- · With the holidays approaching, now is a good time to run the self-cleaning cycle on your oven. Wipe out any bits first and remove as much grease as you can. Then make sure to open a window to air out fumes.
- To get cloudy glassware sparkling for the holidays, soak in hot vinegar for 15 minutes to clear them up. Wash good crystal by hand only, never in the dishwasher.
- · Since you know it's coming anyway, take the opportunity to clean out the fridge a day or two before a big family dinner. It's a good idea to eat up any leftovers for dinner the day before. You'll have plenty to replace them on Thanksgiving, right?
- "If you have one person responsible for putting prep dishes and pots and pans in the dishwasher while you are preparing the bird and side dishes for the table, you will be halfway done with dishes by the time the meal is over."—M.A. in Washington
- "I buy extra supplies for Thanksgiving dinner as items go on sale. We always make extra-large portions of our side dishes and even put in an extra turkey while we're eating! Freeze meals in individual containers for quick dinners throughout the busy weeks from Turkey Day to Christmas.

Potatoes and vegetable casseroles freeze well, and they taste better than microwave dinners from the grocery store."—E.S. in Oregon

- In the fridge, it takes 24 hours of defrosting for every 5 pounds of turkey. When defrosting in water (only birds in a leakproof plastic wrapper), allow 30 minutes per pound and change the water every half-hour.
- · Get kids in on the act of cooking. There's no better time than the holidays to get budding chefs into your family's holiday traditions. Let them help prep, and as they get older, assign cherished side dishes to appropriateage children.
- · Candles will burn more evenly if you refrigerate them for a few hours before lighting.
- For a tailgating favorite, make this: Prepare a batch of macaroni and cheese, then add an egg and stir in. Butter the wells of a muffin tin and fill with the mac and cheese. Top with a bit of shredded cheddar and bake for 20 minutes at 400 F. You can even make them super portable by using muffin liners. The gang loves these no fork necessary!
- · "In my family, you come to a holiday dinner with your own plastic containers for leftovers. If you don't bring your own, you don't go home with tomorrow's lunch. Mom instituted this rule after the first Thanksgiving when all the kids had moved out. We practically cleaned her out of Tupperware!" -E.Y. in New Mexico

In this season of Thanksgiving, I would like to share simple lessons I have learned.

Many years ago, we were under a severe weather alert. A caller urged us to help two dogs that he did not think would survive the night. We left immediately to go to the address and found two skeletal dogs with no shelter, living on the hard, frozen ground.

We seized them and took them to the shelter. A volunteer, crying at the sight, put blankets on their beds and gave each of them a rawhide. One of the dogs timidly took the offered treat and licked the volunteer's hand before turning around to eat.

A few years later, a horse that was underweight by a few hundred pounds had been seized, and was taken to a local veterinary clinic for treatment and to be boarded. The horse stood listening to the story about the deliveryman calling us for help, our hours-long work to find transportation for him, and then our almost-comical efforts to load him into the trailer. As I finished the story with, "But when we looked in his eyes, we knew he needed help, and I promised him I would help," the horse slowly walked over to me and nudged my shoulder. I understood that to be an expression of gratitude.

Their stories join all the others in teaching us huge lessons about being thankful. In a society that seems to be shouting with ever-increasing loud voices that we deserve the biggest and the best, perhaps we will do well to remember the simple act

of being grateful for what we have. As the saying goes, "Gratitude turns what we have into enough."

The animals at dumpsters, the dogs who live their lives on short chains, the hurt animals, and the abused ones ask for little and receive even less. Yet, unless I am completely wrong, they do not spend their days complaining about what they do not have; they are grateful for the smallest bit of food, the hand that occasionally pets them, and the tiniest bit of water. We could learn a lot about gratitude from the animals. We could learn to treat small treats and sips of water as if they are gold, we could learn to express gratitude willingly, and we could learn that there is a myriad of reasons to be grateful for what we have.

We are grateful for the lessons we learn from the animals, but above all, we are grateful for the magnificent creatures they are who fulfill the measure of their creation.

