


#### **TOWN OF LEICESTER** TAX COLLECTOR'S NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that I, Amy Neumann, the undersigned collector of taxes in and for the Town of Leicester, New York, have duly received the tax roll and warrant for the collection of taxes for the Town of Leicester for the year 2019. I will serve at the Leicester Town Hall, 132 Main Street, at the Town Clerk's Office starting Tuesday, January 2, 2019: Monday - Thursday from 8:00 in the morning until 4:00 in the afternoon for the purpose of receiving taxes upon such roll. Taxes may be paid on or before January 31, 2019 without charge or interest. On all taxes received after such date, there shall be added charge of 1% for February and 2% for March. Pursuant to Section 987 of the Real Property Tax Law, a delinquent notice will be mailed on or after the thirty-first day following the expiration of the period of interest free payment of taxes (March 2, 2019). The Law mandates that the expenses of mailing such notice shall be an additional penalty of two dollars (\$2.00) against the parcel. Take further notice, that pursuant to the provisions of the law, the tax roll of the Town of Leicester, will be returned to the County Treasurer of Livingston County on the 2nd day of April, 2019.

As a Department that is devoted to competent staff and community health leadership, Livingston County utilizes staff interests, emerging topics, and research-based strategies to enhance performance while promoting camaraderie and increased employee engagement.

During this session, Department of Health staff received updates from the County Administrator regarding County level initiatives, were trained on topics such as Food Safety, Human Trafficking, The CAST Dragonfly Program, and Quality Improvement, and also participated in a Communication Exercise that demonstrated all the different types of communicators for a better understanding of themselves to effectively deliver their message. The health department utilizes team members from within as well as external partners, such as The Arc of Livingston/Wyoming to present.

"Staff really appreciate the designated time spent to training, not only mandatory, but optional trainings that are vetted by those who work in the Department. These events also provide staff time to network, share and celebrate the success of their work," states Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director.






