How to Invest in Gold and Silver

Gold, silver and other precious metals have been used as currency throughout history. Paper money is a relatively recent method of payment, one that requires a certain level of faith among consumers. But that faith in paper currency has waned in recent years, and there are many people who are once again investing in gold and silver. Gold and silver still have a position of great financial importance in today's market. With the value of a dollar fluctuating, precious metals may make a more stable investment. But investors who plan to investigate gold and silver should consider a few things before making their decision.

- Look into bullion. Gold and silver bullion are made from 99 percent of the total metal. This helps stabilize the cost and is not dependent on some of the fees or price fluctuations resulting from coins issued by various government institutions. Although gold coins aren't widely circulated, silver coins contain enough whole silver mixed with other alloys to make them valuable.
- Consider mutual funds. Rather than purchasing gold or silver outright, you can invest in mutual funds that then allocate a bulk of the fund's investment into the purchase of gold or silver. This requires less knowledge of metal markets and also less work. However, it still enables you to invest in gold and silver.
- Sell scrap jewelry. While you may not get the full value of the jewelry, you can take advantage of the rising rates of gold and silver by selling off items you may not use. Selling extra jewelry requires little work on the part of the seller.

THE GOOD OLD DAYS

My love for the outdoors started at a very early age with hunting being introduced shortly after I was able to follow my father around in the field carrying my BB gun. He even let me shoot at a deer one day but I didn't connect as the BB gun was not quite powerful enough for the 200-yard shot! Following my Dad around while hunting:

'the good old days!" A trip around the Tonawanda and Oak Orchard WMAs the first day of pheasant

season this year reminded me how good we had it back in the late '50s and '60s. Everyone hunted the abundant Ringneck pheasant back then, even my mother. When I was old enough to hunt my mother lost her shotgun to me and I took her place with Dad and our great Springer Spaniel. Pheasant were not only exciting to hunt but they were terrific eating. Pheasant populations exploded naturally after they were introduced in the State back in 1908 but by the early 1970s the pheasant was fading away due to a host of reasons.

Today there is very little natural reproduction and the pheasant hunting that exists today is for the over 25,000 DEC raised and released birds around the State. This is not the same bird we knew "back in the day" but they still excite the hunters who hunt for them. The crowds of hunters on our two State WMAs that first day reminded me of "the good old days."

When I returned from my tour in Vietnam in 1970 the pheasant had become a hard bird to find on private land and I did care for hunting on public areas so I turned my interest to waterfowl hunting. I got into this pretty heavy; field hunting geese, jumping ducks along the creeks and potholes and hunting the late season in the Niagara River and Lake Ontario. I even had a duck camp up near the St. Lawrence River on a small relatively unknown lake where I set out over 100 decoys and hunted from a lay out boat. My Dad and I had some terrific waterfowl hunting and most of the time we didn't have to contend with the mass of hunters on public lands. My trip around the State WMAs and the INWR on the first day of this year's waterfowl season really showed me how lucky Dad and I were to have places to hunt away from the masses of hunters on the public areas. It reminded me of "the good old days."

Deer hunting became a big part of my hunting adventures also, with both bow and gun. Dad and I did hunt some public land for deer in the Southern Tier but eventually I met a farmer who owned about 300 acres adjacent to that State land and he allowed us to hunt his farm. After a few years he allowed us to use his cabin up in the woods, and down the road I brought some of that farm and put a cabin up and put in a pond. Dad and I always got our deer every year and after Dad was gone my son took his place. It was great, I managed the 62 acres for deer and knew it inside and out. The great thing was I didn't have to contend with lots of other hunters.

As I travel around on my "photographing adventures" during bow season this year (shoulder problems have prevented me from bow hunting for now), I couldn't help noticing the amount of hunters out there. All that "hunting traffic" reminded me of how the deer are easily spooked and are quite aware they are being hunted. When I was bow hunting State land (way back when) I could see a real change in the deer habits as bow hunting became more popular there. Then the turkey hunting got better and more hunters moved in, putting the deer on edge and making them more nocturnal. By the time gun season opened up the deer were pretty edgy. With the increase of deer hunters also comes the activity of much more scouting for deer before the season opens which puts the deer on even higher alert. So as I travel around and see all the bow hunting activity I was reminded of "the good old days" when there were fewer folks out there.

Less hunting has been done in the last decade or so due to the problems of aging but the "drive" to be out there still exists and so now I hunt with the camera. I get to "hunt" anytime I want, shoot anything I want (even Bald Eagles!) with no limit and nothing to carry home except my camera! However in recent years I have seen a change in that too.