Schuco Stuffed Bears

Are the Schuco stuffed bears made by the famous German Schuco company that made the very collectible toy cars? The German company started making clockwork and other mechanical tin toys in 1912 as Schreyer & Co. in Nuremberg, Germany. The name was changed to Schuco in 1921. The company designed and made many clever toys that moved.



This 1930s Schuco toy spaniel with brown ears, a white body and a stitched nose and mouth sold for \$900, which was three times the estimate.

Teddy bears were added during the 1920s, and some were miniature bears that held a bottle inside. The famous "Yes/No" bear moved its head when you moved its tail up and down or sidewise. The business faced many reorganizations, and new companies formed in Germany and the U.S. until 1972, when it declared bankruptcy. It was later acquired and is now part of Simba Dickie Group, a major toy company.

The Schuco company in the U.S. made teddy bears in the 1920s with black button eyes. A few years later, the bears had jointed arms, jointed legs and flat feet, and by 1925, some of them could walk. An early 1930s Schuco Yes/No stuffed spaniel in nice condition with cut-glass eyes recently sold at a Bertoia Auctions auction for \$900, although many Schuco toys sell today for less than \$300.

• I inherited a carved wooden • cane with a hidden sword in it. The cane is about 37 1/2 inches long and the blade is about 18 1/2 inches. The carved handle head looks Egyptian, and there are carved designs down the entire cane. It has a metal tip and a metal piece with a button to release the blade. I can't find any markings on it. Any information including approximate value would be helpful.

 Canes were popular accessories • for the well-dressed man from the 1700s to the early 1900s. Gadget canes, which are canes that have special features or conceal items, are popular with collectors. Canes have been made that conceal swords and other weapons, flasks, lighters, fans, perfume bottles, pool cues, tools and other items. The cane's value is determined by the material of the head, intricate hand carving and special features. A carved sword cane with overall leaf and vine carving sold for \$360 recently, but several more common sword canes went for \$25-\$55.



Parks and Recreation receives four awards at state conference

DANVILLE - Danville Parks and Recreation recently received four awards during Virginia Parks and Recreation Society's Annual Conference.

"As always, we are humbled to represent the community so well on such a large stage," said Department Director Bill Sgrinia. "Our staff work tirelessly to address needs and provide quality services for our community and they are well deserving of these recognitions.'

The statewide awards program honors individuals, departments, and organizations throughout Virginia who have demonstrated excellence during the previous year. This year, departments across the Commonwealth submitted 114 applications in 14 different categories for work completed in 2017.

Best New Special Event, Market Monster Mash

Danville's Halloween event, Market Monster Mash, drew over 6,000 people to the Community Market in its first year, far exceeding the expected 2,000. Grant funding, community partners, donations, and public support helped create a safe, fun environment for holiday activities including pumpkin carving, bounce houses, make-your-own slime, scarecrow stuffing, a pet-and-kid costume parade and trunkor-treating.

Best New Program, Rec Mobile

Facing participation barriers such as transportation and income, Department staff created a way to take recreational programming to the communities in the form of Rec Mobile. For five days a week throughout the spring and summer of 2017, a van loaded with play, sports, and fitness equipment visited two sites daily. Over 1,350 students participated in non-elimination active games, health education activities, and self-paced crafts.

Best New Environmental Sustainability, Dan River Twins

The Dan River Twins was a collaborative effort by Danville Parks and Recreation, Danville Public Library, Danville Public Schools, Danville Regional Foundation, History United, and Dan River Basin Association. The program sought to change negative perceptions of the Dan River by telling its story through a fictional tale about two otter siblings competing in the otter frolics. The book highlights North American wildlife and teaches children the importance of environmental stewardship.

Best Health and Wellness Initiative, Thrive! Challenge

The Thrive! Challenge is a cooperative effort with the Health Collaborative designed to allow participating organizations to tailor programs. The challenge encouraged community members and organizations to create health and wellness opportunities in their daily lifestyles; while some worksites partnered with local gyms, others offered fitness classes and walking challenges to its employees.

"It is noteworthy to point out that these awards include four different service areas and a lot of effort from many members of the community," Sgrinia said. "We believe our Department and our community is made up of a diverse group of individuals all working to make Danville a great place to live.

"None of these awards would be possible without the hard work and dedication of the community and our staff. While the plaques list Parks and Recreation as award recipients, these designations belong to the individuals of our city.







