





In the recent meeting, Lauderdale County Schools Superintendent, Hatton, stated, "Helping our students is the main focus for us daily. Pursuing career technical education and development workforce opportunities is something we are excited to be involved with because it expands their future realworld job possibilities."

A three-way path from high school through Northwest-Shoals and on to the University of North Alabama (UNA) is currently being developed in some programs. Therefore, UNA will also have a presence in the proposed center. "These paths will help ensure that students complete an education and move into high wage/high demand careers," Colagross stated.

In addition to dual enrollment opportunities, the proposed center will

provide flexible training for business and industry. The high wage/high demand programs offered electrical, will include machine tool, industrial systems, welding, and robotics. Additionally, the college plans to offer a machinist apprenticeship program on-site. Plans also are underway to start a Federation for Advanced Manufacturing Education (FAME) program. FAME program allows students to earn a wage and gain work experience while pursuing an advanced manufacturing degree.

A portion of the funding needed to construct the proposed center already been secured. Due to the 2017 efforts of Senator Tim Melson and Representative Lynn Greer, Governor Kay Ivey set aside four million dollars for the project. The Shoals Economic Development Center earmarked additional five million dollars for the project in 2018.

gallantry in action when on February 4, 1966 he led a squad patrol on a routine search of several villages in the Republic of Vietnam. As his squad approached a village, they were suddenly engaged by small arms and automatic weapons fire by an estimated Viet Cong squad. Exposing himself to the deadly insurgent fire, Lt. Wallace led an assault that was so aggressive that the Viet Cong were forced to withdraw. Lt. Wallace then led his patrol across an open rice paddy, skillfully executing fire and movement in pursuit of the enemy insurgent force. The Viet Cong squad joined an estimated platoon-size force who were well entrenched. Lt. Wallace directed effective artillery fire and air strikes on the hostile positions.

When the supporting fires lifted. Lt. Wallace led his squad in an assault and was met by intense automatic weapons and mortar fire which forced him to withdraw. One fire team leader fell wounded in withdrawal. Lt. Wallace ran in to the open rice paddy to aid his wounded comrade without hesitation. Lt. Wallace was wounded in the leg before he could reach him. Unmindful of his wound, Lt Wallace got up and continued toward the wounded man.

As he approached the stricken soldier, Lt. Wallace killed two Viet Cong who were also attempting to reach the wounded man. Fully exposed to the intense Viet Cong fire concentrated on him, he aided the wounded soldier. Lt. Wallace was mortally wounded by hostile automatic weapons fire while assisting his wounded comrade to safety. Due to his courage, inspiring example, and his leadership, Lt. Wallace was instrumental in saving the life of a fellow soldier and accounted for twenty-

seven Viet Cong killed. Lieutenant Wallace's unimpeachable valor in close combat against a numerically superior hostile force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, the United States Army, the town of Cherokee and a grateful nation.

My grandfather has metastatic cancer and is refusing chemotherapy. How can I persuade him take the treatment?

The real question should be: "is chemotherapy even appropriate for him?"

Cancers progress through four stages: metastatic refers to the final stage (4), meaning it has spread beyond the original tumor. Whereas stage 1 is often curable

(using surgery, radiation, and/or chemotherapy), stages 2 and 3 are less so; and stage 4 usually results in death.

An article in the *Times-Daily* of June 27, 2017 described how patients with stage 4 keep receiving *false hope* from doctors and the cancer treatment industry, hoping for a cure, when in reality, chemotherapy in stage 4 only creates increased suffering—with a worse quality of death and no improvement in quality of life.

Everyone hopes there will be miraculous cure for the dreaded big 'C'. But, as reported in the *Journal of the American Medical Association* in 2015, despite all the research and promotions, all we've done over the last 20 years is make patients feel worse and they don't live any longer. The editors stated, "It is disturbing that this trial demonstrated no benefits of chemotherapy... and... that oncologists still recommend and use systemic therapy so close to patient death."

The evidence is accumulating: once you have metastatic cancer, your chance of living longer and better by taking chemotherapy is poor indeed. When the goal is *quality of life, not quantity*, your grandfather's decision is the best one: essentially, eat and drink what you like, enjoy your family, and avoid all the side-effects from treatment.

If someone tries to make him feel guilty for refusing chemotherapy, remember that 'false hope' is worse than 'no hope'. A comfort-focused approach improves not only our quality of living, but also of dying: it's what our hospice does well!





My uncle is 85 years old. He has never been married and has no children. He has a sizable estate but does not have a Will. My mother (his sister) passed away six years ago. Her name is on his life insurance policies and the beneficiary to all his money. I have three brothers and just wanted to know if his estate should go to me and my brothers?

When there is a Will, property and money is distributed according to the terms of the Will. When there is not a Will, property and money is distributed under the laws of intestate succession. When there is a Will, the estate is probated. When there is not a Will, an estate is administered.

It is always better to have a Will because that saves the estate the cost of a bond and if the estate is not finished within the first year, then another bond must be purchased.

As you've heard on television, the State does have a Will that is written for everyone and that is known as intestate succession. In Alabama, intestate succession provides that if there is a surviving spouse, the spouse would get a certain amount of money in value and that amount changes if the decedent (person who died and left the estate) and the surviving spouse together had children. If all of the children were by the decedent and the surviving spouse the spouse gets more. If the decedent has a surviving spouse and children that are not the issue (children of) the surviving spouse, then the surviving spouse receives less allowing for more to go to the surviving children of the person who died.

If there is no spouse, then to the children, if no children then to the parents, and if there are no children or parents, then to the aunts and uncles and so forth. You can read the rules at Alabama Code §43-8-41 and §43-8-42.

The way that the legislature is set up "the Will the State wrote for you" or intestate succession is about as rational and well thought out as any group of people could come up with.

Remember that life insurance and investment accounts are going to be distributed according to the contract under which they are made. If your uncle left his life insurance to your mom and she has passed away, I would think that the money would be paid to her estate and distributed according to the terms of her Will or the rules of intestate succession. Remember that a home is usually held in a deed that provides that the survivor of a marriage gets the property. No matter what a Will provides, the deed controls the disposition of the property.





Medicare Minute

"Types of Medicare Advantage Plans"

There are basically two types of Medicare Advantage Plans. One type is a HMO. HMO stands for Health Maintenance Organization. The other type is a PPO or Preferred Provider Organization. Although both are Medicare Advantage Plans there are some distinct differences in the two.

In most HMO plans you generally can only go to doctors, health care facilities or hospitals that are on the provider list of the plan except in emergency. HMO plans require you to name a primary care provider (PCP). Your PCP becomes the quarterback of your health care. This means you may have to have a referral from your PCP if you want to see a specialist or another health care provider. All HMO plans do not require a referral, so this is a question you will want to ask of considering a HMO.

In a PPO plan, you also have a defined network of providers. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network but, unlike a HMO, you may have some coverage if you go to an out-of-network provider. You will pay more for using an out-of-network provider versus an in-network provider. Also a PPO plan may give you the option of getting your health care from a provider outside your immediate geographical area whereas a HMO can be more limited.

HMO and PPO plans are similar in many ways. They both have a defined network of providers, both have a copay on most services you receive and except for a few exceptions will both include prescription drug coverage. Finding a Medicare health plan is about finding the plan that is right for you. It's a good idea to research both HMO and PPO plans if you are considering a Medicare Advantage Plan.






