Christmas Tree Safety Tips

Christmas trees are staples of the holiday season that can be found in millions of households across the globe. But Christmas trees can be as dangerous as they are heartwarming. According to the American Christmas Tree Association, Christmas tree fires contribute to \$13 million in property damage annually. Many Christmas tree fires involve live Christmas trees that, while beautiful, pose a greater fire threat than artificial trees because they can dry out, making them vulnerable to electric lights and nearby heating sources. · Purchase a fresh tree. The ACTA notes that fresh trees are less likely to catch fire than trees that were

Try to purchase trees with vibrant green needles that are hard to pluck. Purchasing freshly cut trees from tree farms instead of grocery store parking lot vendors, whose trees might have been cut weeks earlier, can ensure trees are fresh.

· Discard damaged lights. Electrical malfunctions in lights can contribute to tree fires, so discard any damaged lights. Before placing lights on the tree, stretch each strand out on the floor and plug them in to see if any lights are damaged or burned out, replacing those that don't pass inspection.

• Place the tree away from heat sources. Christmas trees are the centerpieces of holiday decorations. But trees should never be placed near heat sources, no matter how aesthetically appealing certain spots may seem. Keep trees away from fireplaces, radiators, candles, heating vents, and lights.

 \cdot Keep the tree watered. A tree that gets ample water is less likely to dry out, and dried out trees pose a significant fire risk. Check water levels and water trees in the morning and night as needed.

• Turn lights off at night. Christmas tree lights should always be turned off at night when residents are going to bed. In addition, lights should never be on when no one is home.

TWO ALBION MEN ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH YATES HOME INVASION

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office arrested two Albion men following a home invasion-robbery that occurred in the Town of Yates during the early morning hours of Nov. 13, 2018.

Orleans County Undersheriff Christopher M. Bourke reports that at approximately 5:30 a.m., a masked man allegedly entered a home on Lake

Shore Road in the Town of Yates brandishing what appeared to be an AK-47 rifle. The suspect, Dominic R. DeCarlo, 22, of Albion, N.Y., allegedly demanded money, cell phone and drugs from the victim. The Decarlo then reportedly left the residence with an X-Box, PlayStation4, an Alexa, a TV with cables along with some marijuana and cash.

Further investigation revealed that Decarlo was allegedly acting in consort with another suspect, Spencer T. Freeman, 20, of Albion, N.Y., to perpetrate this crime in an attempt to retaliate an for incident that occurred recently. The Orleans County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at Freeman's home on Phipps Road in the Town of Albion. Officers recovered a quantity of marijuana, 38 dosage units of Xanax bars, U.S Currency, Counterfeit U.S. Currency and firearms. The investigation continued with the Sheriff's Office obtaining several statements and confessions which resulted in locating and recovering the stolen property along with an "Air-Soft" AK-47 replica (modified to appear authentic), that allegedly was used in the robbery.

DeCarlo was charged with Robbery in the second degree (displayed firearm), Grand Larceny 4th degree, and Burglary in the 2nd degree. DeCarlo was arraigned by Albion Town Justice Fuller and remanded to the custody of the Sheriff on \$50,000 bail.

Freeman was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th degree, Conspiracy 4th degree, Tampering with Physical Evidence with intent to conceal, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7th degree, and Unlawful Possession of marijuana. Freeman was arraigned by Town of Albion Justice Fuller and remanded to the custody of the Sheriff on \$25,000 bail. O.C. Sheriff's Office C.I.D. is continuing the investigation with additional arrests likely.

AMAZING WATERFOWL

Waterfowl season is still open with duck ending Dec. 8 and then opening up again on Dec. 26 and finally closing on Jan. 11. Goose season ends Nov. 26 and opens again Dec. 26 and closing again on Jan. 13. The ducks have pretty much moved out of our area but there are still quite a few geese around but no one seems to be hunting them probably



really harsh winter weather recently.

because most hunters are hunting deer. Our local marshes are freezing up leaving little open water for waterfowl to roost on so that has been the main factor in the decrease in their numbers, especially the ducks.

I have been watching one of our bigger marshes that has some open water left and is off limits to waterfowl hunting. There has been a real bunch of geese roosting on this marsh, some mornings standing around on ice! They leave about late morning to go to some of the harvested corn fields to look for spilled grain. A nearby field not too far from this marsh has been pulling in the majority of these birds and of course I'm usually there waiting for them to photograph their arrival. The last few days have seen some nasty weather with snow flurries and wind but these birds get out there in the open and walk that field looking for breakfast. You would think they too would have moved South with the ducks but they seem to be able to endure a lot of harsh conditions and I find it amazing how they deal with it.

Waterfowl can be very interesting and sometimes do unbelievable things. For instance ducks usually migrate at a maximum of 4,000 feet but have been recorded flying as high as 21,000 feet.

The Harlequin duck feeds on invertebrates by diving to the bottom of rushing water and "walking" upstream along the rocky bottom.

In 1947 almost 1,000 waterfowl were swept over Niagara Falls to their deaths. A dense fog was believed to cause this disaster.

Waterfowl have a field of view of almost 340 degrees enabling them to see just about everything above, below, in front and behind them at the same time. No wonder we have trouble sneaking up on them.

The oldest known duck taken by a hunter was a Canvasback harvested at the age of 29 years with the oldest Canada goose also being 29.

Some species of waterfowl like Lesser Scaup and Canada geese may "babysit" other broods of their own kind while their parents go off to feed.

The Long-tailed duck, formally known as the Old Squaw, dives deeper than any other waterfowl. More than 80 of these birds were caught in fishing nests in Lake Ontario at a depth of 240 feet.

In 1973, hundreds of ducks fell from the sky and rained down on Main Street in Stuttgart, Arkansas, breaking windows and damaging cars. It is believed that hail and accumulation of ice on their bodies and wings caused their fall to death.

The fastest duck ever recorded was a Red-breasted Merganser that reached 100 mph while being chased by an airplane. Canvasback ducks have been clocked at 70 mph. Guess that explains why hunters have a hard time hitting these birds.

In New York State a lot of our wetlands are without any legal protection. In terms of a per capital basis we actually lag behind other smaller states on wetland restoration and involvement with Ducks Unlimited which unlike many "antihunting" and supposedly conservation groups puts about 86 percent of the money their money back into wetland and waterfowl conservation.
