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
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


For it is by grace you have been saved through faith, and this not from yourselves; it is the GIFT of God, not by works, so that no one can boast. - Ephesians 2:8-9



# **ORANGE CREAM FUDGE**

## **Ingredients**

3 cups white sugar 2/3 cup heavy cream 3/4 cup butter

- 1 (7 ounce) jar marshmallow creme
- 1 (11 ounce) package white chocolate chips
- 3 teaspoons orange extract
- 12 drops yellow food coloring
- 9 drops red food coloring

### **Directions**

Grease a  $9 \times 13$  inch pan.

In a medium saucepan over medium heat, combine sugar, cream and butter. Heat to soft ball stage, 234 degrees F (112 degrees C). Remove from heat and stir in marshmallow creme and white chocolate chips; mix well until the chips melt. Reserve 1 cup of mixture and set aside.

To the remaining mixture add orange flavoring, yellow and red food coloring. Stir well and pour into prepared pan. Pour reserved cream mixture on top. Using a knife, swirl layers for decorative effect.

Chill for 2 hours, or until firm, and cut into squares.

# **CHRISTMAS CRACK**

### **Ingredients**

1 (13-ounce) box Rice Chex cereal 1 (12-ounce) box Golden Grahams cereal

- 1 large can cashew halves and pieces
- 1 1/2 cup butter
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 cups corn syrup

# **Directions**

Combine Rice Chex, Golden Grahams, and cashews in a large mixing bowl.

In a large sauce pan, cook butter, sugar, and corn syrup to the "soft ball" stage. About 234°F on a candy thermometer. Pour over cereal mixture and stir until all is well coated.

Pour mixture out onto 2 large cookie sheets to cool. Stir it around occasionally to prevent clumping.

Store in an airtight container.

# **EGGNOG FUDGE**

- 2 Teaspoons Vanilla Extract
- ½ Teaspoon Nutmeg, Grated

### **Instructions**

Line a 9x9 pan with foil. Spray with non stick cooking spray.

In a medium sauce pan, combine butter, sugar, and eggnog. Bring to a boil.

Cook until the temperature reaches 234 degrees on a candy thermometer.

Remove from heat. Stir in white chocolate until melted.

Stir in marshmallow creme, vanilla, and nutmeg. Evenly spread into prepared pan.

Garnish with more grated nutmeg if desired.

# **CHOCOLATE BILLIONAIRES**

### **Ingredients**

1 package (14 ounces) caramels 3 tablespoons water

- 1-1/2 cups chopped pecans
- 1 cup crisp rice cereal
- 3 cups milk chocolate chips
- 1-1/2 teaspoons shortening







### **Directions**

Line two baking sheets with waxed paper; grease the paper and set aside. In a large heavy saucepan, combine the caramels and water; cook and stir over low heat until smooth. Stir in pecans and cereal until coated. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto prepared pans. Refrigerate for 10 minutes or until firm. Meanwhile, in a microwave, melt chocolate chips and shortening; stir until smooth. Dip candy into chocolate, coating all sides; allow excess to drip off. Place on prepared pans. Refrigerate until set. Store in an airtight container.

# POTATO CHIP CLUSTERS

# **Ingredients**

9 ounces white baking chocolate, chopped 2 cups coarsely crushed ridged potato chips 1/2 cup chopped pecans



In a large microwave-safe bowl, melt white chocolate. Stir in

potato chips and pecans. Drop by tablespoonfuls onto waxed paper-lined baking sheets. Refrigerate until set.




### **Ingredients:**

1 cup raw almonds

1 cup sugar

1/3 cup pecans, chopped





### **Directions:**

Preheat oven to 350 F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat. Spread almonds in an even layer onto the prepared baking sheet. Place into oven and bake until toasted, about 10 minutes; set aside. In a medium saucepan, combine butter, sugar vanilla and salt over medium heat. Cook, whisking constantly, until butter has melted and mixture is almond brown in color, about 10-15 minutes.

Immediately spread the hot caramel mixture evenly over the almonds. Sprinkle with chocolate chips. After 1-2 minutes, spread the chocolate chips in an even layer until smooth. Sprinkle with pecans.

Let cool completely, about 2 hours. Break into pieces.

### PERFECT SOUTHERN PECAN PRALINES

### **Ingredients**

11/2 cups pecan halves or chopped pecans

11/2 cups granulated white sugar 34 cup brown sugar

¼ cup + 2 Tbsp unsalted butter, cubed

½ cup evaporated milk (NOT sweetened condensed milk)

1 tsp vanilla extract

1/2 tsp kosher salt

# Instructions

Line 2 cupcake tins with about 16-20 paper liners. Set aside briefly.

In a large, heavy bottomed saucepan, combine the pecan halves, sugars, butter, evaporated milk, vanilla extract, and salt and bring to a boil over medium heat. Stick in a candy thermometer and stir constantly while boiling until temperature reaches 235° to 240° degrees F, about 10 minutes. Remove the pan from the heat and working quickly and CAREFULLY, beat the mixture vigorously with a wooden spoon until mixture thickens and almost turns cloudy and opaque in color, about 2-5 minutes. Working fast, use a spoon or cookie dough scoop to portion the hot candy into each muffin tin, covering the bottom of the muffin cup. You should get about 16-20 candies, depending on how much you fill each cupcake tin. Cool the candy COMPLETELY. Candy is ready once it's reached room temperature and is firm and solid. Peel away cupcake liners before serving.
