Livingston County Awarded \$260,000 for Mobile Crisis Program

Behavioral Health Disorder occurrences have been on a steady rise across the Finger La kes Region with limited community access to appropriate services for individuals experiencing behavioral health crises. This has resulted in inappropriate utilization of hospital services and disjointed care for those in need of timely support and intervention.

In Livingston County, mental health and substance abuse were identified as high priority areas in the current community health assessment. There were two 24-hour crisis hotline services available to residents. There was also only one Mobile Integration Team available to respond to callers, and staff was only available during standard business hours. Afterhour callers, that met criteria for mobile crisis intervention, were referred to the Livingston County Sheriff's Office. Oftentimes, 911 calls of this nature result in mental hygiene arrests and preventable admissions to the local hospitals.

As a result of these challenges, Livingston County Mental Health Services, UR Medicine/ Noyes Health Mental Health, and CASA-Trinity of Livingston County collaborated to assist in preventing this growing number. Together, they applied for Behavioral Health Community Crisis Stabilization funds, which utilizes FLPPS (Finger Lakes Performing Provider System) monies and were awarded \$260,000. The program will provide after-hours crisis intervention services to individuals in Livingston County by deploying behavioral health clinicians to attend crisis calls with Law Enforcement Officers, to conduct on-site behavioral health and substance use evaluations, and potentially avoid unnecessary hospital admissions. Safety plans are developed during the crisis encounters, and follow-up appointments are scheduled at Noyes or Livingston County Mental Health Clinics, or at CASA Trinity's outpatient clinic. Transportation to and from follow-up appointments can be arranged through CASA-Trinity's Peer Advocate Program.

The program was successfully launched in October and continues to serve Livingston County residents.

Outbreak of E.coli Infections Linked to Romaine Lettuce - Residents Advised Not to Eat -

Mount Morris, NY - A multistate outbreak investigation is underway in several states and Canada after an outbreak of E. coli has been discovered and believed to be linked to Romaine Lettuce. There have been thirty-two people infected from 11 states. Thirteen have been hospitalized, and no deaths have been reported. The illnesses started on October 8, 2018.

The Livingston County Department of Health, under advisement of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is asking residents not to eat any romaine lettuce until more is learned about the outbreak. Residents who have any type of romaine lettuce in their home should not eat it and should throw it away, even if some of it was eaten and no one has gotten sick. This includes all types or uses of romaine lettuce, such as whole heads, hearts of romaine, and bags or boxes of precut lettuce and salad mixes that contain romaine. If you are not sure that it contains romaine, do not eat it and throw it away. Be sure to wash and sanitize drawers and shelves in your refrigerators where the romaine was stored.

Symptoms of this infection can vary for each person, but can often include severe stomach cramps, diarrhea, and vomiting. Some people can develop a fever, which is not usually very high. Most people get better within 5 to 7 days. Some infections are very mild, while others can be severe or even life threatening. Symptoms can develop 3-4 days after eating or drinking something that contains the bacteria. About 5-10% of people who are diagnosed with this infection can develop a life-threatening complication called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS). Some clues that someone is developing this include decreased frequency of urination, feeling very tire, and losing pink color in cheeks. Most people will recover within a few weeks, but can suffer permanent damage. If you have diarrhea or a high fever that lasts more than 3 days, please contact your healthcare provider. E.coli infection is usually diagnosed by testing a stool sample.

The best way to prevent this E.coli infection is to throw out romaine lettuce, wash your hands properly with antibacterial soap and warm water, For more information regarding E.coli infection, please contact the Livingston County Department of Health and ask to speak to a member of the Communicable Disease team at 585-243-7299.

Livingston County Land Bank Awarded \$500K State Grant

Geneseo, NY- Livingston County Administrator Ian M. Coyle announced today that the Livingston County Land Bank Corporation (LCLBC) has been awarded \$500,000 in grant funding. Attorney General Barbara D. Underwood on Friday, November 2, 2018, announced \$25.9 million in new funding for New York State land banks that work to protect homeowners and neighborhoods by acquiring blighted homes and transforming them into community assets. This latest round of funding will be administered by Enterprise Community Partners, Inc.

The \$500,000 in grant funding will assist the LCLBC in meeting its mission of reducing neighborhood blight and fighting property decay in the County. The Livingston County Land Bank Corporation was set up last year by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors to acquire real property that is tax delinquent, tax foreclosed, vacant or abandoned, and use the tools of the NYS Land Bank Program to eliminate negative community impacts associated with these properties.

"This infusion of grant monies from the State Attorney General is a vote of confidence in the LCLBC, its Board of Directors and staff members, as well as the Board of Supervisors responsible for creating and setting the direction of the land bank" said Coyle, who is also the Vice Chairman of the LCLBC Board of Directors. "This grant will greatly assist the Land Bank in continuing to achieve its mission of helping communities facilitate the return of vacant, abandoned and tax-delinquent properties to productive use and return them to the tax rolls in a fashion that serves the public interest."

Since being set up last year, the LCLBC acquired a vacant lot on Cuylerville Road in the Town of Leicester, and then deeded the lot to the Livingston County Chapter of Habitat for Humanity. Habitat is in the final stages of building a single-family home on the property, which will be occupied in the near future.




