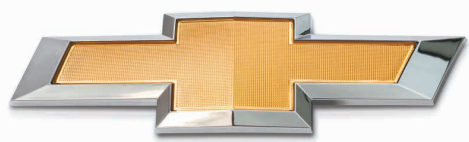

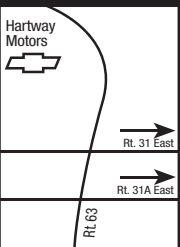

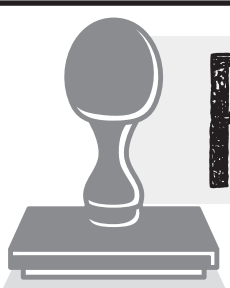

**ENOUGH CASH TO
GO AROUND?**

One issue that must be addressed by the executor of a will is that there are sufficient liquid assets (cash or assets that can be quickly converted to cash) to pay the bills of the deceased's estate. If there are not enough funds to cover the debts, assets must be sold, which should be done prior to distributing property to beneficiaries. If there are not enough assets to pay all the debts, state law will dictate the priority with which outstanding debts must be paid. As a general matter, funeral expenses, family allowances, lawyers' fees, court costs, and executor's fees are to be paid in full (or to the extent possible) before other, lower priority creditors are paid.

Once all court costs, taxes and debt are paid, the executor of the will distributes the rest to the designated beneficiaries. LEGENDS AND BEAUTY OF SPIRIT LAKE

A few years ago a friend of mine and I visited a special place less than 20 miles from Medina. At the time, my friend picked up three pieces of flint, which is plentiful in that area. I again visited this special place last week with another friend and its uniqueness and beauty still captured my mind.

The lake we visited is called Spirit Lake, but is also known as Hidden Lake (because it is), Bottomless Lake and Devil’s Lake. A limestone ridge raises about 70 feet above this three-and-one-half acre lake that was created by glacier action. This kettle lake sits in front of an escarpment of the Onondaga limestone, which is the youngest flint-bearing formation in New York State.

Spirit Lake is an isolated island of natural beauty and uniqueness that is ringed by cultivated fields. Between the lake and the escarpment there is much rock debris that was dropped as the glacier retreated back to the north.

It is the second largest flint quarry in the state. Native Americans collected flint for their arrows and tools from this area for perhaps 10,000 years. They did this by standing on the terraces (which you can still see and walk on) to detach the flint from the matrix.

This escarpment, with its high dropoff, looks out-of-place in this area. It looks more like it should be in Letchworth Park.

I have explored this area several times in the past, once with a Seneca Native American who gave me some insight as to what this lake meant to his people in the past.

Native Americans named it Spirit Lake because they believed a Spirit Sea Serpent lived there. This great serpent spit balls of fire when upset and required a tribute of sacred tobacco to appease him.

Another legend of this lake is how a Native American maiden was offered as a sacrifice to this serpent. Her lover jumped into the canoe with her and folded his arms and awaited the great horned serpent to take them. A band of hostile Native Americans on the way to attack the local village came upon this event and tried to kill the monster, but could not as their arrows broke as they hit the monster. Thus, both the lover and the maiden perished.

Another legend has it that a brave drowned in the lake, and the following spring his body was found floating in a nearby creek, which caused the Native Americans to think there was an underwater channel flowing to the creek. They also believed the lake was bottomless.

Back in 1930 Medina was going to use this lake as a source of water, but after pumping for a few days the lake’s water level began to drop and they forgot the project.

My legend about Spirit Lake starts when my friend and I first visited the lake and picked up three pieces of flint. After that, she began to have one piece of bad luck after another. Then I, too, began to have bad luck, and we joked about returning the flint to the lake and burning tobacco to appease the spirits there.

On my birthday she gave me a little box with the flint in it. That day I locked my keys in my car. Then later I tripped while carrying a heavy object and landed right on my face on cement with no chance to protect myself with my arms. What a mess!

