I tried a fourth and fifth time with the same results and was now laughing as the camera flashed while I rolled past at a snail's pace.


Two weeks later, I got five tickets in the mail for driving without a seat belt.



The animal shelter in Danville has always been prepared for natural disasters. We have a supply of water for the animals to drink, have a supply of food that would last for a few days, and even have crates and carriers stored in cases of evacuation.

Last Thursday afternoon, we had watched the track of Hurricane Michael and felt that the shelter would be safe from the worst effects of it. The shelter is located high above the river. We have had problems with flooding in a hallway and cat room during heavy rainstorms, but that is due to a drainage problem and not the river.

However, we were not prepared for how quickly and how powerfully water can rush into a building. Thankfully, the hurricane did not hit full force during the night when no one was at the shelter.

It seemed that one minute the shelter was secure and dry and the next minute, employees were shouting about water rushing into the adoption center. Cats in Camp Meow Meow and Kitty Corner jumped onto the trees and storage benches and dogs stood on their resting beds to escape the water. Employees quickly evacuated them from the adoption center and put them into dry parts of the

shelter. The three men from Daniel Builders who were working on the renovation that day jumped in to help with no hesitation. All of the animals were saved.

The next day, a large group of volunteers worked for hours helping us to clean up the mud and helping us to restore order to the shelter.

We are grateful to a community of compassionate people who realize that the human heart is big enough to love humans and animals.

After Hep C Is Treated, What About Cirrhosis?

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 59-year-old woman who was recently diagnosed with hepatitis C and cirrhosis. I have never been a drinker. I was treated with Harvoni for three months. I understand the medication is intended to cure the hepatitis C. What about the cirrhosis? My doctor hasn't explained any of my long-term effects from taking this. -- C.J.

ANSWER: Hepatitis C is a common infection of the liver. It is caused by a virus, which can be transmitted by blood and blood products, as well as through sharing needles for injection drugs. It is rarely transmitted sexually.

Anyone with a history of injection drug use, who received blood transfusions or organ transplants before 1992, or who received clotting factors before 1987 should be tested, as should anyone with a known blood or sexual exposure to someone with hepatitis C. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention also recommends testing all adults born in the United States between 1945 and 1965, anyone who is HIV-infected, who received hemodialysis or was incarcerated.

excellent cure rate. The cure rate is 99 percent in people who had never been treated before and who did not have cirrhosis. Even people like you, with cirrhosis, had a cure rate of 94 percent with 12 weeks of therapy in the trial that got the medication approved. Cirrhosis is liver damage and scarring as a result of liver disease. Once it has developed, it is not reversible; however, a successful cure of the hepatitis C virus greatly reduces the risk of further damage, specifically reducing the need for liver transplant and the rates of death, liver cancer and other liver-related complications.

These medications are so new that I can't estimate how much lower your risk of further damage to your liver is post-treatment; however, there is little doubt that your likely successful treatment will substantially improve your expected length and quality of life. But, since you still have cirrhosis, you will need to take some important precautions. These include continued abstinence from alcohol, careful monitoring of prescription and non-prescription medications, avoiding raw shellfish and making sure your immunizations are up-to-date. You should keep asking your gastroenterologist questions until you are satisfied. I recommend you make a list of questions to ask, and bring a friend to help make sure you understand the answers you get.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Should your blood pressure go higher as you age? Is the top number or the bottom more important? I don't like medicine, and my blood pressure was 145/82, but the top number sometimes goes to 150-158. -- J.S.

ANSWER: Both the systolic (top number) and diastolic blood pressures are important, and the difference between them is occasionally important (for example, a blood pressure of 160/60 is more worrisome than 160/85). Blood pressure does go up with age, but even in people over 60, the recommendation is still to get the BP down below 150, and I try to aim for 140 if there aren't too many side effects. It often takes several tries to find a regimen that gets the blood pressure where it should be without affecting quality of life.



Flashed Glass Decanters

Is a red-and-white glass decanter made of cased glass, flashed glass or stained glass? All three were methods of adding color to a clear glass piece to make it more decorative. The cost and quality of each is different, and collectors should look carefully and ask questions before they buy.



These 19th-century Bohemian flashed glass decanters were blown, flashed with red glass, cut and then decorated with orange and black enamel and gilt. The 20-inch-high pair auctioned for \$1,920.

