



# THE PANHANDLE'S FIRST NEWSPAPER

The city of Clarendon is loaded with history, dating back to the days of Col. Charles Goodnight and the JA ranch. Several of the oldest churches in the panhandle were organized in Clarendon. The city has the oldest functioning courthouse in the state. It also has the oldest

newspaper in the panhandle.

"The Clarendon Enterprise turned 140 years old on June first of this year," says Roger Estlack, publisher. "It started out June first 1878 by Reverend Lewis Carhart, who founded the town of Clarendon as a temperance colony and named it in honor of his wife Clara. He started the first newspaper in the Texas Panhandle. The first issue was printed in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Carhart's relatives had a print shop up there so he would put the articles together in Clarendon and ship them off to Wisconsin where his uncle would print the paper, put it on the train back to Sherman and overland to Clarendon. It was a monthly newspaper to start out. Then about two years later Carhart's cousin moved to Clarendon and brought with him the first press in the panhandle and turned the paper into a weekly. It was called the Clarendon Chronicle for a while, then the Industrial West. My family started a paper in the 20's called the Donley County Leader and published it forty years. It was later merged with the

Roger says the paper has changed a lot, especially in the last 20 years. "I have digital subscribers now. Probably twenty-five to thirty percent of our circulation is strictly electronic."

Clarendon newspaper at one point. From 1929 to 1974 my family owned

the paper then I purchased it in 1995."

The paper has won some prestigious awards for reports on child abuse and various historical articles. But some awards mean the most to Roger. "My son is eleven, my daughter is nine. She takes pictures and he writes a weekly column. They've both won some awards with their work. That's pretty cool to be bringing up the next generation of newspaper people."

Roger wasn't so sure he wanted to be a newspaperman. He worked in his uncle's print shop for a while. In high school his English teacher was a woman named Kay Hayes.

"She taught us all the UIL journalism stuff like news, editorial and feature writing. I told her I didn't know what I would end up doing with my life but it certainly wouldn't be working at a newspaper."


Roger has enjoyed reporting on all aspects of life in Clarendon, including the remodeled downtown Movie Theater set to open later this year. He thinks a good newspaper is vital to a town.

"I think it's best for a town when a paper has local ownership. If you look around at some of the strongest communities in the state you'll find they have a strong newspaper."

This feast lasted three days, and—as accounted by attendee Edward Winslow—it was attended by 90 Native Americans and 53 Pilgrims. The New England colonists were accustomed to regularly celebrating "thanksgivings"days of prayer thanking God for blessings such as military victory or the end of a drought.