"I have had dogs all my life, and not once have I ever had to get one out of a tree." Those were the words I was muttering to myself just a few days ago as I stood at the trunk and looked up in the high branches of one of the giant oaks in our front yard. Duchess, our newly acquired kitten of about 8 weeks old. had at some point decided that it would be a brilliant idea to climb that tree, and now she could not get back

Our two faithful mutts, grumpy old Riley and blissfully goofy Echo, were mulling about the yard and occasionally looking that way as if to say, "and this is what you thought you needed to bring home for your oldest daughter, the traitorous cat lover?"

"What are we going to do, dad?" Karis asked me with the gravest of concern. "Well, babe, it's like this. When that cat gets hungry, it will come down," I said with confidence. She just gave me "that look" that daughters everywhere are so famous for, and I knew that this would not be the end of the story...

We came home from church that night, and it took my girls approximately .0003 of a second to be under the tree and looking up into the branches. Sure enough, there was a white kitten with gray ears and gray tail still in the branches mewing plaintively down at them as if to say, "Why am I still up here? Please send someone to fetch me, preferably someone with a platter of milk, a toy, and a crown with which to coronate me queen of this place."

I shook my head in frustration and made my way to the basement to retrieve the only ladder I happened to have on the premises at that moment, an 8 foot step ladder. I put that ladder by the base of the tree and my

daughter held the base of it, although I suspect her main thought at the moment was being there to catch the cat, should it fall, rather than trying to steady the ladder for what she believes is her invincible father.

I climbed onto the very top, the part that says "Do NOT stand here, NOT a step!" and reached up for the cat. She was within inches of my hand. All she had to do was crawl down just a little..

No dice. After five minutes of standing on a perch saying "Here, kitty kitty," the tone of my voice had gone from Dr. Doolitle to Dr. Jekyl to Mr. Hyde, and I knew I needed another train of thought.

I climbed down the ladder, went and got my son's truck that used to be my truck (funny how that happens), parked it under the tree, put the ladder in the bed, and tried again. This got me high enough in the tree for me to reach the cat, which I did. It was then that all of the Garfield cartoons of my youth came rushing back to me, especially the ones where the fireman would retrieve Garfield from the tree, and receive the wounds of a maniacal, sharp clawed whirlwind for his efforts.

That cat put scars across my chest that make me look like I was in the war. If I was the stolen valor type I could show these gashes and plausibly lie about being tortured by the Taliban.

When I got the cat onto firm ground, she raced for the food bowl, and proceeded to ignore every two legged creature who had rescued her or assisted in the rescue. I thought hard about retrieving her from that bowl, carrying her back up the ladder, and putting her back up in the tree, but neither my soft heart nor my cat-person daughter would allow me to long entertain that notion.

If one of my dogs had, somehow, gotten stuck in the tree, it would have licked me in the face to say "thank you" when I rescued it.

This is Thanksgiving week. Truthfully, it is a week that ought to reflect a year long lifestyle for us. Not turkey and dressing and too many desserts, something much more important; an attitude of gratitude. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says, "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

In everything give thanks. We may not be able to give thanks FOR everything, but we can certainly give thanks IN everything. No matter the situation, God is always good to us and, truthfully, most people we meet are pretty good to us as well. The reason the jerks stick out like sore thumbs and go viral in videos is because they are the exceptions, not the rule.

People quite often even do extraordinary things for us (see: cat, tree) that we do not even acknowledge, or worse, return evil for good (see: scars across chest). What a shame for people to justly earn the reputation of cats in that manner.

Please, do not lick anyone in the face this week, or any week. But don't scratch or ignore them for their kindnesses either. Be consistently thankful to God and man; nothing makes for a more pleasant day both for the giver and the recipients of that thankfulness.







- Turkeys first existed in the eastern U.S. and Mexico, where Aztec Indians were raising them for food as early as 200 B.C.
- The Native American name for turkey is "Firkee'
- · Wild turkeys can fly for short distances up to 55 mph and can run 20 mph. The modern large-breasted turkey bred for the Thanksgiving table is too heavy to fly under most circumstances.
- The average weight of a turkey purchased at Thanksgiving is 15 pounds and is about 70 percent white meat and 30 percent dark meat. The heaviest turkey ever raised weighed 86 pounds, about the size of a large dog.

