





#### **UNA's Record Enrollment**

FLORENCE - The official enrollment numbers are in and the University of North Alabama has broken the school's enrollment record.

Officials said the university's current enrollment of 7,650 is the largest fall enrollment in the school's 188-year history. This greatly surpasses the 7,492-mark set in fall 2016.

UNA was able to achieve this growth due in part to an increase in transfer and graduate students, primarily in online programs.

"Ŏur online MBA program continues to be a showcase program for the University, with sustained and continued growth," said Dr. Ross Alexander, UNA vice president for Academic Affairs and provost. "It is by far the largest MBA program in the state with over 805 students."

A closer look at the fall 2018 enrollment numbers indicate a 25% increase in graduate students and a seven percent increase in transfer students. Interestingly, graduate students now comprise roughly 20% of the UNA student body.

Perhaps the most impressive gain though, is in international students. International student enrollment at UNA is up 65% when the national average for international students studying in the US is down 32%.

## Protect Your Disability Benefits with an ABLE Account

In 2014, Congress passed what is known as the Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Act. The purpose of this act is to allow individuals with disabilities to save assets in their name without the risk of losing their disability benefits. These ABLE accounts are tax-advantaged accounts and any earnings on funds in a qualified ABLE account are tax free. Many states began offering these accounts shortly after the act's passing in 2014. These accounts are currently available for qualified individuals in all of the states our law firm serves; Alabama, Mississippi and Tennessee.

#### ABLE Account FAQs

Here are a few frequently asked questions to help you understand your ABLE account:

#### Do You Qualify for an ABLE Account?

So how do you know if you qualify for an ABLE account? You are eligible to benefit from an ABLE account if you are blind or if the onset of your disability was prior to your 26th birthday and you are entitled to receive SSI or SSDI benefits. Another way to qualify is to have a certification from your doctor that you have a severe functional limitation diagnosed before age 26 that may result in death or expected to last for a time in excess of 12 months. In general, a minimum of \$50 must be contributed to open an ABLE account.

#### Who Can Contribute to an ABLE Account?

If eligible, once you have an ABLE account established, anyone can contribute funds to the account. The account owner, or that person's legal representative, remains in control of all funds not matter where they come from, be it family, friends, donations, estate planning, lawsuit proceeds, etc.

However, the total amount that may be contributed is currently \$15,000 per year or possibly more if the owner of the account has earned income. The total amount that the owner may have in the account can vary by state. A balance in excess of \$100,000 can impact SSI benefits. The limit amount is the same as the state's limits on its section 529 plans.

#### What Can You Purchase with ABLE Account Funds?

Funds in an ABLE account may only be used to purchase "qualified disability-related expenses." This covers any expenses that relates to maintenance of the qualified owner's health and quality of life. It can include expenses such as housing, education, transportation, health care expenses, health care assistance and more.

#### How Many ABLE Accounts Can You Have?

A qualified individual may only have one ABLE account. If your state does not have an ABLE program yet, you can still enroll in a program in a different state. Many states accept out of state enrollment. You can learn more about these programs and what states offer them by visiting the ABLE National Resource Center at www.ablenrc.org.

anchor babies as possible. Several decades of being overlooked and several million exceptions are not enough.

The Amendment reads in part, "All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and the State wherein they reside."

Those solely satisfied with focusing on the "All persons born" element have a wistful quasi-interpretation of the amendment. The framers were considering more than a futuristic the mid-20th to early -21st centuries' simplistic and

#### **The Criminal Wave**

Editor:

Some violent acts have taken place within the second caravan. The way it has forced its way through the border between Guatemala and Mexico has raised concerns that it differs from the past. Air Force General Terrence O'Shaughnessy, Chief of the US Northern Command, said, "We are working closely with Customs and Border Patrol to understand the makeup and the nature of this caravan. This caravan is different than what we've seen in the past.'

The second migrant caravan is believed to be armed with bombs and guns and has crossed into Mexico despite a huge police presence. This one has been more unruly than the first that crossed into Guatemala, according to Guatemala's Interior Ministry. Guatemalan police officers were injured when the migrant group broke through border barriers on Guatemala's side of

the bridge.

Monica Showalter of American Thinker, writes, "To hear the press and its narrative allies tell it, the Honduras migrant caravan is little more than thousands of mothers and toddlers spontaneously fleeing violence in their home countries. The flight is little different from that seen in previous caravans. Any concern about crime or violence is a scare tactic or lying, or racism, and there's no evidence any of the migrants are criminals. President Trump's warnings about the matter are simply factually wrong."

That's not a scare story from some rightwing militia group, but the actual view of the U.S. military, whose 5,000-plus troops have been dispatched to meet the caravans and keep them from storming the U.S. border and entering the U.S. illegally as they already did in Mexico."

According to a report, the U.S. Border Patrol told Texas landowners along the U.S.-Mexico border to prepare for a possible influx of armed civilians on their property as the migrant caravan moves closer to the U.S. This is a significant contrast to the picture the mainstream press has been peddling about the supposedly harmlessness of the migrant caravan.







on insurance companies not treating people fairly. I could and will go on about insurance companies. With that said, it is not their job to treat people fairly. We must recognize that it is their job to make a profit.

We certainly base our practice

If you have full coverage insurance, please turn your claim into your own insurance company. They will have your car repaired.

You will have to pay your deductible but after a short period of time they will likely refund your deductible to

Almost all insurance companies have signed what is known as an "inter-company arbitration agreement". Insurance companies look at the facts and agree between themselves who was at fault. Your insurance company will initiate the process against the other company to force them to pay the property damage and refund your deductible to you.

That will get your car fixed quicker than anything else

Most people do not understand that is just because the other company pays for your car that they will accept your claim for injuries without first disputing liability again, if they can.





