

in a hurry. With my nature photography, a lot of time is spent watching and waiting. Thus, I get the opportunity to see some of these things.

WITH NATURE

we often don't see because we are always

Take for instance the osprey. I spent a lot of time photographing them in recent years. The restoration project done in our Oak Orchard WMA back in the early-1990s has made the return of this bird to our area a huge success and today we have many nesting pairs in this area.

In the past I have concentrated my osprey efforts on nest building and bringing fish back to the nest to feed the young. This past spring an effort was made to capture the actual catching of fish by them. This is never easy as sometimes they are just too far away or they make the catch on the other side of some vegetation like cattails and you are unable to get a picture. I learned a lot about ospreys fishing this year and the camera revealed some things my eyes often missed.

My camera can take almost 10 frames a second if I hold the shutter down. When the osprey gets close to the water surface as he goes after a fish I hold the shutter down. Even with that speed it is surprising how much is missed in that shutter burst.

What the camera did show me was that most times the bird goes completely under the water. To the naked eye it doesn't look like they do and I was surprised the number of times they actually do.

When they spot a fish they go into a dive and hit the water with their huge talons open right in front of them with the wings back. There is a huge splash and if successful, they come out with the fish.

The head comes up out of the water first and then the wings are used to "push" them off the water to eventually get airborne again. Remember, now his feathers are soaked from going under water and he now has the extra weight of the fish to fly with. Once off the water he kind of pauses in mid-flight and shakes his whole body to throw off that water. Sometimes these fish are very large and it is amazing how the bird can get airborne again. It all happens so fast that if it were not for what the camera showed me I wouldn't think they actually dove under the water that often.

Another amazing thing seen was with some beavers I was photographing. The beavers had been "booted" out of their pond and house by a farmer clearing the land. They began to build a new house on the bank of a dike on a nearby pond. The only problem was, it had been dry and this pond was just about dried up except for one shallow channel from one end to another. It was only a few feet deep and maybe five feet wide.

The beavers would swim from the house, where the channel started, to an area at the other end where they cut young poplar down for food and house building.

Sometimes before I got to my blind or when leaving I would be within 10 foot of this channel. Now if you spook a beaver he will "slap" his big flat tail on the water to make a big splash to warn the other beavers. However, they got used to me and most of the time they would just submerge before they got to me and swim under the water until they got by. One of the adults looked to be about 45 pounds and yet when he "sunk" below the water there was no ripple. When he got by and resurfaced again there was hardly a disturbance of the water. I don't know how such a big animal could swim by in such swallow water without making a ripple, but it happened many times.

This morning I stopped at one of the refuge overlooks to photograph a family of eight trumpeter swans on the near bank of the marsh only 50 yards away. I seldom get out of my vehicle as I have learned a long time ago that people outside their vehicles spook wildlife. This family of swans were apparently use to people as there was another person there looking at them and didn't seemed concerned as she walked around and came over to talk to me several times. There was a cattle egret over there too, but it was keeping a low profile as he wasn't as comfortable with someone walking around. So this gal stands up on the railing trying to get higher to get a picture of that egret. When she left, the egret walked up where I could get some good shots. Another lesson learned, when observing wildlife stay in your vehicle and have some patience to see what develops.

we are always in a hurry or don't take the time to really look. The next time you see wildlife activity take the time to watch and you may be surprised what you will see and learn.







## **Exterior Lighting Improves the Safety & Appearance of a Home**

with a lighting professional about how to position lights to cover the most territory in the

Safety

Safety is an important consideration when improving a home. Lighting can help illuminate potential hazards or draw attention to borders or property boundaries. Navigating in the dark can be treacherous, so put lights along pathways and near pools or spas. Be sure that lights will clearly mark other walkways around your home, such as those leading from doors to the yard or from the garage to where trash and recycling pails are kept. If a design element such as a bridge over a water feature or a particular ornamental tree or shrub is difficult to navigate in the dark, use lights to improve visibility.

Added security is another reason to install more exterior lighting. Dark homes are attractive to burglars. Eliminate dark corners by lighting up areas where thieves may be able to gain access to your home. This includes areas near doorways and ground-level windows. Install motion-sensor lights in such areas so you are not wasting energy.

Lighting may not only deter human intruders, but also it can scare away animals. A raccoon, skunk or opossum may think twice about hanging around your home when your property is bathed in a spotlight.

Revamping exterior lighting elements can improve the safety and the look of a home.






