





# EXTRA DOE TAGS AVAILABLE NOVEMBER 1st

November 1st starts the First Come, First Served (FCFS) Deer Management Permit (DMP) process. The following Wildlife Management Units (WMU's) will be available:

1C 3M, 3R, 3S (bowhunting-only), 7F, 7H, 7J, 7R, 8A, 8C (bowhunting-only), 8F, 8G, 8H, 8J, 8N, 8R 9A, 9F, and 9G.

- Hunters may apply for and receive up to two additional DMPs in these WMUs.
- DMPs are only valid for antlerless deer in the WMU for which they are issued.
- Leftover DMPs are issued on a first-come / first-serve basis. DEC will continue to issue permits in these WMUs until sufficient numbers of DMPs are issued to achieve optimum management in each unit. When a unit is opened, it will remain open at least until close of business that day. At the end of the business day, any units that have reached the desired number of permits will be closed.
- Applicants with licenses that are exempt from paying a DMP application fee or hunters who have previously applied for DMPs this license year will not be charged any additional fees during the extended application period. Otherwise, there is a non-refundable \$10 application fee for leftover DMPs.

# **Prenatal Care is Crucial**

One of the most critical factors in ensuring a healthy pregnancy for a woman and her baby is early prenatal care. Prenatal care means health care during your pregnancy, before your baby is born.

Prenatal care is important to ensure that problems and treatments can be administered as soon as possible.

If you are planning a pregnancy or are already pregnant, here are some ways to take care of yourself and your baby:



- Exercise regularly. About 30 minutes a day is recommended. Studies have shown that women who exercise regularly have an easier time recovering from childbirth.
- Take at least 400 micrograms of folic acid every day. Folic acid will help to prevent certain birth defects.
- See your health care provider for a check-up as soon as you become pregnant. Your health care provider will then set up a schedule of visits throughout your pregnancy and may suggest prenatal vitamins if you are not already taking them.
- Do not smoke, drink alcohol, or take drugs. When you inhale, or ingest these things, your baby does as well. Babies can have slow development and may be born prematurely from these toxins.
- Protect yourself and your baby. Talk with your health care provider about getting your flu and Tdap (pertussis) shots during your pregnancy.

By following these steps both the mother and baby can have a healthy beginning. The Livingston County Department of Health has services for women who are thinking of becoming pregnant and who are pregnant. # Is Your Home Bat Proofed?

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), bats are the most common source of human rabies in the United States. Although bats are very helpful to humans and the environment, by

consuming insect pests, bats can also be infected with rabies. You can't tell whether or not a bat has rabies by looking at it. Rabies can only be confirmed in a laboratory. People and animals can get rabies if they are bitten by a rabid bat. A bite from a bat may not be noticed because bat's teeth are so small.

If you or someone you know has had physical contact with a bat, please call the Livingston County Department of Health at (585) 243-7280 and consult with a health care provider to determine if rabies treatment is needed. It is important to keep bats out of homes. It's best to contact an animal-control or wildlife conservation agency for assistance with "bat-proofing" your home. However, if you choose to do it yourself, "batproofing" can be done by caulking any holes that are larger than a quarter inch, closing all doors to the outside tightly, using chimney covers, window screens, and draft guards beneath doors to attics. Bats can even enter homes through loose shingles, siding, or open vents.

If a bat is in a home and there is a chance that the bat had contact with a person, pet, unattended young child, a sleeping individual, a person under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or a person with other sensory or mental impairment, please follow these simple guidelines:

- Do not touch the bat with your bare hands. Put on leather work gloves.
- Get a small box or coffee can, a piece of cardboard and tape.
- Wait for the bat to land.
- Approach the bat slowly, and while wearing the gloves, place the box or coffee can over it.
- Slide the cardboard under the box or can to trap the bat.
- Tape the cardboard to the can or box opening so the bat cannot escape.
- Punch small holes in the cardboard allowing the bat to breathe.
- Leave the bat in the container. Then take the container outside and call the Livingston County Department of Health at (585) 243-7280, or the Livingston County Sheriff's Department at (585) 243-7100 after hours.
- Do not release the bat. The bat should be tested for rabies to determine the need for rabies treatment. If you have pets, it is important to keep them up to date with their rabies vaccinations to prevent exposure.






