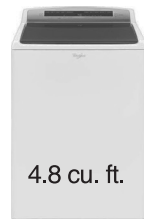

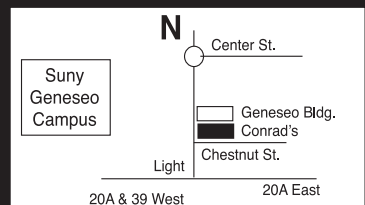

Board of Supervisors Appoints Next Director of Long Term Care at CNR

At their December meeting, the Livingston County Board of Supervisors appointed Stephen R. Woodruff as the next Director of Long Term Care for the Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation (CNR). Mr. Woodruff will succeed the CNR's current Director of Long Term Care, Franklin N. Bassett, RN, LNHA, who is retiring in January.

Mr. Woodruff, the current Deputy Director for Long Term Care, is a Livingston County native and has worked for the County since 2011. Prior to his appointment within the County, Mr. Woodruff served in numerous administrative and care-level positions in health care facilities across Upstate New York. He maintains licenses to practice both as an Occupational Therapist and as a Licensed Nursing Home Administrator.

"It is an honor to be appointed the next Director of Long Term Care of the CNR," said Mr. Woodruff.