We both figured before I started deer hunting out of tree stands we better visit Spirit Lake again. This time we explored the old Native American terraces below the escarpment and with her as model my photographs were able to show the size of this escarpment along with the beauty and uniqueness of this place.

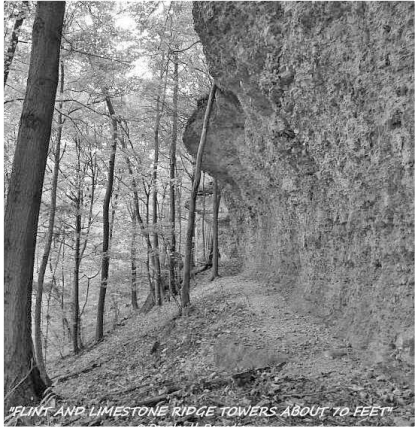
Yes, we returned the flint and yes, we burned tobacco to appease the serpent. And you know what? Neither of us have had any bad luck since!

The lake is privately owned by good friends of mine and so I have the privilege to explore and photograph its beauty and uniqueness. However, these owners do not want this pristine place opened to the public so its location cannot be disclosed.

On this most recent visit to Spirit Lake, no flint was taken and so far everything has been good!

Oh, by the way, all the shooting you may hear this weekend will be waterfowl hunters out for the first weekend of duck and goose season along with some pheasant hunters who started their season last Saturday.

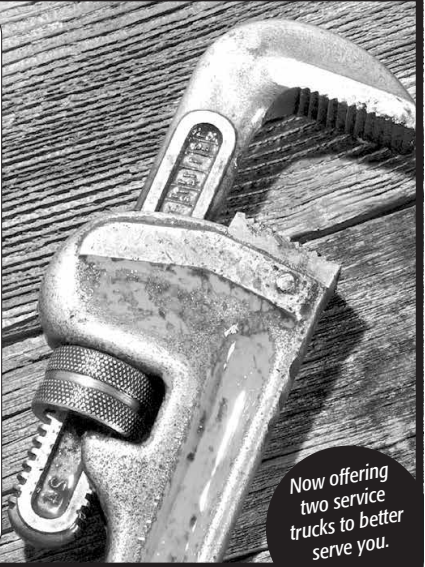



SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1 Ask the person to **SMILE**.
- 2 Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- 3 Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.
- 4 Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking, dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

CHEST DISCOMFORT. Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

DISCOMFORT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE UPPER BODY. Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.

SHORTNESS OF BREATH with or without chest discomfort.

OTHER SIGNS may include breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea or lightheadedness

Women are somewhat more likely than men to experience other common symptoms, particularly **SHORTNESS OF BREATH, NAUSEA/VOMITING, AND BACK/JAW PAIN.**

Whether or not to relocate can be a difficult decision. Sometimes such decisions are borne out of necessity when a parent is relocated by his or her company. Other times it is a personal reason to try out a new neighborhood or upgrade to a larger home. creature comforts of home. Make these the first items that are unpacked upon moving into the new house.

Many real estate agents live in the towns where they make their living. Find out if the agent can set up a meet-and-greet or if he or she knows of any clubs or leagues that suit your family's interests. Making a few introductions ahead of time will give children and adults some familiar faces on their first days in their new home.

Families shouldn't shy away from making their own introductions as well. Knocking on a few neighbors' doors and letting them know a new family is coming to the street can pave the way for familiarity and friendships.

Stay in touch

Encourage children to stay in touch with their current friends. Video chat enables kids to see and speak with peers. When things settle after the move, arrange for a surprise play date where children can introduce their old friends to newer ones.

Stick to a routine

One of the ways to breed familiarity is to stick to the same routine. If a big Sunday family dinner was the norm, continue the tradition in your new home. Wake in the morning and go to bed at the same time. According to Vanessa Lapointe, a registered psychologist in Surrey, British Columbia, structure and routine are key for children. Try to focus on one new thing at a time to minimize stress.

Moving can be exciting and scary at the same time. Children may be anxious about the process, but families can work together to iron out the kinks and settle into their new homes successfully. ■

Did You Know?

