WHAT WILL YOU **LEAVE BEHIND?**

Despite the fact that we are all well aware of the inevitability of death, only approximately 55 percent of Americans have a will. Are you among them? If you have dependents, you need a will, which names an executor and a guardian to care for your minor children. Both should know where your will is kept, as should your attorney. You should also draft a standby guardianship proxy for your children's guardian, to be kept with your will. Keep Your Natural Tree Fresh this Christmas



Natural Christmas tree afficionados love the authenticity such trees provide during the holiday season. Natural trees also provide a unique aroma that can make holiday celebrations feel more homey.

When purchasing natural trees, holiday celebrants, especially those who like to buy their trees in early December, may be concerned about keeping their trees fresh throughout the holiday season. The following tips can help trees last until the final present is unwrapped and the last of the egg nog has been consumed.

• Buy a freshly cut tree. Whenever possible, celebrants should cut their own trees. This ensures that the tree they bring home is fresh, increasing the chances it will remain so throughout the season. If it's not possible to cut your own tree, the National Fire Protection Association notes that fresh trees should have green needles that do not come off when touched. Many people put significant effort into their holiday lights. When a bulb goes out, all that effort can seem like it was for naught. Replacing a single bulb or multiple bulbs can be a lot of work. • **Ease of installation:** LED lights are easily installed, and the OEERE says as many as 25 strings of LEDs can be connected end-to-end without overloading a wall socket. That can ease the nerves of homeowners concerned about the potential hazards of elaborate holiday lighting displays.

• Energy savings: LED lights consume considerably less energy than incandescent lights, saving homeowners money on their energy bills, which can skyrocket in December thanks to interior and exterior holiday lighting displays using incandescent lights. In fact, the OEERE estimates that, by 2027, widespread use of LED lights could save consumers more than \$30 billion at today's electricity prices.

• Cut pre-cut trees before leaving the lot. Pre-cut trees can make it through the holiday season looking their best, but buyers should request that employees cut as much as two inches off the bottom of the tree before leaving the lot. Once trees are cut, sap begins to seal their base, making it hard for them to absorb water. By requesting that between one and two inches be removed from the bottom of the tree at the time of purchase, buyers are ensuring their trees will be able to absorb the water they'll need to make it through the season when they get home.

• Place the tree in water the moment you get home. To prevent the base of the tree from drying out, place it in water the moment you get home. Freshly cut trees may initially need the water in their tree stands filled in the morning and then again in the evening. As the season progresses, trees likely won't need their stands filled more than once per day.

• Place the tree away from heat sources. Placing trees away from heat sources, such as radiators, fireplaces, heating vents, and lights, reduces the likelihood that trees will dry out and also reduces the risk of fire.

A few simple strategies can help holiday revelers ensure their Christmas trees make it through the holiday season unscathed. \blacksquare

Secure temporary storage

It can help to put some belongings into a storage center prior to moving, and then gradually take items from the storage unit to your new home. This will free up space to make repairs to your new home and give you time to figure out decorating schemes while ensuring clutter won't get in the way of renovation projects. New homeowners also can take their time sorting through boxes and getting rid of items they may not need in their new homes.

Get estimates and verify licensing

The BBB advises consumers to verify all licensing for movers. Solicit at least three in-home estimates and get those figures in writing. Confirm insurance coverage for the company chosen, and be sure to have all agreed upon information spelled out explicitly in a written contract. Red flags to consider include movers who don't make onsite inspections for estimates and those who demand payment in advance before the move.

Have a first-week survival kit

New homeowners can pick up takeout restaurant menus and premade grocery store meals. In addition, stock up on staples such as paper plates, toilet tissue, light bulbs, and cleaning supplies in advance of the move so you won't have to unpack everything at mealtime or when you want to clean after arriving at your new home.

How to Manage Relocating for a New Job



Moving can be a considerable undertaking. While working professionals who are single or married with no children may find it easier to move than men and women with families, it's fair to say that anyone who is moving in the near future has some significant work ahead of them.