Stained glass is the least expensive way to color glass. This method uses a staining material that is brushed on, becomes red or amber, and adheres to the glass when heated. The layer of material is very thin, and if cleaned too vigorously, it could wear off. It often is used to color pressed glass.

Flashed glass is made by using an added thin layer of glass over a different color glass. It is made by taking a "gather" of hot glass, dipping it into a second colored glass, then blowing it into shape. It leaves a thin layer of glass but makes a piece that appears to be made of one solid color, which would be more valuable.

Cased or plated glass is the most expensive. It is made by putting a thick layer of glass over a glass piece of a

different color. It can be decorated on the outside layer or cut to expose the inside layer. Look at the rim at the top of a cased vase, and you'll see two distinct layers. Some glass, like rubina verde, is made with a yellow glass body and red glass added inside. It makes a two-color glass.

To make this even more difficult for beginners, there are many different ways to decorate the outside of any of these glass pieces. The glass can be cut through to a different color or just in a clear section. It can be painted on the outside with gilt and enamel to make decorations in many colors. A very elaborate pair of Bohemian flashed glass decanters with cut and enameled decorations sold at a recent Cowan auction for \$1,920.

New Opportunities for Inspiration Coming to Danville Science Center

DANVILLE, Va., Oct. 15, 2018 – In 2016, the leadership of the Danville Science Center ranked a major refreshment of its core exhibits as its top priority moving forward. This major initiative would create better experiences to help guests make more connections to the world around them. A recent gift from the Danville Regional Foundation helped the Science Center nearly achieve its interior enhancement campaign goal, enabling the organization to turn dozens of innovative ideas into reality.

Located in the Danville Passenger Rail Station since 1995, the Science Center offers curious guests of all ages the chance to explore STEM concepts and skills with interactive exhibits, hands-on activities, live demonstrations, touring exhibitions and special events. While the Science Center is the Dan River Region's educational and cultural anchor, inspiring nearly 49,000 guests each year, an extensive community engagement process revealed the need for enhanced experiences as permanent galleries at the museum have not been updated since its opening.

To accomplish this, the Science Center developed a master plan that included a \$9 million interior refurbishment. The \$3 million from Danville Regional Foundation combined with \$5.25 million awarded from the state and \$250,000 from the Hughes Memorial Foundation allows the Science Center to begin the work, which is scheduled to conclude by December 2020.

"This funding is instrumental in completing our first phase of interior improvements and enriching the guest experience outlined in the master plan," said Science Center Executive Director Adam Goebel. "This allows us to deliver a world-class dynamic community resource, and puts us on the trajectory of being the pre-eminent regional destination for informal learning and discovery for a diverse, multi-generational audience by 2025."

The financial support will underwrite the fabrication and installation of four signature, permanent displays that will have lasting impact on the education, economic and community health of the Dan River Region:

• Young Learners Gallery – This 1,800-square-foot train-themed space is dedicated to preschool-age children and their families. Aimed at introducing families to important STEM fundamentals, it is a one-of- a-kind experience in the area.

• "Water" – This signature 4,600-square-foot gallery will help guests understand water differently, from its chemical makeup, to the ecology of bodies of water like the Dan River and the power we can generate from this resource.

• "Go!" – Addressing the physics of motion through kinesthetic (physical interaction) learning, this 4,500- square-foot space engages participants in social and inquiry-driven challenges prompting collaboration to generate results.

• Creativity Lab – Offering guests access to craft and design tools – from construction paper to digital design programs – this lab offers a hands-on entry point into STEM learning.

While interior renovations take place, the Danville Science Center Foundation will be working to raise an additional \$1.5 million from individuals and businesses to achieve the overall campaign goal, thus enabling the Science Center to implement the full master plan adopted in 2017.

Delegate Danny Marshall and Senator Bill Stanley sponsored budget amendments to obtain state funding for this project. The entire Southside delegation, Senator Frank Ruff, Delegates Les Adams, James Edmunds and Charles Poindexter, co-sponsored

and were also instrumental in obtaining the state funding for this project.

"The Science Center is a very important educational resource for students. It offers science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) training through hands-on science," said Delegate Danny Marshall. "I am proud to have sponsored the House budget amendment that will help fund a national caliber array of new exhibits."