Many homeowners have lofty goals for their homes. Such plans may include extensive renovations or even additions. While many of these projects create beautiful changes in a home, it's important to consider the impact that renovations can have on property value before beginning a project. Many home improvement projects do not add as much value as homeowners may think they do. In fact, some homeowners "overbuild" for their neighborhoods. This means the amount of money invested in improvements can likely never be recuperated because the house value simply exceeds those around by too much money. To avoid overbuilding, homeowners can ask themselves several questions before beginning a renovation project.

• Will my house be the largest house in the neighborhood? Larger homes tend to have a lower price per square foot, so you may not want to improve to this extent.

• Will the house blend with others in the area? If your house will stick out like a sore thumb, it will detract from its own value and could impact the value of other homes in the area.

• Have I examined the cost vs. value of the project? Many home improvement resources analyze the cost of a project versus the overall value of that project with regard to property value. For example, a \$100,000 basement remodel may not add \$100,000 to the value of the home in the event you choose to sell down the line. It's important to know which projects provide the best return on investment. ■

Steps to Take Before an Appraiser's Visit

Homeowners unfamiliar with the appraisal process might not know if there is anything they can do to make the process go more smoothly. While certain variables involved in the appraisal process, such as location of the home and the value of surrounding homes, are beyond homeowners' control, the Appraisal Institute recommends homeowners take the following steps before an appraiser visits their home.

• Clean the house. A dirty home that is full of clutter will not make the best impression on appraisers. Dirty homes may be vulnerable to insect infestations that can lead to structural problems with the home. While a dirty home is not necessarily an indicator of infestations or a reflection of a home's value, a clean home will create a stronger first impression with the appraiser.

• Make any necessary repairs ahead of the appointment. Homeowners who have been putting off repairs should make them before the appraiser arrives. Homes with repairs that still need to be made will

likely be valued less than similar homes with no such repair issues. Though repairs can be costly, investing in home repairs will likely increase both the appraisal and resale value of the home.

• Obtain all necessary documents before the appraiser arrives. Homeowners who have certain documentation at the ready can speed up the appraisal process. Such documentation may include a survey of the house and property; a deed or title report; a recent tax bill; if applicable, a list of items to be sold with the house; purchase history of the home; and the original plans and specifications of the home.

• Inform the appraiser about recent improvements. Homeowners can inform appraisers about any recent improvements to the home and the cost of those improvements. The value of home improvements with regard to a home's appraisal value vary depending on a host of variables, but having such information at the ready can help appraisers make the most informed appraisal possible. ■

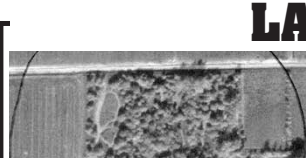

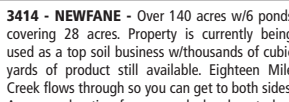



Literature and Hollywood have done much to villainize bats, which many people perceive to be dangerous, blood-sucking creatures that prey on unsuspecting victims. However, bats are far less menacing than that. While there are bats that feed on blood (vampire bats), they tend to stick to cows, pigs, horses, and birds for their meals. It is uncommon for vampire bats to bite humans for food. Vampire bats make a small cut with their teeth and then lap up the blood with their tongues, rather than “suck” the blood like they do in movies. These bats are native to Central and South America. Most other bats feed on fruit, fish or insects, particularly those that reside in North America. A single bat can eat up to 1,200 mosquito-sized insects every hour, and a bat will usually eat around 8,000 insects a night. In fact, it is beneficial to have bats around since they might serve as all-natural pesticides. Bats are nocturnal mammals that “see” in the dark using echolocation. Their eyesight is actually quite poor, but these echoes serve as a form of sonar so that bats can find prey and steer clear of obstacles in their path. There are more than 1,000 different bat species. Some are solitary animals, while others thrive with hundreds of others in caves. Bats are nothing to fear - even around Halloween - and actually can be fascinating to study. ■