- A turkey under 16 weeks of age is called a fryer, while a young roaster is five to seven months old.
- Only Tom turkeys gobble, mostly as a mating call.
- Turkeys can see in color, but do not see well at night.



Ingredients

1/2 lb bulk hot pork sausage

1/2 cup spicy jalapeño cream cheese spread (from 8-oz container)

1 can (8 oz) Pillsbury™ refrigerated crescent dough sheet or 1 can (8 oz) Pillsbury™ refrigerated crescent rolls

1. Heat oven to 325 F. Remove neck from inside turkey; reserve for making pan gravy. Discard giblets and liver or save for another use. Rinse turkey with cold running water; pat

dry with paper towels. 2. Place onion, celery, parsley and 1/2 bunch each of sage and thyme (wrap and refrigerate remaining herbs to garnish platter) inside body and neck cavities of turkey. Fasten neck skin to back with 1 or 2 skewers. With turkey breast-side up, fold wings under back of turkey so they stay in place. If drumsticks are not held by band of skin or a stuffing clamp, tie legs together with string.

3. Place turkey, breast-side up, on small rack in large (17 by 11 1/2-inch) roasting pan. Rub turkey all over with salt and pepper. Insert meat thermometer into thickest part of thigh next to body, being careful that pointed end of thermometer does not touch bone. Cover turkey with a loose tent of foil, letting top of thermometer poke through foil. Roast turkey about 3 3/4 hours; start checking for doneness during last hour of roasting.

4. While turkey is roasting, prepare broth to use in Pan Gravy.

5. To brown turkey, remove foil during last 1 1/4 hours of roasting time; baste with pan drippings occasionally if you like. Turkey is done when thigh temperature on meat thermometer reaches 175 F to 180 F and breast temperature reaches 165 F. (Internal temperature of turkey will rise 5 degrees to 10 degrees F upon standing.)

6. When turkey is done, place on large platter; cover with foil to keep warm. Complete gravy.

7. To serve, garnish platter with remaining herbs. Pass gravy to spoon over turkey. Remove skin from turkey before eating, if you like.

PAN GRAVY

- medium onion, cut in half stalk celery, cut into large
- chunks
- bay leaf
- sprigs parsley Turkey neck
- cups water

cup all-purpose flour teaspoon salt

1. To make the broth: In 3-quart saucepan, place onion, celery, bay leaf, parsley sprigs, turkey neck and water; heat to boiling over high heat. Reduce heat to low and simmer 45 minutes.

2. Strain broth into large bowl; set aside. Pull meat from neck; discard bones and vegetables. Chop neck meat. If not using right away, cover and refrigerate broth and meat separately up to 2 days.

3. To make gravy: Remove rack from roasting pan and strain drippings from roasting pan into 8-cup liquid measuring cup or medium bowl. Let stand 1 minute or until fat separates from drippings. Spoon 2 tablespoons fat from drippings into 3-quart saucepan; skim and discard any remaining fat from drippings.

4. Add 1 cup broth to roasting pan. Place pan over medium-high heat and stir until browned bits are loosened and liquid boils; boil 1 minute. Strain liquid into drippings in measuring cup. Add enough water to meat-juice mix-

ture in cup to equal 3 1/2 cups total. 5. Stir 1/4 cup all-purpose flour and 1/2 teaspoon salt into fat in saucepan; cook over medium heat until flour turns golden brown, stirring. Gradually stir in drippings mixture and cook until gravy boils and thickens slightly, stirring occasionally. Stir in reserved meat; heat through. Pour gravy into gravy boat or serving bowl. Makes 12 servings.

TIPS: If using a frozen turkey, make sure it is completely thawed, especially inside the cavity. The rule of thumb for thawing turkey in the refrigerator is 24 hours per 5 pounds.

Cooking the stuffing separately yields a juicier bird, but if you want to stuff your turkey, to be safe, make sure that the stuffing temperature reaches 165 F on a meat thermometer. And you will need to roast the turkey about 30 minutes longer than the roasting time indicated.