#### All Babies ARE **NOT Citizens**







#### **Medicare Minute**

#### "Medicare Advantage Plans Part 3"

A Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) is a type of Medicare health plan offered by a private insurance company that contracts with Medicare to provide you with all your Part A and Part B benefits. There are six things to consider when choosing a MA plan. We discussed three of those things last week; the premium, copays and coinsurance of the plan. This week we will talk about deductibles, provider networks and drug formularies.

A deductible is the amount you are required to pay for your health care services before your health insurance begins to pay. Most MA plans do not have a deductible on services as long as you receive the services from an in network provider. If you receive the services from an out of network provider you may have to meet a deductible before the plan pays or you may not have coverage at all depending on the type of plan you have.

The provider network of the plan is a list of doctors or health care facilities that have agreed to accept the plan. If you are considering a MA plan for the first time you will want to verify with your agent that any doctor or facility you may want to visit is in your plan's network. If you are already in a MA plan you will want to verify with your doctor that they will accept the plan in 2019.

A MA plan's drug formulary is a list of drugs that are covered by the plan. This will include the tiers and copays of the drugs and any deductible you may have to meet on the prescriptions you are taking. Don't overlook the formulary of the plan because MA plans do not cover every prescription drug that is manufactured.







was written in such a manner as to prevent state governments from ever being able to deny citizenship to blacks who were born in the United States. The US had no formal immigration policy in 1868, and there was no need for the authors to address immigration explicitly in the amendment.

The portion of the amendment that reads "subject to the jurisdiction thereof" addressed the chance of children born in the United States to parents of foreigners (i.e.: modern day tourists) or those who belonged to the families of ambassadors, family members or other foreign dignitaries while in the US. The phrase was purposely intended to exclude those born on US soil from automatic citizenship when an allegiance to the United States was not complete. Those infants were still subject to the jurisdiction of their home country and were still citizens thereof. There was no question as to whether the US was claiming them as a citizen.
The phrase carries no

The phrase carries no less meaning now than it did in 1868. The correct interpretation of the 14th Amendment is that an illegal alien mother is NOT American. Therefore, she is subject to the jurisdiction

of her native country, as is her baby.

Birthright citizenship to children of illegal alien mothers is an unfortunate by-product of the 1965 immigration Act that should have been challenged from the outset by people smart enough to know better. This charade has been based upon decades of erroneous executive interpretation.

Once again, many are laughing at President Trump for arguing law when he is not a lawyer. However, this argument has strong legal footing when considering the spirit from which the Amendment was established.

By granting immediate universal birthright citizenship to anyone born on US soil, regardless of the legal status of the parents, we are encouraging and rewarding illegal immigration. Of course, we all know that needy immigrants who don't work and don't speak English and depend heavily on extensive government assistance will eventually mean democrat votes.

Historical documentation should always be considered in the spirit in which it was penned. That includes the issues, the timing, the period, and current events that led up to a new amendment.

This issue is primed for an eventual Supreme Court interpretation. I am eagerly looking forward to it.

#### What You'll Pay for Medicare in 2019

Dear Savvy Senior,

I know there will be a small 2.8 percent cost-ofliving increase in Social Security benefits next year but what about Medicare? What will our Medicare Part B monthly premiums and other Medicare costs be in 2019?

Curious Jim

Dear Jim,

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services recently announced their cost adjustments for 2019, and you'll be happy to know that the standard Medicare Part B monthly premium for most beneficiaries starting in January will be \$135.50, a modest increase of just \$1.50 per month over 2018's standard premium.

There are, however, a small group of Medicare beneficiaries (about 2 million people) who will actually pay less than \$135.50 because the 2.8 percent cost-of-living increase in their Social Security checks will not be large enough to cover the full premium increase. Thanks to the Social Security Act's "hold harmless" provision, Medicare cannot pass along premium increases greater than the dollar increase in their Social Security checks.

In addition, there are also a small group of highincome beneficiaries (about 3 million people) that will pay higher Part B premiums because their income is above \$85,000 as a single, or \$170,000 as a married couple filing jointly.

Medicare uses modified adjusted gross income from your tax return from two years ago to determine your premiums, which means that 2019 Part B premiums are determined by 2017 income.

So, if your income was \$85,001 to \$107,000 (or \$170,001 to \$214,000 if filing jointly), your monthly premium will increase from \$187.50 to \$189.60. Monthly premiums for singles with an income of \$107,001 to \$133,500 (joint filers with income of \$214,001 to \$267,000) will rise from \$267.90 to \$270.90. And premiums for singles earning \$133,501 to \$160,000 (\$267,001 to \$320,000 for joint filers) will increase from \$348.30 to \$352.20.

If you had higher income than that, your monthly premium for 2018 was \$428.60. In 2019, there will be an extra surcharge tier for people with the highest income.

If your income is between \$160,001 and \$499,999 (\$320,001 to \$749,999 for joint filers), you'll pay \$433.40 per month. Single filers with income of \$500,000 or more (\$750,000 or more for joint filers) will pay \$460.50 per month.

If you fall into any of these high-income categories and you've experienced certain lifechanging events that have reduced your income since 2017, such as retirement, divorce or the death of a spouse, you can contest the surcharge. For more information about contesting or reducing the high-income surcharge, see "Medicare Premiums: Rules for Higher-Income Beneficiaries" at SSA.gov/ pubs/EN-05-10536.pdf.

In addition to the Part B premium increases, the annual deductible for Medicare Part B, which covers physician services and other outpatient

services, will see a mild bump from \$183 to \$185 in 2019. The deductible for Medicare Part A, which covers hospital services, will increase from \$1,340 in

2018 to \$1,364 in 2019.