The Science Center is a satellite location of the Science Museum of Virginia in Richmond, which completed the last of its major interior refurbishments this fall with the opening of a permanent makerspace, The Forge. This multi- year project created new opportunities to highlight how informal educational organizations, such as science museums and centers, can enrich a community and inspire guests to enjoy the process of discovery.

"STEM literacy is a fundamental competency in today's world," said Science Museum of Virginia Chief Wonder Officer Richard Conti. Most preachers do either all pastoring or all evangelism. As one of the rare preachers who for a very long time has done both, I can tell you that they are radically different tasks, and generate radically different emotions

As an evangelist I will be at a church for a few nights and then be gone. I do make friends most everywhere I go, sometimes very good friends, but I am not usually around long enough to develop bonds of deepest affection, unless it is one of the churches I go back to year after year. But as a pastor, I get oh, so very attached to people ...

Our church recently lost a very special person to me and to all of us. In fact, she held a lofty and powerful position among us; she was delectable treat guaranteed to sabotage any diet all while making the recipient glad to fall off of the calorie counting work of killing Goliath.

In other words, she found something she was good at, and put it to use in the Lord's work.

In 1 Samuel 17 we find the historical account of David and Goliath. On the conservative side, Goliath was at least nine feet, nine inches tall. If the longer cubit, the king's cubit, was being spoken of, he may well have been over eleven feet tall. Either way, he was the most fearsome warrior to ever pass across the pages of Scripture and the path of Israel.

And yet, by the time the battle was over, a kid named David had cut him down. Everyone knows this. But many have never considered the two unnamed people who made it possible for David to fight and win this battle.

Lazy Provider Faked Blood-Pressure Readings

A potentially life-threatening practice had been going on at one of the Department of Veteran Affairs medical facilities, until the Office of the Inspector General caught them at it. A primary-care provider had been falsifying blood-pressure readings to cut down on the workload.

This is a big deal. High blood pressure can lead to all kinds of ugly outcomes such as stroke, kidney disease, heart failure and heart attack.

Specifically, the OIG responded to a report that the primary-care provider was entering fake blood-pressure readings into the patients' records, indicating normal readings. When the OIG investigated, the care provider had put 128/78 into the record for 83 percent of the patients. The OIG reached out to 10 patients with that reading and was told that their blood pressure hadn't been taken at all.

At that point the OIG looked at 5,000 of that provider's patient records. Of those, 1,370 had conditions that required blood pressure to be tracked and controlled, and 1,364 of those had the same reading (128/78) entered into their record. In that group, 64 patients were ill with hypertension, which could have led to death. Additionally, lab work wasn't always done when prescription changes were ordered. The patients were scheduled for follow-up in nine months, no matter how serious their conditions.

Why on earth would a care provider falsify information like this? The OIG reported that the normal 128/78 reading was entered to turn off the clinical reminder -- an automatic note to the physician about whether lab work, referrals or medication changes are needed -- which served to reduce workload because a normal



1 1/2 Tbsp buttermilk

1/2 tsp baking powder

powdered sugar

lemon slices

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Line an 8x8" baking pan with aluminum foil or parchment paper, set aside.

Combine crust ingredients (melted butter, flour, powdered sugar and cornstarch) in a mixing bowl, then press into bottom of prepared pan. Keep crust in an even layer, as much as possible. Bake 10 minutes, then set aside.

While crust is baking, combine filling ingredients (eggs, sugar, zest, juice, flour, buttermilk, and baking powder), and whisk to combine. Try not to whisk too vigorously, as you don't want to incorporate a lot of air into the filling.

Pour over baked crust and bake (still at 350 degrees F), for 22-25 minutes, until filling has set and edges are lightly golden brown.

Cool completely, cover with foil, then refrigerate.

To slice bars, I find it easiest to lift up on the foiling lining in the pan, to remove the bars from the pan. Slice into 12 bars. Before serving, dust bars with powdered sugar and garnish with a lemon slice if desired

* When defrosting meats in the fridge (never on the counter, right?), make sure they are sitting in a tray or plate with a lip. If the plastic leaks, you don't want meat dripping on your other groceries. Defrost meats on the bottom shelf, just in case.
