

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

Since my last letter, my new Facebook profile went from 0 to 60 friends, which is pretty funny if you know about my love for cars. And if you're one of those 60, you've probably seen what I've stirred up this week: Those horrible Jersey barriers in the State Street plaza. Don't forget the crumbling stucco, trees growing from the awnings, and lamp posts canted to such a degree where safety is a concern. You've also read that I intend to pursue the owners of Mayo Plaza, LLC to have that lot properly rehabilitated.

Have you heard the saying, "Dress for the job you want, not the job you have"?

If we want to attract business to Mount Morris - either retail or otherwise — to create jobs, help raise property values, increase tax revenue and ultimately reduce the rate (the ratio paid to the assessed value of your home) we have to make our village look the part.

Will convincing investors who live far from Western NY to pour money into a property (and subsequently, community) they care nothing about be easy? No. But I'm certain that I can bring our complaint to them in such a way it can't be ignored. It may take time and require pressure on multiple fronts. Please stay tuned: I may ask you to do your part and help at some point.

For now, I ask that the owners of Save-A-Lot and Mun Yuen review their leases to see if the landlords are in violation of contract in any way that would allow recourse, such as withholding rent, etc. until improvements are made. There may be a case on the safety front, which would help compel them through legal pressure - and show unity between the businesses and the community.

During a discussion with former mayor/current trustee Joel Mike, he stated, "I would love to see a whole foods store here, but that's not in our wheelhouse." It may not be, but I challenge Joel and anyone else to operate as if that IS our goal. We have to aim high and hope to land somewhere in the middle, but above where we are now. I believe that all great leaders and innovators become so by having no awareness of limitations – if we accept the world around us as it is – the status quo, then it can become self-fulfilling.

Mount Morris wasn't always this way – it was a slow evolution and the fix could be equally slow. But in my mind, I want to finish what O'Connell started. I may make enemies along the way, but if I'm not, then I'm not trying hard enough.



Historical Society Finds Pieces of History



A very exciting discovery was recently made at the Livingston County Museum in Geneseo. The museum, formerly the District #5 Geneseo Schoolhouse (1838-1932), was in the middle of renovations to prepare for the Big Tree exhibit. While moving several large interior cabinets, volunteers uncovered two chalkboards from the early 1900s.

As seen in the photos, one shows "o" spelling words as well as part of the story of the Myth of Ceres and Proserpine.

The second board relates to "E Spelling" and "D Spelling" and lists student names. Amidst the dust and dirt behind the cabinet, other found items include an 1883 penny, marbles, a paper airplane, and chalk.

The original cobblestone sector was built in 1838 on land donated by the pioneer Wadsworth brothers, who asked that the land remain a site of education. It functioned as an elementary schoolhouse until 1932, when the Newcomb School (now Welles on the SUNY Geneseo campus) opened.



The building promptly turned into the Livingston County Historical Society Museum (after it was purchased for a dollar), consistent with the Wadsworths' wishes.

Since then, the museum operates to discover and preserve the history of the region, offering public displays and teaching kits to local schools. Fourth graders in the area have a curriculum that includes local history, so the museum is a benefit to those classes in particular. Additionally, the museum takes on interns from SUNY Geneseo to encourage experience within a student's chosen field of study.



Since the discovery, members of the museum have been chasing down the identities of the students listed by looking through census records, death records, military records, etc. Especially interesting is that in 1932, when the school had closed down (when many assumed the writings were from), most of these students would have been in their late teens. So it's possible the writings are from earlier. Even then however, a large range of ages is represented on that board, with one kid being 9, and others being 13, 16, 17, 19, etc. Volunteers are a bit perplexed by this since the school only educated children K-4.

Volunteers have been in contact with the Livingston County Historian's office along with a special collections librarian at SUNY Geneseo to try and find more records that might help to elucidate our inconsistent findings, but that's a work in progress.
