IT FINALLY ARRIVED!

Well winter has finally arrived and in some places pretty hard. The Saturday before I headed to camp down in Allegheny County to check a few things out with the intentions of returning home that day, a really bad snowstorm with high winds was encountered about halfway down. It got to the point where I would have turned around and headed back home if that had been possible. New snow tires had just been put on so that was good, but I was struggling and it was almost impossible to see the road at times. It kind of reminded me of the Blizzard of '77 when I actually traveled between Lockport and Pendleton twice that evening. I had checked the weather map and it looked like the storm was going to be a little north of Arcade so it I was figuring on good sailing after that. Only a few inches existed at camp and by the time I spent some time scouting around and gathering some things to bring home, the decision to stay overnight was made in hopes that by Sunday morning that bad section up north would be cleared and it was.

Here of course we were in good shape, but that storm experience reminded me to get my bird feeder up. I enjoy watching the birds out my living room window and the birds enjoy the free handouts.

Lots of geese have been moving into our refuge areas and I have taken advantage of that by getting out in the swamp early with the camera. I love to watch geese come in, especially when they start slipping and sliding to lose altitude quickly as they drop into the marshes and of course trying to capture that with the camera. I have actually seen geese fly upside down while doing this, but never caught it until the other day.

With waterfowl season open the places to visit, for photographing and observing, are the ones that are off limits to hunters. Ringneck Mash on the INWR is always a good bet and seeing it is only a few miles from my place it is usually one of the first places that are visited in the morning. One morning last week I was treated to thousands of new migrating geese pulling into that marsh. There were a lot of hooded mergansers, too. The pair of bald eagles, who call Ringneck Marsh their territory, are usually seen there and sometimes they offer a shot or two. It turned out to be a great morning for both photographing and the excitement of watching some of mother nature's wonders.

Another spot, over near the Tonawanda WMA that is off limits to hunters, is also included in my daily adventures and there have been a lot of mallards, with some pintails and gadwalls.

A great egret hasn't been seen for a week or better so they have gotten the word that winter is almost here with its freezing temperatures, but a couple of great blue herons are still around yet and they look pretty cold and depressed!

If you are out and about in our swamp you will notice mounds of cattails and mud in the marshes that the muskrats are building houses to wait out the winter in. Later in the spring geese often use them to build their nest on.

Deer sightings haven't been as numerous as before bow season, but that is normal. Deer learn quickly that they are being hunted and become very nocturnal and now that gun season opens on the 17th they will be even less visible. We have a great area for deer hunting and some dandy bucks are taken ever year. Last week one morning I got several shots (camera) at a really big buck on public land that really got my blood flowing. I caught the big 8-point with a doe about 250 yards out in a grown up field just as they were headed into thicket and he paused just long enough for me to get the camera on him. If someone gets this guy you are going to hear about it!

Fall foliage fooled me this year as it was better than I figured it would be, but still not up to par with past years. There was some great colors, but they were late and you had to look for them. Now only the beech are giving any color. They always seem to be late getting the word that winter is here!

Fall brings winter, but it is a great time of the year to be outdoors and winter is not always that bad either, you just have to prepare for it.

If you get a big buck let me know, maybe we could do a little story on him. If you get the one I photographed last week let me know, I will be right over with my camera!

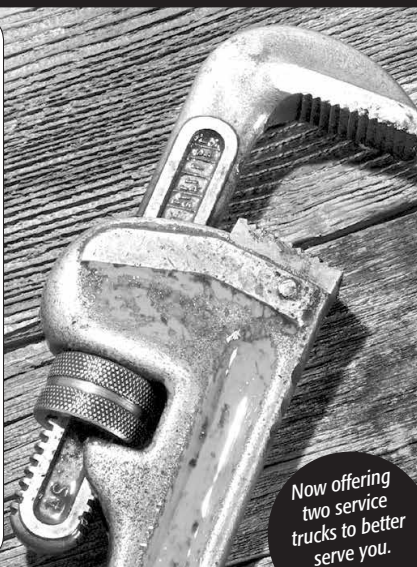

## How to Time Holiday Shopping Right

The holiday season begins at the end of November and stretches into the first week of January. But this five-week stretch may not necessarily be the best time for everyone to shop.

Harvard Business Review says that the retail industry has been turned on its head in recent years, and shoppers and retailers may want to rethink their approaches to the holiday shopping season. But keep in mind that, according to a survey conducted by Business Wire, 65 percent of holiday shoppers scramble to complete their purchases in the last two weeks before Christmas, so shoppers who delay may be stuck in long lines at the mall.

- Embrace in-store pickup. Many retailers are merging their online and brick-and-mortar operations. Shoppers have the convenience of price-comparison and online shopping, with the physical enjoyment of going out to the store to complete their purchases. In-store pickup often enables shoppers to avoid hefty shipping fees, as in-store pickup is free. Plus, scoping out items online — and ensuring they're in stock — saves the hassle of making a trip in vain.

