PROHIBITED PARKING

The parking of all commercial and passenger vehicles is hereby prohibited on all Town and County roads within the Town of Mount Morris at anytime between the dates of November 1 and April 1. For the purpose of facilitating snow removal, the Highway Superintendent is authorized to erect and maintain signs prohibiting the parking of vehicles pursuant to this chapter. Any vehicle may be towed and impounded at the expense of the owner by the Highway Superintendent or any person designated by the Highway Superintendent which is in violation of this chapter. After removal of any vehicle, the Highway Superintendent or any such designee shall have the vehicle stored in a designated storage area at the expense of the owner. Such owner or person with legal authority to redeem the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment of all expenses and charges actually and necessarily incurred for such removal and storage and by fulfilling all of the requirements of New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law § 1204(d). In addition, any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall subject such violator to a civil penalty, not to exceed \$25 for the first violation and not to exceed \$50 for each subsequent violation.

SNOW REMOVAL AND MAILBOXES

Please be aware that the Town is not legally responsible for the replacement of any mailbox that has been knocked down by the snow plow. Often it is not the plow, but the weight of the snow that knocks over the mailbox. Also, many roadside mailboxes are located in the Town's right-of-way and the plows need to push the snow back far enough to clear this area. This situation is an unfortunate consequence of living in a rural area, and the Town does not have the resources to replace or reinstall all fallen mailboxes. Your understanding is appreciated.

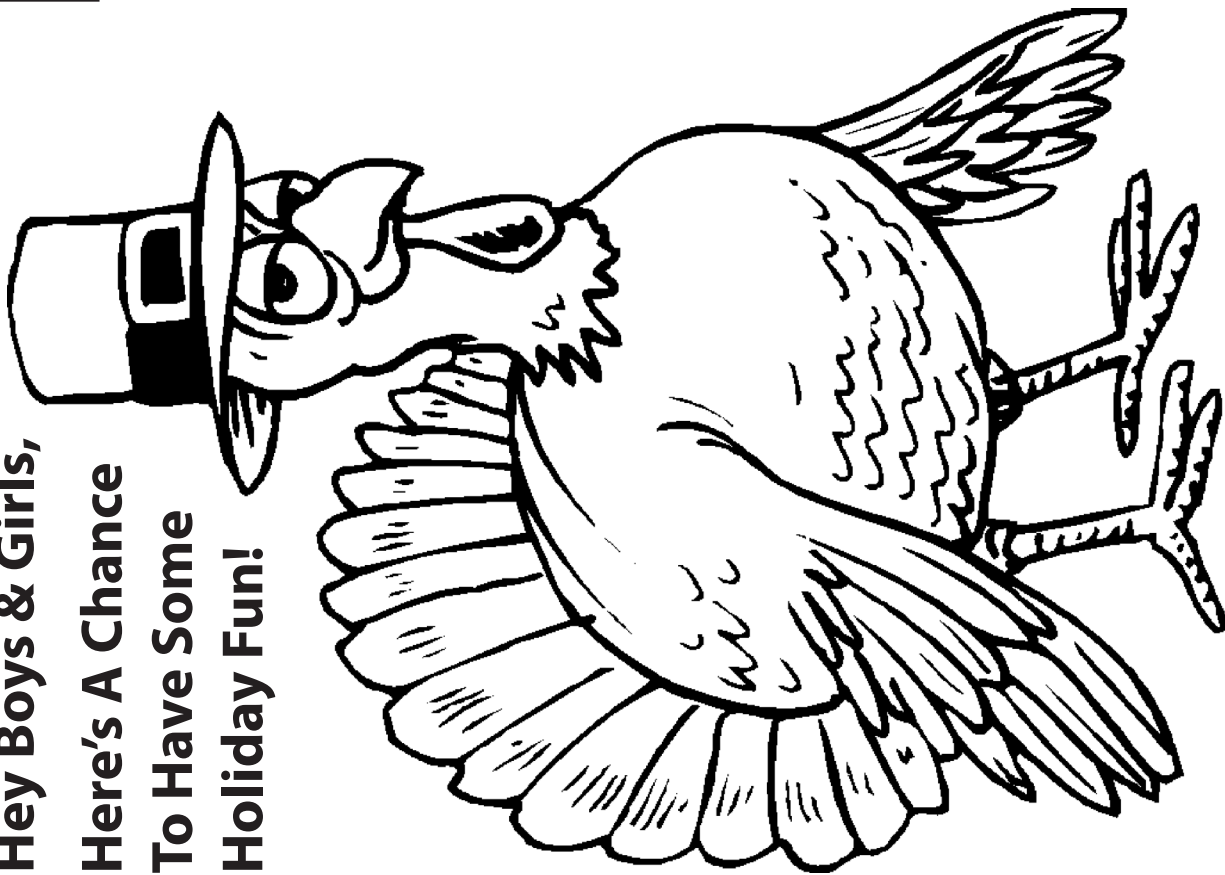

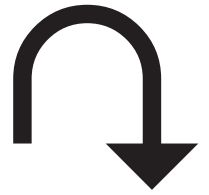

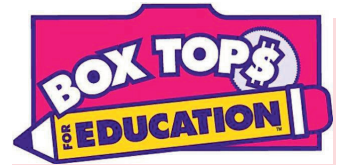

Is Your Home Safe from Radon?

Radon is sneaky and dangerous! Radon is a cancer-causing radioactive gas that you cannot see, smell, or taste. It can be present in your home without you knowing and has been identified by the Surgeon General as the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, radon is responsible for approximately 20,000 deaths annually.

Radon is produced naturally by the decay of radioactive material in soil, rock and in groundwater. It moves upward in the soil and can enter your home through cracks and other holes in your home's foundation or with groundwater from a well.

Houses located on highly permeable, gravel concentrated soils can have indoor radon levels that are above average. Houses located on or around limestone rock formations may also be at higher risk for elevated indoor radon levels.

According to the EPA Map of Radon Zones, Livingston County is one of many counties in New York State considered to have a high potential for high radon levels. The only way to determine if radon is a concern in your home is to test for it using a radon detection kit. The Livingston County Department of Health reminds residents that radon detection kits are available free of charge to Livingston County residents who are homeowners through the Center for Environmental Health. 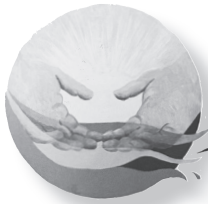
