. For example, if you are 65 or older, or blind, you should claim the correct, higher standard deduction, that is if you are not itemizing.
- 6. Incorrect Bank Account Numbers. If you are due a refund you should choose direct deposit for ease and convenience, but make sure you double check to make sure you are using the correct bank routing and bank account numbers on your tax return so it deposits safely into "your" account.
- 7. **Unsigned Forms.** If everything is perfect and you have not signed your return, it is not valid. If you are filing with a spouse and one of you fails to sign the return, it is not valid. There is an exception for some members of the military who are not present and are defending this wonderful country. You can avoid this error by filing your return electronically and digitally signing it before sending it to the IRS.

Medicare Minute "Value of a Local Agent"

Medicare's Annual Enrollment Period (AEP) begins October 15th and extends through December 7th. You will find that there are many ways to sign up for your 2019 plan. You can enroll online, enroll over the phone, have a noninsurance person help you enroll or you can enroll in your plan through a local insurance agent that is certified to offer Medicare plans.

If you want to deal directly with a particular insurance company you can do that online or over the phone. All insurance companies now have a website and toll free number to call. Some people feel as though they need help in choosing a plan. They will call on a friend, family member or non-insurance person to help them. All three of these methods are perfectly acceptable under Medicare guidelines. If you choose to enroll without the help of an insurance agent it will be up to you to read and understand the plan's summary of benefits, assure that the doctors, hospitals and pharmacies you want to use are in the plan's network and make sure your drugs are covered on the plan's drug formulary.

There's an important question you'll want to ask yourself; "If I have a problem with my plan can the person helping me enroll go to the insurance company on my behalf to help me solve it?" If the answer is "no" then you will be on your own to deal with the company. Your local insurance agent must be appointed by the company they enroll you with. Therefore, if you have a problem with your plan the agent that enrolled you can go to the company on your behalf. Next week we will look specifically at the value of a local agent and how an agent earning a commission can actually be a good thing for you!!