In its Job Relocation Survey, the moving company Allied Van Lines found that people move for a variety of reasons. Fifty percent of the 3,500 respondents indicated they relocated for career advancement or money, and many more indicated they relocated because of a job transfer (12 percent), their companies moved (9 percent) and to be closer to family/relationships (8 percent).

Regardless of what's motivating men and women to relocate, and whether or not they're relocating on their own or uprooting their families, various strategies can make a forthcoming move go more smoothly.

· Inquire about relocation assistance. The Allied survey found that 63 percent of companies offered relocation packages. That's a considerable perk, as moving can be expensive, especially for adults moving to different parts of the country. Asking about relocation expenses before being offered a job can be tricky, but some companies may mention such packages in their job ads or in their initial meetings with out-of-town candidates.

The Allied Survey found that 54 percent of companies that offered such packages covered moving expenses, while 21 percent gave new hires a lump sum of money to use as they deemed necessary. Adults who are offered relocation packages should get the specifics so they can start creating moving budgets.

· Emphasize organization. Much of the stress associated with relocating can be traced to the logistics of uprooting oneself and one's family. Men and women who are unaccustomed to making lists may want to start, as doing so can help keep track of all the tasks that need to be completed before hitting the road. Various unique tasks, from canceling utilities to changing insurance policies, must be completed before moving, and it's easy to lose track of what's been done and what hasn't. Maintaining a to-do list and checking off tasks as they're completed can simplify the relocation process.

· Rent your first home. Adults who rent their first homes upon relocating can remove some of the pressure to find the perfect home, knowing full well their first home in their new community will be temporary. If possible, rent in a location that makes it easy to immerse yourself in your new community, which should make the adjustment easier. In addition, place items that are unnecessary for day-to-day life in storage.

Relocating for a job can be exciting and stressful. But there are ways to make moving go smoothly.

Homeowners who park in their driveways may find that their garages have become crowded, cluttered spaces in which searching for tools can feel like scouring a haystack in search of a needle. Choose the right day. So if they are stupid enough to continue their advancement when they know I'm armed, oh well. But will we be able to defend ourselves and our homes in the future or will have to wait for the police to show up and have them figure out what happened?

Our Governor has set up some strict gun laws in New York State and now he is pushing for stricter laws. One of his more recent statements: "We ALREADY have the strongest gun safety laws in the nation, and in the upcoming legislative session we will take additional steps to make our laws even stronger to keep our communities safe."

Stuff like the "red flag" law that creates a court order of protection to ban people considered to be a danger to themselves or other from possessing or buying guns. Hey, that sounds great! But wait, we have a ton of radicals and unstable people out there now and they can't control them until something bad happens. And of course we all know, but apparently our Gov. "Como" doesn't, that these characters don't care about laws. Of course if I pulled a lot of the stuff our State and Federal government officials pull today I wouldn't want the public to have any firearms either! So is gun control more about disarming the public or really to prevent gun violence? No, the problem is not guns; the problem is people and our lack of proper control of those who are a threat to others. Super-high penalties for gun violence may help but what about all those other ways?

1 pork loin, about 3 lbs., trimmed of fat and silver skin

1 tablespoon coarse sea salt

1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

4 cups canola oil

1 cup brown mustard seed

Rub the pork with the salt and pepper. Set on a rack on a baking sheet and refrigerate for at least 12 hours and up to 24 hours.

Preheat the oven to 175 F.

Combine the oil and mustard seed in a Dutch oven and place over medium heat until the oil reaches 350 F on a deep-frying thermometer. A wooden chopstick or the end of a wooden spoon inserted into the oil will emit bubbles when the oil is at the right temperature.

While the oil is heating, remove the pork from the refrigerator. Pat dry. When the oil is up to temperature. turn off the heat. Using tongs, carefully submerge the meat in the hot oil. Cover the pot, transfer to the oven and cook until the pork is 150 F, about 2 hours.

Lift the pork from the oil onto a baking sheet to catch any oil drips. Carve the pork across the grain on the diagonal into thin slices. Drizzle with some of the mustard-scented oil and serve.