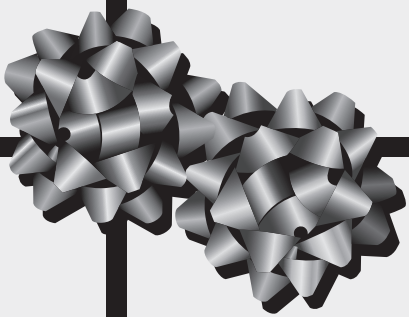

## How to Build a Holiday Giving Budget

Spending time with loved ones and reflecting on all of the blessings the previous year has bestowed is a great way to celebrate the holiday season. But giving, entertaining and traveling are part of the season as well, and that can leave many people wondering how to finance their holiday season.

## A More Organized Family

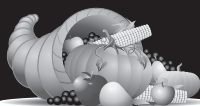

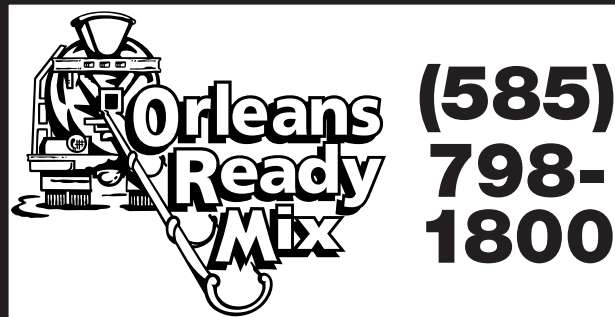

### GET IT IN WRITING

A written contract is considered to be more ironclad than an oral contract because it not only contains a promise made, but it also serves as its own proof of said promise. An oral contract is a promise that has been plainly spoken but not written down. When this promise is broken, it could be considered to be a breach of oral contract. State laws dictate how ironclad they can be by force of law. Those with proof of an oral contract may have legal grounds to pursue litigation if the promise is broken. However, it is generally better to have a written contract in hand if a breach of contract has been made.

If you're in a contract dispute because you think the other party isn't living up to their side of the bargain, providing a notice of breach is the first formal step in resolving the problem. The notice, generally in the form of a letter, explains why you believe there has been a breach of the contract, and lays out the actions that must be taken next, either to solve the problems or to end the contract and compensate for the damage. ## Rich and Nutty Comfort Food for Breakfast

Bread pudding is a tasty concoction made with simple ingredients that, when combined, pack a delicious punch. Bread pudding often can be crafted from ingredients one likely already has in the kitchen. In addition, recipes can be adjusted depending on the number of servings desired.

While bread pudding may be thought of as a dessert, it also can make for a tantalizing meal at breakfast or brunch. Ideal for warming up on autumn or winter days, this "Breakfast Bread Pudding With Pecan Crumble," courtesy of The American Pecan Council and Brandon Matzek, founder of the culinary website Kitchen Konfidence, is sure to be a hit. This satisfying dish also can be prepared ahead of time and then garnished before warming and serving.

## Breakfast Bread Pudding With Pecan Crumble

*Yield: 6 to 8 servings*

For the bread pudding:

- 1/2 tablespoon unsalted butter, for greasing
- 1 pound brioche bread, cut into 3/4-inch cubes
- 8 eggs
- 2 cups milk
- 1/2 cup heavy cream
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 2 tablespoons good bourbon
- Pinch of fine grain sea salt
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans, toasted

For the crumbled topping:

- 1/2 cup flour
- 1/2 cup pecan pieces
- 1/2 cup packed dark brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon fine grain sea salt
- 3 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature
- Sliced persimmons, for serving (optional)
- Maple syrup, for serving (optional)

Lightly butter a 9 x 13 baking dish, then place cubes of brioche in the baking dish in an even layer.

In a large bowl, whisk together eggs, milk, heavy cream, sugars, vanilla, bourbon, and a pinch of sea salt. Sprinkle toasted pecans over the brioche, then pour the wet ingredient mixture evenly all over the bread, making sure it's covered thoroughly. Cover and let sit in the fridge for at least 2 hours (or up to overnight).

To bake the bread pudding: Preheat the oven to 350 F and remove the baking dish from fridge.

Meanwhile, prepare the crumble: Add flour, pecans, dark brown sugar, cinnamon, salt, and butter to a medium bowl, and using your fingertips, rub ingredients together until evenly combined and clumps start to form. Sprinkle the surface of the bread evenly with the crumbs. Bake until the bread pudding is puffy and the top is golden, about 45 minutes to an hour.

To serve, cut squares of warm bread pudding, and place on small plates. Top with sliced persimmons and maple syrup, if desired. ■
