Originated as "Armistice Day" on November 11,1919 - the first anniversary of the end of WWI; Congress passed a resolution in 1926 to make November 11th an annual observance; in 1938 November 11th became a National Holiday; in 1954 President Eisenhower officially changed the name of the day from Armistice Day to Veterans Day; in 1968 Congress moved the date to the 4th Monday in October - to go into effect in 1971; in 1975, due to the significance of the original date, President Gerald Ford returned the date back to November 11th.

Unlike Memorial Day - VETERANS' DAY is a day set aside each year to pay tribute and respect to all Veterans - living or dead - serving or retired - who honorably served or serve our country during war or peacetime.








Dansville Motor Vehicle Office Closing Early November 14th

Protect Your Child from the Hazards of Lead

If you have children, you should know that lead poisoning is the number one preventable environmental health threat in the United States. Although it is true that children living in older homes are at greatest risk, lead can also be found in your children's toys, which makes lead poisoning a danger to every family. Lead poisoning from paint chips is the most talked about threat, but lead can also get in the body by breathing or swallowing dust or soil and can sometimes be found in drinking water.

The only way to know if your child has lead poisoning is to get a blood lead test. In New York State, all children must be tested for lead exposure at or around age one and again at age two.

Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Week 2018 was observed October 21st through 27th. The Livingston County Department of Health reminds parents that most children with lead poisoning do not look or feel sick. Children with both low and high levels of lead in their bodies can suffer from brain and nervous system damage, behavioral and learning problems, slowed growth, hearing loss and headaches. The first step in preventing lead poisoning is to keep your home in good repair. If you live in a house or apartment built before 1978, it's important to properly repair any peeling paint properly. When paint flakes are disturbed, the home can become filled with lead-containing dust.

Call the local health department before you do any remodeling to find out how to paint and repair safely. Frequent washing of children's hands, toys, and pacifiers is an effective way to keep lead from accumulating. The Livingston County Department of Health also recommends cleaning floors often with a damp mop, and use damp cloths to clean windowsills.




