Wreaths Across America has hit Hopkins County! mission of the national campaign is "Honor, Remember and Teach" and represents a wonderful way for communities to honor those individuals who served during their lifetimes by decorating their town's cemeteries. As Americans, don't we count our blessings during Thanksgiving, and as Christians, don't we wish the world 'Peace on Earth' at Christmas? "Wreaths Across America" had it's start at Arlington National Cemetery, and today allows Americans an outward expression of these sentiments across our country on December 15 annually.

It is simple... wreaths constructed of live fir branches with a large red bow attached are delivered to the participating cemetery (or other agreed location) on December 14. Then, the local group of volunteers carries out a brief honor ceremony with mass placement of wreaths the next day. Here's something truly amazing...the massive "team" that rolls out to accomplish this is



ALL VOLUNTEER from the companies and drivers who transport the wreaths, to the local committees who organize to place them on graves. It's not too late for you to get involved in Hopkins County's first "Wreaths Across America" campaign. As all the wreaths for the 583 Veterans graves in City Cemetery have already been provided through local donations, all you need to do is gather at Sulphur Springs City Cemetery at 11 am on Saturday December 15 to attend a brief ceremony, and then head to a section of the cemetery where wreaths will be laid by local Boy and Girl Scout troops. Also, each individual hero's name will be spoken at their gravesite. A debt of gratitude is owed to Dena Loyd who heard about the idea and then acted on it for Christmas 2018. Dena selected City Cemetery because that is where her son, US Army SSG Michael 'Chad' Loyd, was laid to rest in August 2006 after he was killed in a war zone near Baghdad. Please come see community action at work! And join in to help if you can! With questions, you can reach out locally at 903-348-8174.

Next year, other cemeteries can get involved in the WAA project. Might we get all of Hopkins County's cemeteries dressed this way for Christmas next year? The answer is yes! If individuals feel moved to accept the invitation and form committees like Dena has done, then all the final resting places of our heroes can display this symbol of remembrance and peace. "Honor Veterans...Remember anyone; a child, a parent, a neighbor or a friend who served their country, and Teach the new generation to do the same". What better way to honor service and sacrifice than by sponsoring a wreath in their honor or in their memory? And these fresh, sprightly generous-sized wreaths make the perfect gesture to say "Peace" during the Christmas season.

I spent mine with family near OKC, and in the suburban neighborhood, many homeowners were putting lights up on their roofs and eaves. The weather was wonderful and families were outside together. 




Jay Don Hays



THE AGGIE WAR HYMN IS 100 YEARS OLD

Tumbleweed Smith

James Vernon "Pinky" Wilson fought in the largest and deadliest battle of World War One. It occurred in France's Argonne Forest in the fall of 1918 and was the battle that weakened the German forces to the point of surrender. It was a bloody, muddy battle.

In the midst of the flying bullets and mortar shells Pinky took out a letter from home and scribbled down a few words

on the back of it. Those words became the Aggie War Hymn, perhaps the most famous fight song in the world. The sound of the artillery's staccato rhythm made Pinky think of an old A & M yell that had the words Hullabaloo Caneck Caneck in it.

Pinky got his nickname while in school when someone threw a tennis ball at him. It hit him in the middle of his back. When he turned around to face the student who threw it, his face was red. The student said, "Well look at old Pinky." The name stuck.

Pinky was a junior at A & M when he volunteered for the Marine Corps. He could have gone into officer training but chose the enlisted ranks and entered as a buck private. In the Marines he was a muleskinner and worked in supply until he was pressed into service on the front lines in the Argonne Forest. When the war ended he stayed in Germany as a guard. His famous song was first played on an old piano in a caretaker's cabin near the Rhine River. He finally got to hear the words and the tune of the melody he had been carrying in his head for months. He carefully unfolded the letter with the words on the back, got paper and ruler and drew some musical scales. He penned four copies for vocals and one copy for piano. Some of his Marine buddies sang it for the first time. They sang it up and down the Rhine River, making Germans the first audience to hear the Aggie War Hymn. The original title was "Goodbye to Texas University." According to Dr. Don Powell, who wrote a history of the Aggie Band, the first time the song was sung on the A & M campus was at a pep rally in 1920.

The song has been played all over the world and beyond. It woke up astronauts Cernan and Schmidt while they were asleep on the moon.

In 2010 Bill Wilcox of Burnet contacted me to do a documentary on Pinky. Bill was Pinky's friend and in the mornings Pinky would stop by Bill's funeral home and tell war stories. When Pinky died in 1980, Bill handled the funeral and burial. "I kept noticing that modest headstone for Pinky and thought he deserved more." So Bill went about raising money for bronze statues of Pinky. One is on the A & M campus; another is near the depot in Bertram where Pinky had a farm.

I interviewed dozens of people for the documentary. I had interviewed Pinky in 1980, just months before his death. I used portions of that interview in the documentary. While doing research I went to all the libraries and museums on the A & M campus and asked if they had any audio or video recordings of Pinky. They said no. A & M recently contacted me and said I had the only recording of
