Hello to my fellow Village Residents

My name is Edward Kenney and I will be running for a position on the village board in March. The reason I'm running is that I believe the village of Mount Morris has been getting the dirty end of the stick for far too long. Many of you know me from my days on the police department years ago. I was there when the big fight on Main Street happened. I'm not sure what the result might have been, had it not been for the members of the fire department coming to our aid. I also helped the PD navigate the rough waters after Chief DiPasquale retired. I am now a retired Lieutenant of the New York State University Police. If you add up all my part time service with MMPD and Geneseo Village Police I have over 40 years of law enforcement experience. Mount Morris is my home, but more importantly it is YOUR home.

I believe we need a full-time Police Chief and will advocate for hiring more full time officers (a priority for bilingual officers) to fill the schedule. Our property values are below market now and will plummet if there is no local PD. I don't buy the "let the sheriff do it" philosophy. I know the Sheriff, been to a few bar fights together back in the day. Nobody can serve two masters. The Sheriff has his own worries and will ALWAYS be there for needed assistance, but we need a local PD that is responsive to our needs, directly supervised by our own Chief. Remember up to 15,000 cars and tractor trailers full of god knows what, go through our village every day.

Regarding the PD, everyone is concerned about the traffic in the village. The traffic situation will only get worse without any local PD. We should coordinate with the NYSP scales and commercial enforcement to set up at least once a month. I've helped in a NYSP scales detail on Main by Connors Ave. in the past, truckswill sooner avoid the village than get the "full Monty" from the police. Speed traps work. Put a cop on foot with a laser gun and start writing. Easy enough to solve with local control of the PD.

The Fire Department looks to be on its last legs as far as the equipment andbuilding are concerned. How long has this been a problem? Somehow it became a political football, and little has done about it. Do you know that your fire insurance will skyrocket without a FD? The heavier trucks are now parked off site because the floor of the current building is slowly collapsing into the basement. I've been told the trucks are all very old and constantly breaking down. I don't care if we must start a go fund me page for the FD or hold a bake sale but LET'S GET IT DONE!

How many apartments and rental houses/properties are in the village? 200? 700? That's the range of current estimates. Do you own an apartment building? I don't. There are probably 10-20 different entities that own most of the rentals in Mount Morris. I propose a rental property tax of only a dollar a day for each rental (house, apartment, room etc.) Then add to it a sliding scale of rental building tax (from \$0-100 a month). If you live in a house, you can exempt one apartment. If you own a business property and pay over \$1000 a year in sales tax all the apartments in the building are exempt. If we have anywhere close to the 700 rental properties that should be well over 250,000 a year. I'm tired of absentee landlords picking over the bones of the village while the salt of the earth that made this town great get shafted at every turn.

Another thing I will advocate for is a moratorium on any rooming house or hotel development until we can take a long serious look at our codes to avoid a conflict with what the law says and what is just good common sense. Any disputes as to the number of apartments etc., it will be decided in open village court, not by any appointed official. If you get caught with a bootleg apartment; heavy fines.

I am not a politician, I might get beat bad. I don't know the first thing about how to get any of this done. Anything I have put forward is a starting point and a talking point. Let's get it done together. I can promise you this, I'll keep you fully informed, and it will all be above board in the full light of day. One more thing: I'll do it for free.







I FOUND A BAT IN MY HOUSE!

You could be subject to getting rabies vaccinations if the bat is not tested.



Bats are important in the environment but can cause a serious health risk in the home. Bat bites can transmit rabies. Sometimes even if a bite isn't known you might need to undergo rabies treatment, particularly if an exposure could have occurred while sleeping. Once rabies is contracted it is nearly always fatal.

If you find a bat in your home:

- 1. Keep it isolated to one room if possible.
- 2. Capture the bat if you are comfortable doing so. Wait until it lands and then place a can, plastic container or box over it. Slide a paper under it and then place a cover on top to contain it. You may also contact a wildlife removal specialist to capture it.



- 3. If the bat is killed, the head must not be crushed or destroyed to allow testing.
- 4. Call the Livingston County Department of Health, Center for Environmental Health, at (585) 243-7280 / (585) 335-1717. For after hours emergencies, call

the Livingston County Sheriff's Office at (585) 243-7100.




